### **SHORT BIO**

Yanu Endar Prasetyo is a researcher at the Research Center for Population, National Research and Innovation Agency (BRIN), Indonesia, and currently serves as a research fellow at the International NGO Forum on Indonesian Development (INFID). During his doctoral studies at the University of Missouri-Columbia, USA, Yanu was actively involved in the Deaton Scholars Program and received hands-on community training through the Randolph County Caring Community Partnership (RCCCP) from 2019 to 2021. He graduated from the MU Extension Community Development Academy in 2019 and holds two graduate certificates from the University of Missouri-Columbia. His research, conducted in collaboration with his advisor Hua Qin, has been published in reputable platforms such as the *Natural Hazards Center* at the University of Colorado Boulder (2020) and the *Journal of Social Science & Medicine* (2021), where they explored dynamic risk perception and behavioral responses during the COVID-19 pandemic. Yanu's academic journey has been marked by numerous accolades, including the MU International Engagement Award for Outstanding Student Contribution (2020), the Freeda Thomas Yeo Agricultural Fund (2020), the Lionberger Scholarship (2020–2021), and his selection to the prestigious Rollins Society (2021). In 2023, he was chosen as one of the Southeast Asian scholars to participate in the Asian Conference for Young Scholars of Southeast Asian Studies (AYSEAS) at Academia Sinica, Taipei, Taiwan. He was also entrusted with leadership roles, notably as Chair of the Organizing Committee for the 4th SEASIA Biennial Conference in Jakarta (2022) and as the current coordinator of the Poverty, Inequality, and Social Protection Research Group since 2023. In 2025, Yanu's contributions received further recognition when he was awarded the *Séjour Scientifique de Haut Niveau (SSHN)* by the Institut Français Indonésie (IFI), enabling him to undertake a three-month research residency/visiting researcher/scholar in France from September to November (2025). Earlier that year, from March 17 to 26, he also participated as a Visiting Researcher at La Rochelle University under the *AAP Mobilités Internationales 2025* program, deepening his collaboration with CRHIA La Rochelle University on social protection and inequality.
