

How to mount a Windows shared folder

On your Mac, from Finder's Go menu, press “Command-K”, to “Connect to Server.” Enter the server name, preceded by smb://, you'd use

“smb://HazenSD2.HSD.local/Student-Homes\$/", followed by your graduating year, forward slash, and your login name and then click on connect (not case-sensitive).

Now you'll get to choose which shared folder you want to mount on your Mac. In this case, we're going to choose the your graduating year, and then your username.

And you're done! Now the folder will be mounted on your Mac, and accessible from your desktop and in Finder. If you've

allowed reading and writing to the shared folder in Windows,
you can drag and drop and save files to it as if it were any disk.
