Research Question:

Is SCP-1048-D capable of using their portals of traveling into SCP-106's pocket dimension through their *own* means, rather than contact with 106? And if so, could SCP-1048-D be able to create rifts inside the pocket dimension to allow for the retrieval and escape of the pocket dimension? Or, would SCP-1048-D be unable to open dimensional tears into SCP-106's pocket dimension from outside, and would rather have to be inside it, to open a rift within, that may lead back to the Site. Regardless, with this test, the hope is to get a glimpse into the cross dimensional anomalous capabilities that these two SCPs have. And, if SCP-1048-D is capable of traveling into the pocket dimension and opening tears inside, it could be used for getting MTF, SD, and FP out of the pocket dimension to avoid loss of life.

Hypothesis:	SCP-1048-D is known to have been created by using some sort of material stolen by the Void Guardians / Void Mothers. It is what grants the Bear their ability to open tears in reality, and teleport across the entire Site as he pleases. And the Void Guardians must have some sort of their own split dimension in which they reside in, as the crystals in Pathos have never been found on Earth before. However, does that mean SCP-1048-D would be able to even travel into SCP-106's pocket dimension? Well, I'd say <i>yes</i> . If SCP-1048-D seemingly has some sort of ability which allows him to map out the entire Facility, as he can teleport wherever he wants too. And it seems he knows where large crowds of people are as well. Assuming the void guardians do have their own alternate realm which is where they open portals too, then surely SCP-1048-D would be able to send himself into SCP-106's pocket dimension, or open a tear inside it.	
	However, there are some complications. There is only <i>one</i> way inside SCP-106's pocket dimension so far; that being 106 himself. To put it bluntly, SCP-106 very well is a walking, talking, and lethal portal into a twisted dimension. With our inability to take any samples of the corrosive tissue he is made of, it seems SCP-106 is the only means to get inside the pocket dimension, and 1048-D may only be able to open a rift inside if he has been in there beforehand. Seeing as Void has supposedly not traveled to this supposed realm the Void Guardians reside in, it may be that Void is incapable of this interdimensional travel like the Void Guardians may be, and thus may be unable to enter SCP-106's pocket dimension, without any experience of venturing into other dimensions like the Void Guardians may have.

-[Testing Results]-

I arrived at Site Omicron and requested a large amount of Class-D. Six, to be exact. Due to the severity of the test, I only allowed trusted Scientific Personnel to spectate. Thus, the only spectators that arrived were a majority of Medium Command, and one Research Specialist. When the six Class-D's were brought out by two Security Department personnel, we loaded up on a few humvees and ATV's, and drove to Site Epsilon. The large group came to a halt, as we quickly lined up. I had requested for any Crimson-9 Personnel to respond, but unfortunately, none were present. After a few communications with a C-9 sergeant, they authorized an SRU Specialist to escort the 106 test with several other trusted Military Police operatives.

With the SRU now taking over as escort, they briefed us at the Epsilon checkpoint. After a quick check, we all agreed to abide by the brief at all times, and we were all asked if we were armed or not. We were told for the duration of this test we were unable to utilize our firearms at any point, regardless of the situation. After that, we passed the second pair of gates, and we rallied the Class-D's and spectators onto trucks, as we drove to the MCZ. As we drove to SCP-1048's CC, SCP-082 decided to join our caravan, joining the group of spectators. As we disembarked from the vehicles, I got off, and went in alone with the SRU and SCP-082 to speak with SCP-1048-D. As I moved inside to explain to SCP-1048-D why I wanted to meet

with him today, SCP-1048-G and SCP-1048-F emerged, standing behind Void and seemingly conversing with one another.

As I spoke with Void, I told him his part in this large test on SCP-106. After giving a brief summary, he turned to SCP-1048-G, as if asking for confirmation on whether or not he could go. After a nod from SCP-1048-G, SCP-1048-D turned to me, and nodded. With the confirmation from Void, we got back into the cars, and we set off for the HCZ, the several neutral SCP's who had been watching followed not far behind. We arrived at the HCZ, and stopped before SCP-106's CC. The SRU gave a short brief alongside Military Police, regarding the guidelines for SCP-106's containment. After the brief, we all agreed to abide by the brief, and we were allowed inside. The spectators filed into the viewing area, whilst I remained on the catwalk with the several 1048 instances, and combative personnel.

I briefed SCP-1048-D once more on his part in the test, before I briefed the Class-D, on how they would be sent in two groups. Three would go in, and be sent to the pocket dimension, and would not go through any of the doors at all. The other group would go in only under specific circumstances. I turned back to SCP-1048-D after briefing the Class-D's, pulling him aside. I asked him if he could try to open a rift inside the pocket dimension, or teleport himself inside through his wormhole ability. He shrugged, unknowing if he was able to do so. I then asked him the question, if there were living people inside the pocket dimension, would he find it easier to get inside through his own means? Once more he shrugged, and he looked at me and the Class-D, seemingly wanting the first group to go in to see if their presence in the pocket dimension would make it easier.

The first group was sent in. Three Class-D were dropped inside 106's containment chamber, and whilst watching through the cameras, it didn't take long for SCP-106 to reveal himself. Hunting down the Class-D's in his chamber, he sent both of them to the pocket dimension. With confirmation that they were now in the pocket dimension, I turned back to SCP-1048-D and asked him to attempt to open a rift into the pocket dimension, or send himself into the pocket dimension via his teleportation abilities. He nodded, and I watched as Mugger moved through the catwalk rapidly, as if analyzing the containment chamber of SCP-106. I watched him slice a knife into the air, teleporting, and opening a rift. But it closed instantly, and SCP-1048-D was not in the pocket dimension. In fact, he was gone for a short period, before returning. He was teleporting rather strangely, as if trying to find a way to breach himself into SCP-106's pocket dimension. Unfortunately it seemed to be of no avail. This continued frequently, and when I asked SCP-1048-D if he would be willing to be attacked by 106 and try to escape the pocket dimension from inside with his own portals, he became angered, slicing his knife at myself and an Adept Researcher, and moving to a wall. This pattern of SCP-1048-D teleporting frantically, trying to find a way inside continued for a long period, before he confirmed to me that he was unable to enter SCP-106's pocket dimension. Not with his own portals. Before we were able to leave, the Chief of Security kept the group inside due to SCP-682's behavior in the HCZ. He had broken through the gates, and was rampaging in Epsilon. YE was declared due to 682's anger, and we were left inside the CC with a Security Agent. Suddenly, from unknown means, SCP-106 somehow breached; escaping his CC, and massacring everyone in his CC. Red Heron was declared; but surprisingly, the interesting results I got was in the *breach*, and not the test itself.

We had all arrived at Site Phi after SCP-106 and SCP-682 started rampaging throughout the facility. However, whilst we were in Phi, SCP-1048-D suddenly appeared. Urging myself, and several other Foundation Personnel to come closer, where he suddenly opened a rift, pointing towards it, asking us to get inside. We obliged, and we ended up at the gates of Site Epsilon. As the rift closed, I heard on the radio nearly a minute after that SCP-106 had arrived in Site Phi. The realization hit, that SCP-1048-D saved us.

After Red Heron ended, I ran back to SCP-1048-D, asking him a few questions. The main question I asked was; did he know SCP-106 was coming to Site Phi beforehand? Or was it just a hunch? In which he shrugged; indicating to me that there was a chance that SCP-1048-D may have sensed SCP-106 beforehand. Why else would he open a portal at such perfect timing?

-[Conclusion]-

It is unfortunate that SCP-1048-D was unable to breach inside SCP-106's Pocket Dimension; but, the results I had garnered were not entirely useless. Whilst SCP-1048-D was unable to enter SCP-106's pocket dimension, he was still capable of supposedly knowing that SCP-106 would be coming to Phi, and opened a portal for several FP to escape before he arrived at Site Phi. Now, what does this mean? Well; perhaps the anomalies which are able to utilize these teleportation, cross dimensional abilities are not so different after all. Perhaps they operate on a similar scale, their abilities able to conflict with one another.

Look at SCP-106, SCP-1048-D, and the Void Guardians. SCP-106 is by all means; a walking wormhole. His living tissue is made of a corrosive substance capable of sending anyone to his wicked pocket dimension, capable of traversing through any form of solid matter. Meanwhile, the Void Guardians, and SCP-1048-D have much different means of using their cross dimensional abilities. Rather than their physical bodies being the conduit of which they travel, they seem to use parts of it. The Void Guardians for example, have their highly lethal claws, which they use to open tears in reality to teleport to their realm. SCP-1048-D is the same; using his small knife to open a tear, exactly like the Void Guardians; and his second means of teleportation, again, is not like 106's. Sending his own physical body via a wormhole which he can open.

With the above listed, this leads me to believe that SCP-106's means of cross dimensional abilities are much more 'advanced' than that of the Void Guardians and SCP-1048-D. In my own words, I would describe SCP-106 as a sentient, conscious, and sadistic wormhole; his abilities to send victims to the pocket dimension, and his ability to traverse through all physical matter is unmatched by all other cross dimensional capabilities. SCP-1048-D, and as far as we know, not even the Void Guardians are even close to such capabilities, which only further shows the lethality and danger of SCP-106. Whilst their abilities may operate on a similar plane, to where cross dimensional anomalies are able to sense other 'living' beings like 106, traveling via their teleportation, and cross dimensional abilities, I do believe SCP-106 is far more advanced with his capabilities, much more than the Void Guardians, and SCP-1048-D.
