Entry Level Mathematics Coursework has Changed

In fall of 2021, WIU discontinued teaching intermediate algebra. The two beginning level math courses are Math 100: Core Competency in Mathematics and Math 110: Introductory College Algebra. Details about these courses and related changes can be <u>found here</u>. WIU will accept Intermediate Algebra as a transfer course for the purpose of math placement in 2022-2023. Beginning fall 2023, transferring in Intermediate Algebra will no longer help a student's math placement (see next item).

Math Placement

The primary means of math placement for transfer students is their math coursework. Additional information may also be used for placement. <u>Details on math placement here</u>. We also offer the <u>ALEKS Placement Test</u> which can improve math placement and save the student time and money.

- Preferred courses: Math 133: Calculus with Analytic Geometry I (IAI: M1 900-1; MTH 901) and Math 134 Calculus with Analytic Geometry II (IAI: M1 900-2; MTH 902)
- Also recommended: 231 Calculus with Analytic Geometry III (IAI: M1 900-3; MTH 903) and 311 Linear Algebra (IAI: MTH 911).
