Are you registered to vote in PA? If not, would you like to be?

Everything you'll need is at https://bucknell.turbovote.org/ Thirty days of residence in PA makes U.S. citizens eligible to become a PA voter. If you are registered and do not need to change your address, request a ballot by mail.

October 19th is the deadline to register to vote.

If you are registered in another state & want to switch, register via <u>TurboVote</u> The PA elections office does not remove individuals from the rolls in their home state. Voters need to remove themselves from their home state if they are registering in PA.

Register on your phone using TurboVote (can do any state and Mail In requests too)

Use the BU TurboVote QR code or type in the url https://bucknell.turbovote.org/
Make sure to list your name as it appears on your state issued ID

Make sure to list your dorm name and campus mailbox # in the address section

If you don't have a PA driver's license, TurboVote will ask you to upload your signature

This signature certification is NOT available on the PA Dept. of State's page but rather requires a dual, follow up mail in certification

Vote early by **requesting your ballot by mail BEFORE October 27** (the deadline) Once you've filled out your ballot, put it in the included secrecy envelope and the return envelope, and sign the outside envelope – send it back as soon as possible. It's recommended that you drop off, rather than mail-in your ballot, if it's 10 days or less before the election.

You can register, pick up and drop off your ballot in person at your county elections office. If you need more information to make decisions about your ballot, here's the <u>local voting guide</u>

If you wish to vote in person on Nov. 3rd, find your polling place and/or consult BU posters
