



How to: Join the Prayer Request Group on the App

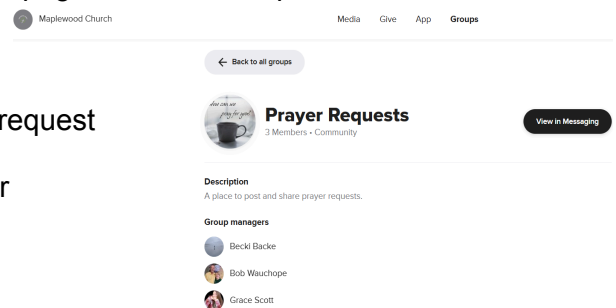
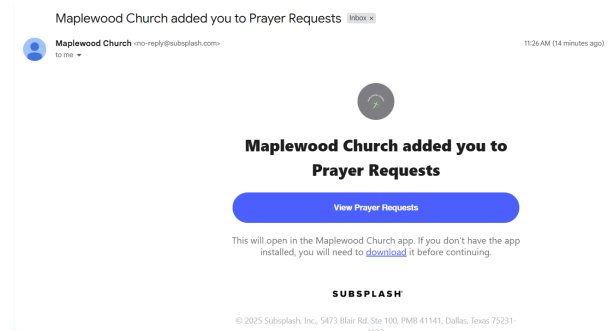
1. Open the Maplewood app.
2. Click on the speech bubbles at the top right of the screen.
3. Click over to the “Discover” tab on the top right of the screen.
4. Either, start typing “Prayer Requests” into the search bar, or scroll down till you see it.
5. Click on it.
6. Click the “Request to join” button.
7. Click “Request to join” again.
8. There will be a pop up that says, “Your request was sent!”
9. Click “Ok, got it!”
10. Once the request has been approved you will receive an email stating that you have been added to the group.
11. Click “View Prayer Requests” in the email.
12. A new tab will open and you will click “Accept invite”.
13. Follow the log in prompts like you did when creating your account.
14. Once logged in, it will take you back to the Prayer Request page, but the “Accept invite” button will be replaced with “View In Messaging”
15. Click “View in Messaging” to go ahead and post a prayer request from the website, or click “Back to all groups” to search for additional message groups.



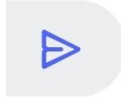
Your request was sent!

16. In the app, the Prayer Request Group will show up under the “Conversations” tab of the Messaging page. (Get to the Messaging page by clicking on the speech bubbles on the app's home page.)
17. To post a prayer request, simply click on the “Prayer Request” group and type your request into the “Message Prayer Requests” text bubble at the bottom of the screen. To send, simply click the paper plane to the right of your message.

1. No foul language
2. Include the important information, but keep it brief
3. This message group is for prayer requests ONLY, no advertising
4. Please only post a prayer request once
5. Keep updates to a minimum (when there are big changes or when it has been answered)
