Margins

- Top, Bottom, Left, and Right: 1 inch (2.54 cm) on all sides.

Font Size and Style

- Title: 14 pt, Times New Roman, Bold, Centered.
- Headings (e.g., Introduction, Methodology, etc.): 12 pt, Times New Roman, Bold.
- Subheadings: 12 pt, Times New Roman, Italic.
- Body Text: 12 pt, Times New Roman, Regular.
- Abstract and Keywords: 11 pt, Times New Roman, Italic.
- Captions for Tables and Figures: 11 pt, Times New Roman, Bold.



Tables

- Tables should be placed within the text where they are first referenced.
- Number tables consecutively (e.g., Table 1, Table 2) and provide a clear, concise title above the table.
- Use 11 pt Times New Roman for table text.
- Ensure tables are formatted to fit within the page margins.
- Tables should be cited in the text as, for example, "Table 1 shows..."

Figures

- Figures should also be embedded within the text near the first mention.
- Number figures consecutively (e.g., Figure 1, Figure 2) and provide a descriptive caption below each figure.
- Use 11 pt Times New Roman for figure captions.
- Ensure that all figures are of high quality and readable.
- Figures should be cited in the text as, for example, "As illustrated in Figure 1..."

Acknowledgments

(Optional Section)

- The acknowledgment section should be placed after the main content and before the references.
- Acknowledge any funding sources, institutional support, or individuals who contributed to the research but are not listed as authors.
- Use 12 pt Times New Roman, Regular.

- A brief biography of each author can be included at the end of the manuscript.
- Limit biographies to 100-150 words per author.
- Include the author's current position, research interests, and notable achievements.
