- Each delegate will need to be prepared to complete research in order to create a 2 page position paper which will focus on a country's position on a certain topic of debate.
- Demonstrate Oak Middle Schools' Core Values while attending the conference.
- Students must be able to attend the conference on Saturday, 4/27/24 from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm and be able to get a ride to and from the event on their own.

What is the objective of the club?
