Learning Intention	I will Learn the Auslan signs for some different types of shops. Learn Auslan conversation about buying.	

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Success Criteria

I can

- Recognise and correctly sign the shop types that were taught.
- Recall and sign some of the fruit signs previously taught.

Time	Teacher	Resources
5 mins	Set up the video to watch. Students seated on the floor.	
5 mins	Introduction: Introduce the topic - Shops and shopping Today we join someone on their shopping day. Probably similar to what you might do with your family members. We will learn the Auslan signs for some shops, the meet and greet and purchasing items. Have fun at the shops and don't forget to take some money! (haha) (Start of Lesson)	Provided above
	 Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria. Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary. 	
10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch the video Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time.	#B Lesson 4 video
	Signs taught: Shops, shopping, buy, Supermarket, Chemist, Bank, Fruit shop, Butcher Coffee shop - cafe, Toy shop, Ice-cream shop.	
5 mins	 Explanation of Activity: Practise the Shop signs taught in the whole group with the teacher. Circle Shopping Activity - students are seated in a circle on the floor. The first student starts - signs Fruit shop, buy, sign a fruit sign previously taught, e.g. Fruit shop, buy, banana. The activity continues with each student in the circle having a turn, buying a different item, using the three signs. Some students may wish to add the number they purchase, e.g. Fruit shop, buy, 3 banana, or banana 3. 	

	 If a student has difficulty, the teacher or another student can assist them with an idea/sign(s). Constructed Action - each student places their item in their personal shopping 'bag'. 	
15 mins	Activity: Practise the Shop signs taught in the whole group with the teacher. Circle Game Shopping Activity - Fruit Shop.	
5 mins	 Reflection with Students: (Select from the following) Which shops do you like to visit with your family? Which fruit did you buy in our activity today? Would it be easy to buy something using Auslan? What signs would you need to know and use? Tell/show me something that you learnt in this lesson.
