Those primarily interested in honing their writing skills are encouraged to apply for the **SATW Foundation Paul Lasley Scholarship to Book Passage.**

Long-time faculty member Paul Lasley never met a stranger. After Paul's death in 2021, we heard that repeatedly from those who knew him and all those (which was everybody) who benefited from his warmth and his willingness to share his knowledge.

Besides originating hundreds of radio shows, Paul was active in SATW (Society of American Travel Writers), serving as its president 2015-16; the SATW Foundation (the philanthropic arm of SATW) as a board member; and as a faculty member with his wife, Elizabeth, at the Book Passage Travel Writers & Photographers Conference.

### **Photography**

Those primarily interested in honing their photographic skills are encouraged to apply for the **SATW Foundation Ed Stone Scholarship to Book Passage.**

Ed Stone was gracious and charming, and his smile could melt glaciers. He was a paragon of professionalism and integrity in his travel and tourism public relations work — as vice president of marketing and PR at Nashville's Grand Ole Opry and Opryland

Hotel for many years, and later as head of his own communications company.

He brought those gifts to SATW, where he worked on many conventions, and to the SATW Foundation, where he served as a Board member. Among Ed's loves, which included golf, country music, and Fran, his wife of 53 years, was photography. The multimedia slide shows he created in his public relations work won rave reviews, and he brought that sharp eye as well to his work and collaboration on the annual Lowell Thomas Travel Journalism Competition videos.

After Ed's death in 2022, the Foundation established this scholarship, a fitting tribute to someone who consistently encouraged talented, budding photographers and who always understood the importance of photography in travel storytelling.

### **Who is eligible to apply?**

Both scholarships are open to:

1. Anyone trying to break into the craft, who has spent less than two years working on the craft and who has fewer than five published paying pieces or photos.

*Notes: A personal blog, owned by the writer or photographer and for which the person receives no compensation and is not supported by advertising or other revenue, does not count against that total.*

2. Students who have never attended Book Passage or who have studied at BP not more than once may apply.

3. Anybody who meets these criteria may apply. You need not be a member of SATW to apply.

### **How to apply for the scholarships:**

#### **Those applying for the SATW Foundation Paul Lasley**

**Scholarship:** Please explain in 500 words or fewer, why travel matters to you and to the world right now, and how your mastery of the craft can help inspire travel.

#### **Those applying for the SATW Foundation Ed Stone Scholarship:**

Please send 6 photographs that demonstrate a basic technical understanding of photography. Photographs should be submitted as jpeg attachments.

**Those applying for either scholarship:** Please also write a paragraph of 100 words or fewer explaining why you are the ideal candidate for this scholarship.
