

Data Availability Statement guidance

Note: Prior to submitting a manuscript for peer-reviewed publication, it is prudent to submit the experimental data that are used in that publication to ICARUS. If the data are not yet ready to be viewed publicly, the Data Contributor group may set an “embargo” date and time for when the data may be published. This way, the data links will be ready in time for paper submission.

When writing a data availability statement, the Data Contributor may choose to provide a link to the Experiment Set. This works well when the Experiment Set is organized to include all of the Experiments that are relevant to one publication. The link of the Experiment Set list all of the experiment DOIs individually.

For example:

“The chamber experiment data used in this study are available in the Integrated Chamber Atmospheric data Repository for Unified Science (ICARUS) database: (<https://icarus.ucdavis.edu/experimentset/256>).”

The Data Contributor may choose to provide DOI links to each individual Experiments. This may be useful if Experiments from different Sets have been used to compile a manuscript.

For example:

“The chamber experiment data used in this study are available in the Integrated Chamber Atmospheric data Repository for Unified Science (ICARUS) database, via the following data object identifiers (DOIs): <https://doi.org/10.5065/psfa-0134>; <https://doi.org/10.5065/92cq-j160>; <https://doi.org/10.5065/0anb-2j91>; <https://doi.org/10.5065/az5x-kd02>; and <https://doi.org/10.5065/4qyk-z803>.”
