City Bike (OVO)	www.nextbike.co.uk	Download app to use. £1 for 30 mins Must pick up and drop off at parking spots (not anywhere). ***Make sure the return is registered, sometimes they glitch but you get a refund easily.
Subway (underground)	www.spt.co.uk	One circular line. You can't pay using a bank card. You will need a ticket - single, day pass or a card that you can top up. Last train 23:16 Last train on sunday 18:00 Ibrox stop is closest to the venue.
Train	www.nationalrail.co.uk	Check times due to strike action
Buses	Firstbus Stagecoach	Not that reliable. There are two operating companies. Pay using your bank card for a single trip in case you get back using a different operator.

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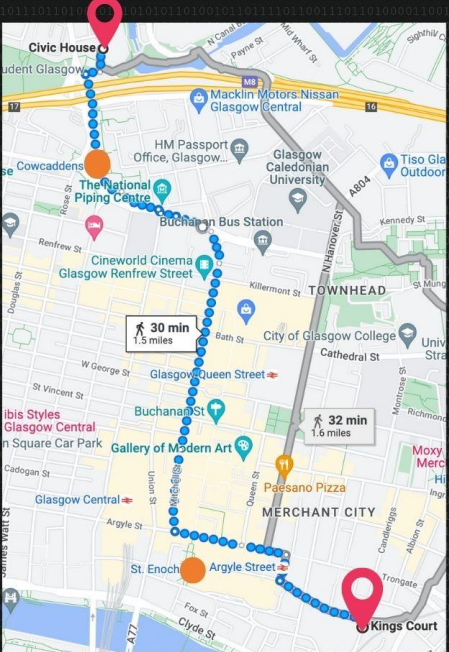
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subway
