1. Information We Collect

- A. Personal Data Provided by You: Name, age (18+ only), gender identity, and sexual orientation.
- B. Sensitive Personal Data: Precise Location (GPS) and Private Communications (In-app chats).
- C. Automatically Collected Data: Device Information and Usage Analytics.

2. Legal Basis for Processing

- Consent: For profile creation, sexual orientation data, and location tracking.
- Contractual Necessity: To provide the matchmaking service.
- Legitimate Interests: To ensure community safety and prevent fraud/harassment.

3. How We Share Your Information

- Other Users: Profile data and approximate distance.
- Service Providers: Google Firebase and analytics providers.
- Legal Compliance: Required by Indian law enforcement under the IT Act.

4. Data Retention & Deletion

- Profile is removed immediately upon deletion.
- Data deleted from active servers within 30 days.
- Encrypted logs may be kept for up to 180 days for security audits as per Indian law.
