

Base Camp Disc Golf Extravaganza

Information - March 2024

First this will be a Bring your Whole Bag Event, You are going to need them All! 😊
Everyone Plays Two Rounds Saturday 3/9, One on each Course, Hayduke (OG) & Hurrah (New) 18's for a total of 36 holes. Pro/Adv (MPO,MP40,MP50,MA1,MA40) = Play Blue Tees, and Intermediate & AM Lady's (MA2,FA1,FA40,FA2) = Play Red Tees. Pro Women (FPO) can play either Tee, as long as everyone in the division plays the same thing.

On Saturday Morning First Round - Pro's (MPO, MP40, MP50, FPO) play Hayduke 18 (OG), with AM's (MA1,MA2,MA40,FA1,FA2) playing Hurrah 18 (New). Doing Lunch then Switching courses for Saturday afternoons second round, Pro's on Hurrah 18 & AM's on Hayduke 18.

Also on Hurrah Hole 7 (over the wash) the Red Tee in the sand Sucks from what most people tell me and I agree. So I'm moving the Red Tee to be the same as Blue at least for the Event. MA2's let me know what you think.

On Sunday 3/10 We will All play a Modified Hayduke 18 Adding Holes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 16, 17 and 18 from the Hurrah 18 playing a Total of 26 Holes. Allowing 120+ Players in the event this year. Playing a mix of Red & Blue Tees, with 2 Temp Tees, One OB Circle Hole on Hayduke # 2. Alternate/Temp Pin positions on 5, 10, & 16. The Pro/Adv play an 800+' longer version of the course than Int/Wo do. Pro Women do the same as on the first day.

It should be a Fun Yet Challenging Course. Start time is around 9 AM Sunday - Remember Sunday starts Daylight Savings so we lose an hour Sunday Morning, but that gives you an hour more daylight to drive home. We should be finished up around 4:30 PM if Everything runs smoothly. 😊 Hope for Good Weather 😊

When playing Every Round Don't just follow the group in front of you, it could cost you! Pro/Adv play a longer course then Int/Wo, The Score Cards are your Friends, Lots of Good Info found there.

The last Day to get a refund is/was Tuesday March 6th, 2023, at 8:00am MST. After that if you drop out consider yourself a sponsor to your Division. 😊 Not such a bad thing 😊

I'm going to Use PayPal to do most of the PRO/Cash Payout. Makes things easier and I don't need to carry around thousands of dollars. Will have some cash if needed. All AM payout will be TU Disc Dollars. I have more than just discs available for Payout. 😊 Will have an Innova EZ basket, Umbrellas, Innova Dew Towels, and some new molds in stock stamp discs. Shirts & Discs with last year's Stamp.

The Ace Pot has No carryover from Team Utah's 2023 season.

Player Check-In and Paying DG and Camping Fees is on Friday Afternoon and Saturday Morning (see schedule) - Pre Reg Only - If Camping It's \$5/Person Per Day and for DG it's \$5 Per round/person so Minimum of \$15 for the 3 event rounds. If you play other practice rounds, they all are \$5. However If staying in one of Tom's House/Rooms, You are already Covered for All DG Fees.

Additional Rules for Disc Golf at Base Camp

On All Longer Holes and ones with High Lost Disc Potential. All Groups should throw their second shots then Spot Discs for the group behind you before proceeding. There will be an OB line on the Back side of Main Lodge for Hayduke hole 2, It now plays back at the Lodge. No other OB's or Mando's are in Play Saturday. The Two Meter rule is OFF. For Speed of Play on Lost Discs, Let's use the old Rule. 2 Minutes with everyone looking. One stroke penalty then play from the last known location (Group Decision on location).

There are Disc lie's that happen on this course that are unlike most other courses. So If you find your Disc Deep in a Crack, Under a Big Boulder, or on the Edge of Cliff and a normal legal stance is Impossible and/or Dangerous, You get Casual Relief. First Play from the nearest possible spot, On-line-of-Play, if Possible, You can ONLY move sideways/lateral if no other option possible, Then move to best safe/closest relief - No closer to the Hole, No Penalty Stroke. Most importantly is Don't Get Hurt, Stay Safe!

On Hayduke 18 Hole 14 - Hayduke's Revenge - If your Disc comes to rest at the bottom of the Cliff on the Right after a throw, and/or you are at the bottom of the first set of cracks on the right near the basket your closest relief is at the bottom, Sorry. The Coin Slot has rocks in it now, Putt from on top. However If your disc lie is determined to be at the bottom of ledge, You have 2 Options - 1 Play from the bottom of the cliff where your Disc came to rest using normal stance rules No Penalty. Or 2 Take one penalty stroke and Putt from the DZ on top, Around a 40 foot Putt shooting 3. Most of the time when in a Crack your nearest relief is not Up but Back/Away from the basket, but BC has lots of Exceptions.

You Also get Casual Relief from Cactus, Crypto and other Thorny Plants/Trees. Casual Relief = Line of Play, up to 5M/15', No Closer to the Hole. PLEASE Try to stay off the CryptoBiotic Soil (Dark Crusty Sand) when walking around. The Crust with Moss is 500+ years old (Hayduke 4,5,6,7,& 8). One step Kills it for the most part. It is what keeps the sand in the desert from just blowing around and washing away when it Rains. Please when walking around all holes Stay on already walked on areas and trails between holes. The area around Holes 8-9 on the Hurrah 18 is Very Fragile, Stay on marked path to 9's tee pads Please. Also be nice to All the Critters, Plants & Trees, Base Camp is their Home not yours. 😊 Help take care of Base Camp 😊

One Stroke penalty for playing the wrong Tee if discovered before completing the hole. Re-Tee from correct Tee and finish hole counting all strokes + the penalty. Two Strokes penalty if discovered after putting out. Make sure you are on the correct Tee - Especially on Sunday Third Round!

You are Responsible for knowing & playing the Stipulated Course.

The Score Cards have All the needed Tee Position, Normal Pin or Alt/Temp, Par, and Distance Info for reference. Check Cards on every hole Sunday to make sure you are playing the correct Tee & Pin, It changes frequently, Also Pro/Adv & Int/Wo cards are different with Pro/Adv playing a much longer course Sunday. On Every Round Don't just

follow the group in front of you, it could cost you! Pro/AM Women can play either Tee on Sunday, as long as everyone in the Division plays the same thing.

On the score card make sure you are scoring the hole in the correct place; we are playing 2-18 hole round (Sat) and 1-26 hole round (Sun). It's a Complex Scorecard but has lots of necessary Info. No Front and Back Total on the scorecard for the 26-hole round Sunday.

Remember a messed up card is likely a wrong Total. ☹ I know ☹

Make sure you Total Your Card with a number, Not a +/-, That's a Wrong Total. A total score for each round is all that is Needed. No Total or Wrong Total = Actual Score + 2 Strokes.

An abundance of Necessary Information is on the Score Cards. Lots of questions can be answered by just looking at the cards. Like what Tee are we playing R/B, Distance to the hole, Par, Circle hole, or Is there Temp Tee or Basket. The Cards are your Friends! I have extras if you want one for reference.

Only take the Scorecards from the scoreboards at the start of each round. Don't take the Talley Cards Please. Clipboards & Pencils available if needed, you should have everyone in the group have a turn at keeping scores.

On Sunday R-3 Hayduke Hole 2 will be an Island Hole playing from the Red Tee for Everyone. If you miss the Circle, take a One Stroke Penalty and Play/Putt from where the disc came to rest, No DZ in play.

Tee Assignment on Saturday – You can play on any Card in your division, but ONLY on the Holes Assigned to your Division in groups of 3 to 5 players. Please make all tee changes by Friday night, Saturday morning Cards are LOCKED! We have had issues with having groups taking off to whatever hole they like causing Big Issues. If your group does not start on one of the holes assigned to your division, the entire group gets a DQ for the event! Please Don't make me need to do it. ☹

For the second round Saturday Keep the score card after the first round and have Lunch. We will do a quick player meeting then send everyone out to their Assigned holes for the 2nd Round. PRO's play Hurrah 18 and AM's Hayduke 18 second round, Keeping the same group, and starting on the same hole as the first round but the other course. Some holes don't line up well with the other Course. The AM group playing Hurrah-15 in the morning will just need to hike up to Hayduke-15 for the PM round (Sorry). The AM groups playing Hurrah 13&14 in the morning should play Hayduke 9 & 10. So then the Pro groups playing Hayduke 9 & 10 in the morning should Play Hurrah 14 & 15 for the PM round.
Hope that makes sense to everyone?

5:00pm - 7:00pm Player Check-In and Pay DG and Camping Fees if Camping - Pre Reg Only if The Event is Full - If Camping It's \$5/Person Per Day and for DG it's \$5 Per Round so \$15 for the 3 rounds. If you play other practice rounds and stay extra days all are \$5 each per Day. If staying in one of Tom's House/Rooms you are already Covered for All DG Fees, but still check-in. There is a \$5 Late Fee to sign up at Base Camp, Please do it online the event will likely be Full anyway.

8:00am - 9:15am Player Check-In and Pay DG & Camping Fees if Camping - Pre Reg Check-In Only Saturday morning, Tee Assignments have been Posted - Pro's on Original Course & AM's on New Course First Round. If you are just showing up Saturday morning, please let me know Friday if Possible. Texting works once I'm at Base Camp.

9:20am - 9:40am Players Meeting First Round - Pro's on Hayduke 18, AM's on Hurrah 18. All Pro (MPO,MP40, MP50,) and Advanced (MA1,MA40) Play Blue Tees. Intermediate (MA2,FA40,FA2) Play Red Tee's. FPO & FA1 can Play Either as a group/division decision.

10:00am - 1:00pm First Round - Pro's on Hayduke & AM's on Hurrah first Round - All Pro (MPO,MP40, MP50,) and Advanced (MA1,MA40) Play Blue Tees. Intermediate (MA2,FA40,FA2) Play Red Tee's. FPO & FA1 can Play Either as a group/division decision. I will Call 2 Minutes, Then Start.

1:00pm - 2:00pm Lunch - Do Not Turn in Scorecards Yet - Play Second Round First! Keep the same groups and play Opposite Course after Lunch using same Hole/Tee Assignment as First Round - Pro's on Hurrah & AM's on Hayduke Second Round - Do Not Turn in Scorecards Yet - Play Second Round First!

2:00pm - 2:10pm I will Call Everyone in after Lunch, Answer any questions, then Go to your assigned holes. Keep the same groups and play Opposite Course as First Round using same Hole/Tee Assignment as First Round - Pro's on Hurrah & AM's on Hayduke Second Round. Some starting holes do not align well from Hayduke to Hurrah courses so adjust as Necessary. :)

2:30pm - 5:30pm Second Round - Pro's on Hurrah & AM's on Hayduke. All Pro (MPO,MP40, MP50) and Advanced (MA1,MA40) Play Blue Tees. Intermediate (MA2,FA40,FA2) Play Red Tee's. FPO & FA1 can Play Either as a group/division decision. Some starting holes do not align well from Hayduke to Hurrah courses so adjust as necessary. - Turn in Score Cards After Second Round :) I will Call 2 Minutes, Then Start.

5:30pm - 6:00pm Total Up and Turn in Scorecards at the front of the Main Lodge so we can Total things up for tomorrow. No score or +/- is a wrong score you get actual score +2 strokes. If I don't see your card by 1 hour after finishing you get a 999/DNF. Remember Daylight Savings begins tonight :) 9am tomorrow is like 8am was today :)

Sunday, March 10, 2024

9:00am - 9:15am Tees Posted & Player Meeting for Final Round - 26 Holes on Modified Hayduke 18 + 8 of the Hurrah 18. We will play from a variety of Red, Blue & Temp Tee's. (MA2/FA2)Divisions will play different/shorter layouts of Red & Blue Tees on the Final round. Pro/Adv will play a mostly Blue but with a Few Reds in the Mix. Intermediate and Women will play a shorter Mix but with several long holes still in play.

9:30am - 2:00pm Final Round - 26 Holes on a Modified Hayduke 18 - Red & Blue Tees with Temp Tees & Baskets on a Few Holes. Hole 2 will be an Island Hole from Red Tee. Plus Holes 1,2,3,4,5,16,17,18 of Hurrah 18. Hole 16 will have a Temp Tee Pad down low on the flats below the road near the rocks Playing to

normal 16 basket. Refer to Scorecard for Red/Blue or Temp Tee Info. Pay attention to the Tee you should be playing from, it Changes. I will Call 2 Minutes, Then Start.
