SENIOR AWARDS NIGHT

PLACE: Enloe Auditorium
DATE: May 26, 2026
TIME: 6:00 PM (**Invited Seniors needed by 5:30 PM**)

Seniors who will be recognized will receive an invitation to the Senior Awards Night. Recognition items (stoles and cords) will be given. Seniors should report to the cafeteria by 5:30 PM and doors will open for guests at 5:30 PM. Students receiving an award can invite two guests due to limited space. Students should plan to wear their graduation gown, but the cap will **not** be worn for **this particular event**. Please see below for proper attire. If a senior receiving an award RSVPs YES and finds out later they cannot attend, they should inform their assigned counselor as soon as possible.

GRADUATION REHEARSAL

PLACE: Auditorium & West Gymnasium(before Senior Picnic)
DATE: Thursday, May 28th, 2026
TIME: 7:40 am-10:30 am **SLIDESHOW HERE** (CHECK BACK HERE IN MAY)

All graduating seniors should be at Rehearsal. We will meet in the Auditorium and transition to the West Gymnasium for rehearsal (walk-through). Please pay close attention to the instructions given so that we can make the rehearsal short. During the graduation rehearsal, we will line up graduates for the procession, practice the procession, practice the receiving of diplomas, and practice the recessional. Graduation tickets will be distributed only to seniors who have met **ALL** graduation requirements and have no outstanding fees/fines. Each graduating senior will receive seven (7) tickets for graduation. **BRING YOUR STUDENT ID!** There are **NO** additional tickets. If you need additional tickets, ask your fellow graduates if they have extras that you could have. You may **NOT** sell tickets for any reason. You can pick up your tickets from the Graduation Coordinator in the East Building, room 1934, during school hours until June 8th if you cannot make the above times. After that, see Student Services.

GRADUATION CEREMONY LIVESTREAM HERE (CHECK BACK HERE IN JUNE)

PLACE: Raleigh Convention Center
DATE: Thursday, June 11th, 2026
TIME: 8:00 A.M.

All graduating seniors must be at the Raleigh Convention Center on Thursday, June 11th, **NO LATER THAN 7:00 A.M.** After you have parked your car, report directly to the area behind the stage to a seating area similar to rehearsal. There are to be absolutely no seniors outside of the designated areas before graduation. Get there early! Drive the route days prior to ensure you are aware of travel time and parking decks. Multiple concerts and graduations prior to Enloe's, expect delays! Leave home early!

Attendance will be taken. Once attendance is checked, remain in your space in the processional line. Once in line, do not leave your position! **The procession will begin at 7:50 A.M.**

Following the ceremony, graduates should report back to their assigned area to their holding seat to receive their diplomas. Once you have your diploma, quickly exit the Convention Center. Students who behave inappropriately during graduation will have their diplomas temporarily held.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR GRADUATION

Handicapped Seating:

One (1) family member will be allowed to sit with the family member who is handicapped. Persons being seated in the handicapped area should enter the Convention Center at the designated areas that are marked. They may enter 45 minutes prior to the ceremony.

Interpreter Services:

Senior students should notify Mrs. Gill (enloehs_graduation@wcpss.net) by May 1st if they will have guests in need of sign language interpreter services.

Time Guests May Enter:

Guests may enter 40 minutes prior to the ceremony.

Respectfulness:

We ask that all guests respect the right of every family to hear their student's name being announced. **Family members and invited guests are requested to respect all seniors and the dignity of the ceremony by remaining quiet during the ceremony and especially as the names are called for the presentation of diplomas.** The Principal may place a temporary hold on a student's diploma if family and friends disrupt the graduation ceremony.

Information from the Convention Center:

- No flowers in glass vases
- No signs, balloons, or noise makers
- No wrapped packages
- Stay in seat during the ceremony
- No individuals under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- No outside food or drink

Exiting the Convention Center: At the conclusion of the graduation ceremony, families are invited backstage to meet their graduates before exiting the Convention Center. **Please do not linger.**

General Reminders:

- All Wake County School Policies must be adhered to. Any major infraction will bar participation in graduation activities.
- All fees and fines must be paid. Seniors who fail to assume financial responsibility to Enloe High School will not receive a diploma until fines are cleared.
- Admission to the graduation ceremony is by ticket only. Each senior will be given seven (7) tickets. There are NO extra tickets available.
- If you are having difficulties getting your cap/gown, tassel, or paying your senior fee, see your counselor immediately.
- Please be reminded that any misconduct on your part during graduation WILL result in your diploma being pulled. If that happens, you will need to follow instructions given following graduation as to when you can pick up your diploma.
- The Convention Center is an active space. They ask that we respect others who are using the building & assist in leaving the areas used better than we found them.

ATTIRE FOR GRADUATES

We want your graduation ceremony to be a dignified experience. You have worked hard to reach this milestone, and you deserve a ceremony in which you can be proud. So that your graduation ceremony can be a special event for you and your family, we ask for your full cooperation in following the instructions and procedures given and adhering to the dress code for graduation. Any student who has difficulty acquiring an item necessary to meet the dress code requirement should discuss the situation with a senior teacher, senior advisor, or senior administrator.

ALL:

Wear comfortable dress shoes, be careful not to wear too high of a heel; you will be walking up and down steps (no top siders, casual sandals, flip flops, or tennis shoes), dress socks, dress trousers (no jeans or shorts), a dress that is not below the hemline of the gown or skirt, white/light blue dress shirt, tie or bowtie.

CAPS AND GOWNS should always be worn in a dignified way. Be sure gowns are neatly pressed. Use an iron on a cool setting. Caps are always worn straight on the head and the tassel is worn on the right side. Collars will not be worn. You are not allowed to decorate your CAP per WCPSS Policy. **DO NOT lose your tassel! We do not have many extra tassels. If you lose yours, there will be a barcode available to pay \$13, if applicable at the time.**

GRADUATION PROCEDURES AND ETIQUETTE

Seniors will graduate in alphabetical order. At the time of the presentation of diplomas, sections of seniors will be escorted to the stage by student marshals. Please watch for their signal. Everyone in the row will stand together and follow the marshal's directions. Upon hearing his/her name called, each senior will walk across the stage and receive his/her diploma. The diploma will be received by the left hand, and you will shake hands with the right.

After the diploma is presented, exit the stage and return to your designated seat. Do not wait for the entire row to return to their seats. Please be seated immediately so that others may view the ceremony.

While waiting for the other seniors to receive their diplomas, please give your fellow graduates respect so that each person's name can be properly heard. After all seniors have received their diplomas, the class representative will lead you in the traditional tassel ceremony. You will be moving your tassel from the right side to the left side of your cap.

Any graduate who disrupts the ceremony by hand gestures, hooting, and hollering, etc. will have a temporary hold placed on their diploma.
