2022 Fort Recovery District Report Card Summary

The students, parents and entire staff of Fort Recovery Schools should be proud of the continuous improvement of our academic success as assessed by the Ohio Department of Education. On Thursday, September 15th, ODE released school building and district data from the end of the school year testing results for 2022.

This year, the Ohio Department of Education is using a 1 through 5 rating in 5 major academic related areas. They include: Achievement, Progress, Gap Closing, Graduation, and Early Literacy. For the Fall of 2022, ODE will not provide an overall rating. This will occur in 2023, but the five areas will not be weighted evenly. A sixth area, College, Career, Workforce and Military Readiness Component, will be added after the 2024-2025 school year.

Fort Recovery's Achievement Rating



standards in academic achievement

This component represents whether student performance on state tests met established thresholds and how well students performed on tests overall.

Fort Recovery's Progress Rating



the district exceeded student growth expectations by a larger magnitude Simply put, academic growth is measured by looking at the current achievement compared to prior achievement results on Ohio's State Tests. Educators in Ohio call this a value-added rating.

Fort Recovery's Gap Closing Rating



standards in closing educational gaps

Gap Closing rates how a district's subgroups demonstrate mastery of academic content through their assessments.

Fort Recovery's Graduation Rating



graduation rates This rating is based on graduation rates of a grade level cohort (ex. Class of 2021) after four years of education and after five years from the start of high school.

Fort Recovery's Early Literacy Rating



literacy (K-3)

The Early Literacy Component measures reading improvement and proficiency for students in kindergarten through third grade. The majority of the data is pulled from the 3rd Grade ELA test.

As the school district evaluates our progress related to the academic goals of the 2021-2024 Culture and Commitment Guide, we all can be proud of the gains we have achieved.

This year we exceeded one of our goals for the Fall of 2024. That goal was to meet 85% of the state indicators. We had a modest improvement goal of a 2% increase in the percentage of district indicators that we would meet each school year. Over the past two years, the district has progressed to achieving 95% of the state achievement indicators.

The school district performance index is also a key measure because it evaluates all schools in the same manner. Based on the State of Ohio annual assessments, students receive 1.0 points for a proficient testing area. Each student's score can range from Limited Proficient 0.3 points to Advanced Plus 1.3 points on every assessment they take each year. Untested assessments have a drastic effect on the scores, as they count as a 0. The combined scores of all of the tests X the associated point factors gives the district a performance index score. This year, our district performance index improved from 99.7 up to 102.7. This score places Fort Recovery at #34 in the Ohio Performance Index Rankings for 2022. That is higher than 825 other public school districts and community schools in Ohio.

We are striving for a district performance index score of 106.7 by the Fall of 2024. Our students are on track to achieve this high reaching goal.
