Class Description:

Workability is a training program for special education students ages 18-22 who have completed school through the twelfth grade with a Certificate of Completion. It is designed to promote career awareness and exploration. It provides students with opportunities for job shadowing, paid and non –paid work experience, and ongoing support and guidance from vocational personnel.

Transition to Adult Life includes independent living skills such as money management, domestic skills, community resources, and social skills.

Students will learn:

- To identify post school career interests and skills needed.
- On and off-campus work experience (when available).
- Career preparation skills such as filling out applications, interview, create and update resumes, and maintain a portfolio.
- To be as independent as possible in their daily life.

Teacher Statement:

Our goal is to prepare students for life outside of the public school system. Students will need to have consistent attendance and good work ethics to do well in this class.
