TRAVEL ITINERARY:

DAY 1		XX:XX	Arrival in Tashkent. The guide and driver will warmly welcome you at the outdoor waiting area of Tashkent International Airport. After your arrival, enjoy a short rest before setting off to discover a city where ancient heritage meets modern elegance. Hotel check-in is available from 2:00 PM.
Arrival in Tashkent Meals: Breakfast		10:00-13:00	Exploring the magnificent Khast Imam Complex , one of the city's most important spiritual and historical landmarks Experiencing the lively atmosphere of Chorsu Bazaar , a colorful market filled with local flavors, spices, and traditional crafts
		13:30-14:30	Lunch time
		15:00-17:00	Riding the iconic Tashkent Metro , famous for its beautifully designed stations, including Kosmonavtlar, Alisher Navoi, Paxtakor, and Mustaqillik Maydoni. Enjoying a relaxing walk through Sayilgoh Street, the lively heart of the city, where you will admire landmarks such as Amir Temur Square, the State Museum of the Temurids, the first hotel in Uzbekistan, and the Palace of Congresses from the outside.

		18:30	Return to the hotel. Rest and overnight

DAY 2		08:00	Meet the driver at the hotel entrance. Transfer to the airport.
Tashkent –Sariasiya morning flight to Sariasiya with Silk Avia		10:00-11:15	Upon arrival, transfer to the scenic Topalang Valley . Sariasiya (Sariosiyo) in the Surkhandarya Region offers untouched panoramic mountain landscapes, distinguished by the towering Hisar range and river valleys. The area contains striking alpine views, deep canyons, and traditional highland villages, providing remote and dramatic scenery perfect for exploration.
		13:30-14:30	Lunch time
Transfer to To'palang valley 30 min		15:00-18:00	The To'palang Reservoir in the Sariasiya District of Surkhandarya is famous for its 180-meter dam—the highest in Uzbekistan. For panoramic viewpoints, the best spots are the elevated ridges and winding mountain roads that surround the reservoir and overlook the dam and the Topalang HPD Holding hydroelectric facilities. Villages like Khufor, Khondiza, and Zokhona are nestled deep in the mountains (between 2,500 to 2,800 meters).

		19:00	Return to the accommodation mountain guesthouse.

DAY 3		08:00	Meet the guide and driver transfer to Water reservoir (Omonkhona)
Excursion to Omonkhona Reservoir By car 3 hours		11:00-14:00	Upon arrival sightseeing in Omonkhona . Located in the northern part of the oasis opposite the Zovbashi mountain in the Boysun district is the " Omonkhona " is a balneological complex. The sanatorium also offers dozens of additional services, including electrotherapy, massage, phytotherapy, diagnostics, and ultrasound. Patients suffering from diabetes, cardiovascular, liver, and spinal diseases are being treated at the sanatorium. The freshness and tranquility of the mountainous landscape can attract tourists.

Ride the Sangardak Cable Car		8:00	Meet the guide and transfer to Sangardak.
Meals: Breakfast			
		9:00-11:00	Upon arrival, sightseeing in Sariasiya district , the premier destination is the majestic Sangardak Waterfall , which cascades over 120 meters down emerald moss-covered cliffs. The site features a well-developed network of viewing platforms, bridges, and stairs, allowing visitors to view the waterfall from multiple perspectives. The specific cable car system you are referring to is located in the Sariasiya District (Surxondaryo Region) as part of the newly developed Sangardak Tourist Center . The massive 1.8-kilometer cable car system takes visitors across the breathtaking Hissar mountain range directly toward the famous Sangardak Waterfall , including directly below the plunging mist.

Transfer to Termez by car 3.5 hours		15:00-19:30	Arrival in Termez and dinner

DAY 5			
Meals: Breakfast		8:00-09:30	Sightseeing in Termez. Fayoztepa (sometimes spelled Fayaz-Tepa) is an ancient Buddhist monastery complex located in Termez, in southern Uzbekistan. Dating back to the 1st–3rd centuries CE during the Kushan Empire, it is one of Central Asia's oldest Buddhist sites, famous for its well-preserved stupas and wall paintings. The Hakim at-Termizi Mausoleum is a prominent Islamic pilgrimage site located on the outskirts of Old Termez, Uzbekistan. The original structure and tomb were built in the 9th century near the medieval citadel of Termez.

Transfer to Kampirtepa 2 hours		09:30-13:00	Kampirtepa is an ancient, fortified port city on the Amu Darya (Oxus) River in southern Uzbekistan. Established in the late 4th century BC—likely during the Central Asian campaigns of Alexander the Great—it served as a vital river crossing, customs post, and harbor. The Surkhan Valley (Surkhandarya) in southern Uzbekistan is an emerald oasis bordered by the soaring Pamir, Gissar, and Babatag mountain ranges. It is famous for jaw-dropping, high-altitude nature, vividly colored gorges, and ancient Silk Road history.

		13:30-14:00	Lunch time
Transfer to Derbent Gorge (Iron Gate) 2 hours		14:00-16:00	Exploring to Derbent Gorge is a legendary natural and historical chasm in the Baysun Mountain. Famous for its 400-meter-tall limestone cliffs, the gorge narrows to just 15 meters at points, blocking out the sun except at high noon. The name Derbent translates from Persian as " closed gate " or " narrow passage ". After exploring then transfer to Samarkand.
Arrival in Samarkand		17:00-22:00	Dinner and overnight stay

DAY 6			
Samarkand full day		8:00-13:30	Sightseeing in Samarkand. It is the remarkable Ulugh Beg Observatory (15th century), one of the greatest astronomical observatories of the medieval world. Built by the renowned Timurid ruler and astronomer Ulugh Beg, this fascinating site offers a glimpse into the advanced scientific achievements of the Silk Road era. Discover the ancient instruments and innovative techniques once used to map the stars and explore the mysteries of the universe centuries ahead of their time. Exploring the peaceful Imam al-Bukhari Memorial Complex , dedicated to the world-famous Islamic scholar Imam al-Bukhari, one of the most respected figures in Islamic history. This spiritual and beautifully designed complex is an important pilgrimage site and a place of reflection and cultural heritage.

		14:00-15:00	Lunch time
		15:00-17:00	Visiting the magnificent Gur-e-Amir Mausoleum (14th–15th centuries), the final resting place of the great Amir Temur (Tamerlane). Built during the Timurid era, this architectural masterpiece continues to captivate visitors from around the world with its elegance, grandeur, and stunning blue dome. Exploring the world-famous Registan Square (15th–17th centuries), the true heart of ancient Samarkand, surrounded by the majestic Ulugbek ,

			Tillakori, and Sherdor madrasahs — some of the finest examples of Islamic architecture in the world. Discovering the mystical beauty of the Shah-i-Zinda Necropolis, a sacred complex of beautifully decorated mausoleums known for its dazzling mosaics and spiritual significance. Admiring the impressive Bibi-Khanym Mosque (14th–15th centuries), once one of the grandest mosques in the Islamic world and a symbol of Amir Temur's powerful empire.

Located on the territory of the international business center Tashkent City. Magic City Tashkent ("Tashkent Disneyland") is a modern amusement park in Tashkent that was opened several years ago. Both adults and children will find the visit to this park interesting and enjoyable. The park opens at 10 am and closes at 10 pm. In the morning, there are usually few visitors, but more and more people come around lunchtime and later.
