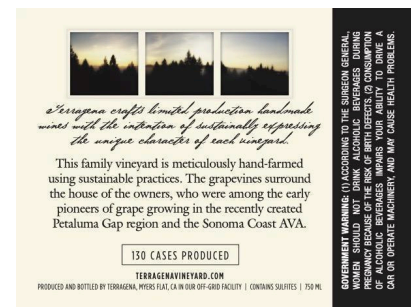
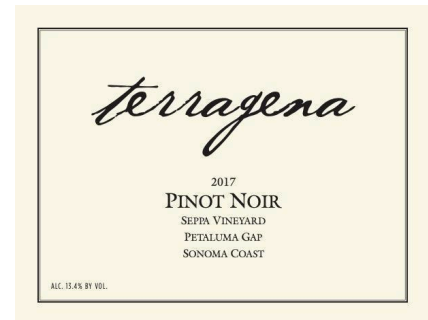

This family-owned vineyard is certified as a Sonoma County sustainable vineyard. From the Seppa family: *The Seppa farm has been in the family since 1902. In 2001 Don Seppa planted his first Pinot Noir grapes on two separate slopes of land. Located in Penngrrove, Sonoma County, the diurnal temperatures can range up to 40+ degrees, and the valley experiences a coastal fog layer that lends itself to a final wine with added complexity and acidity. The vineyard is 110 feet above sea level, and the vines are over 15 years old.*
