PSD 2024 Student Connections Survey

Poudre School District will provide all students in grades 4-12 with an opportunity to take a voluntary online student connections survey. This survey will be delivered through the PSD student email system and should take about 15 - 30 minutes to complete, sometime between October 21st and November 22nd, 2024. General Notes for PSD Options:

Breakfast & Lunch

As a reminder, PSD Options students are not eligible for free breakfast or lunch despite the passage of the Colorado Healthy School Meals for All ballot issue. The costs are \$2.40 for breakfast and \$4.85 for lunch. Payment can be made via [SchoolPay](#).

Please keep in mind that since Options is an enrichment program, we tend to be more flexible on attendance. However, during October Count attendance is vital, since the state of Colorado uses attendance on these dates to determine our student enrollment count and funding allocation. Please be sure that your child attends PSD Options during October Count that typically runs from the last week of September through the first week of October.
