## Intro to Event

Polkadot & Kusama Belgrade 2024 is a one-day event aimed at bringing together members of the Polkadot & Kusama community, such as infrastructure providers, parachains, developers, and enthusiasts to discuss the growth and potential of the Dotsama ecosystem, share knowledge and forecast collaborations.

Several significant projects, organizations, and stakeholders such as Ceres, Origin Trail, Unique Network, MVP Workshop and Apilon in the Polkadot ecosystem have expressed interest in the event so far and have committed to attending the conference. We intend to take advantage of these relationships to increase the event's appeal and positioning in the Polkadot community.

As organizers, we strive to create an environment that promotes collaboration and human connection, which is essential for the web3 community to create valuable products and drive the mass adoption of Polkadot and Kusama.



# Why Belgrade?

Belgrade and Serbia have been one of the leaders in the growth of the Web3 industry in Europe over the past few years. Belgrade hosts a lot of such kinds of events and conferences because it is unique in many ways:

- Belgrade is a base for multiple Polkadot projects and a number of people from the community (including Parity) that can present the ecosystem well.
- Serbia has a very well-established and strongly bonded Web3 Community consisting of enthusiasts, investors, and industry experts.
- The Web3 industry in Serbia has been rapidly growing in the past few years because of the quality of development services that companies in our market are eligible to provide.
- A large number of Web3 startups with innovative ideas appear on our market, which represents an ideal opportunity for all ecosystem builders to get a chance to come and learn about the innovations that are being developed here.
- Web3 Companies from Serbia have been featured, many times, as implementation partners of industry leaders such as Parity (Substrate), Polygon, and others
- The government and state institutions already provide a lot of support for all kinds of events in the Web3 community and try to improve how we do business through the Web3 market by working on regulations. Serbia has established the first cluster organization dedicated to web3 in the world, once again showcasing the potential of this market to pioneer the Web3 industry

By hosting this event in Belgrade, Serbia, we aim to tap into the vibrant technology ecosystem and entrepreneurial spirit of the Balkan and Eastern European region. The conference will serve as a platform to connect local developers, community builders, and investor partners (venture capitalists, angels, accelerators) with Polkadot & Kusama projects and opportunities, fostering collaboration and driving innovation within the ecosystem. Additionally, we will actively engage with local Web3 companies, universities, and government agencies to showcase the enterprise potential of Polkadot and explore opportunities for its adoption in various sectors.

In addition, the event will coincide with Belgrade Blockchain Week, a time when the city will host several other notable events such as ETH Belgrade, ZK Day, Rust Summit, and more. This scheduling ensures that a significant number of crypto enthusiasts and





blockchain professionals will already be in Belgrade, enhancing the potential reach and impact of our event.

- Parity's Substrate Delivery partners: 3,5 years ago we got in touch with Parity to build a variety of products for the Polkadot ecosystem, including Substrate Starter Kit.
- Completed the grant to build UI Kit for Asset Conversion Pallet which is broadly adopted by developers that are building DeFi (DEX) solutions on Asset Hub system parachain. Almost half a year after the official release we have managed to adapt the product to scaling needs of Polkadot (since runtime 1.2.0 is live) and to introduce new features while providing the support for teams that are onboarding their products to Asset Hub by using our solution as a core.
- In April 2024 we have as well closed the grant on open governance to update the Substrate Starter Kit

Our position in the Polkadot ecosystem at the moment is multifaceted. Besides developing solutions for a number of clients, we are also advancing our own products, the Parachain Runtime Builder and UI KIT for Asset Conversion Pallet, which is now, six months after release, used by multiple teams that are building DEX products in the Polkadot Ecosystem. This initiative is crucial as it facilitates the creation of custom parachains, streamlining the development process and enhancing efficiency. Our active engagement and contributions aim to significantly enrich the Polkadot community with innovative tools and applications.

We have organized a Polkadot Community Day in Belgrade, held as part of the Belgrade Blockchain Week. This event brought around 100 community members together for networking with Polkadot Ecosystem Experts, parachain teams and enthusiasts. Here you can find the <u>recap of last year's event</u>.



Unique Network is a parachain designed as a next-gen NFT chain, aiming to support advanced uses and attract many users. It explores new ways to use NFTs, which are key in managing distinct digital assets like digital real estate and fashion, as well as in gaming.





- As one of the top Polkadot parachains in active users and traction, it can represent real-world solutions to the wider dev community to attract them to Polkadot. It appeals to the EVM ecosystem with a full EVM compatibility, and to Web2 developers with its Unique SDK, which allows development in most Web2 languages with easy access to blockchain capabilities. Since a big part of the Unique team is based in Belgrade, they can assist in putting together a great event.
- The Unique Network NFT Marketplace has been relaunched to support next-generation NFT utility tools for creators. This marketplace offers a seamless experience for creating and trading advanced NFTs, promoting more sophisticated and functional digital assets.

Through these initiatives, Unique Network is driving significant advancements in the utilization of NFT as a tool for adding utility and providing sustainability of digital assets which are unlocking new use cases for potential builders to further expand their vision in the Polkadot Ecosystem.






# Polkadot Day 2023 - Recap

Polkadot Day 2023 was a 1-day conference event hosted by MVP Workshop during the Belgrade Blockchain week last year. We have managed to successfully gather Polkadot community and these are event summary:



#### Overall summary:

Polkadot day (an event held during Belgrade Blockchain Week), was organized on June





5th, 2023, in a Business Auditorium of the Faculty of Organizational Sciences.

The total number of attendees was between 50 and 100 (with 200 Eventbrite registrations), in which we've included 9 speaking & educational sessions (2 fireside chats, 1 workshop and 6 keynotes) amongst 11 speakers:





#### Onboarding developers to Substrate framework

#### Project visibility increment
