



Summer Reading Assignment 2025 **Students entering Sixth Grade Resource Room**



Reading during the summer is so important in helping children maintain the skills learned during the year. Reading every day advances current reading levels and creates lifelong readers and learners. The students **entering sixth grade resource room** this year will be reading **one book of choice** this summer. The students will choose their book prior to the end of the school year and their current ELA teacher will approve their choice.

We are expecting the students to continue to become active readers this summer. Being an active reader requires thinking, questioning and visualizing the text while reading. In doing so, the students **will complete two boxes of the attached choice board**. Directions for the choice board activities are provided.

READING RESPONSE CHOICE BOARD

Create a TIMELINE about the novel you read. Make sure the timeline includes the title and author, main characters, problem, solution, if you enjoyed the book, and if you would recommend it to other students. Click on 'Launch the Tool.' https://www.readwritethink.org/classroom-resources/student-interactives/timeline	Make a COLLAGE. Find pictures from magazines or online. Hand drawn pictures are super too. Combine them all to create a collage that represents what happened in the story you read. Make sure the pictures depict the title and author, main characters, problem, solution, if you enjoyed the book, and if you would recommend it to other students.	CHARACTER TRADING CARD Choose a character from the book you read and create a character trading card. Create a STORY MAP about the novel you read. Write or type a one paragraph SUMMARY of the book.	CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS Choose 2 characters from your story and create a T-chart. You may use the link provided or create your own. On a piece of poster board, illustrate and label the title and author, main characters, problem, solution, if you enjoyed the book and if you would recommend it to other students.
