MEDICAL ADVICE (INCL. SANITATION + PPE)

This <u>Google Doc</u> contains the best practices for before, during, and after protests.

This <u>Twitter thread</u> contains reminders and new information about maintaining your respiratory health while protesting.

It is best not to bring prescription medications to the protests. If you do, you're encouraged to bring the bottle containing your prescription. While police may not allow you to take them while detained, your best bet is to have them in the bottle they came in.

Avoid wearing your contacts! Tear gas is particularly harmful for you!

SOCIAL MEDIA AND COMMUNICATION

For people doing the heavy lifting on the ground: <u>A resource on deleting your</u> <u>digital footprint</u>. It's best policy not to post excessively about what you're wearing, who you're going with, etc. to avoid drawing additional attention to yourself.

Many people have recommended using 'Signal' to communicate! It is more secure than your DMs on Twitter or IG. <u>More on Signal here</u>. <u>More tips on making</u> <u>your phone more secure</u> (Thread)

The best policy is to watch what you text and to make sure you're not including your location on your social media posts. Turn off your location!

→ What to do if ICE comes to your door

- Do not open doors: ICE cannot come in without a signed warrant by a criminal court judge. They can only come in if you let them in.
- Remain silent: ICE can use anything you say against you in your immigration case so claim your right to remain silent ("I plead the fifth amendment and choose to remain silent")
- <u>Do not sign</u>: Don't sign anything ICE gives you without talking to an attorney

- <u>Report and Record</u>: Take pictures and video unless you're on federal government property. Take notes of badge numbers, number of agents, time, type of car, and exactly what happened (UWD hotline 1-844-363-1423)
- Fight back: Get a trustworthy attorney to explore all options to fight your case. If detained, you may be able to get bail - don't give up hope! Join your local team to defend yourself from enforcement!
