

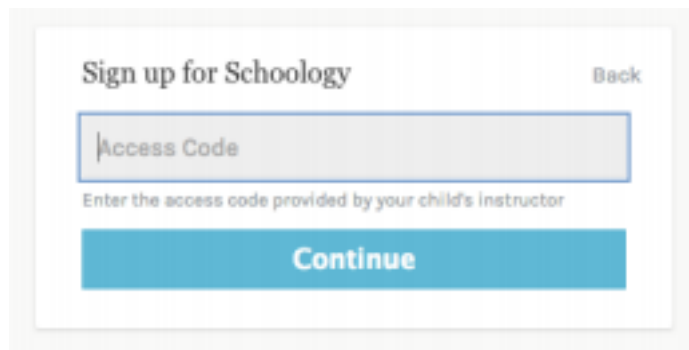
Parent Access to Schoology

Parents will need only a single access code to register for an account and that will allow them to view all of their child's Schoology activity.

Parents can get the access code from one of their child's teachers.

To sign up for a new Schoology account go to <https://app.schoology.com/register.php> and click the **Parent** button.

Enter your Access Code. This is a 12-digit code in xxxx-xxxx-xxxx format that you will receive from one of your child's teachers.

When parents use a Parent Access Code to create an account, they are automatically associated with their child. They can add additional children to their account using the **Add Child** button.

Parents must have an account at each of their children's schools. For example, if they have one child at a High School, and one child at a Middle School, they must have accounts at both schools and then **link their accounts** together. The feature enables them to toggle between accounts without having to log out and back in, and it lets each school separately manage the parent accounts and then communicate with them as necessary.
