



Spotlight!



Fr. Theo Lange; Parochial Vicar

Shining a light on the Employees who make the St. Anthony Community feel like Home.

Early Life and Family Background

- Grew up in Salem, Oregon; attended St. Joseph's Catholic School and Church. Graduated from Sprague High School, where he played football, basketball, and baseball.
- Comes from a large family with three older sisters and one younger brother.

Education and Early Career

- Began engineering studies and baseball at Lane Community College. Shoulder injuries ended his baseball career and prompted a life transition that opened him to deeper spiritual interests.
- At 19, he assisted with a high school youth group and co-led a Bible study for athletes with a teammate.

Vocational Discernment and Ministry Path

- After Lane, he worked for a family friend who manufactured chiropractic equipment, which allowed greater participation in daily Mass and parish life.
- Enjoyed hands-on engineering and manual work. Became a youth minister at St. Jude's in Eugene at age 21
- Grew increasingly involved in spiritual reading, church groups, and daily Mass. Entered a four-year discernment process that was eventually guided by a Maronite hermit who lived in Beaverton at the time. A discernment retreat led him to choose seminary. Studied at Mount Angel Seminary for three years, then completed five years of additional formation and Study with the Jesuits in Rome at the Gregorian University.



Priesthood and Ministry Assignments

- Entered Seminary at 23 and was ordained a priest on the feast of St. Anthony at the age of 31. First assignment was in Southern Oregon for two years, where he learned Spanish.
- Spent five years on faculty at Mount Angel Seminary, working in undergraduate discernment and teaching at both undergrad and graduate levels.
- Desiring parish work, he became pastor in Venita and chaplain at Marist High School (five years). Served as State Chaplain for the Knights of Columbus for eight years. Appointed a Missionary of Mercy by Pope Francis, which involved preaching, conventions, and visits to Rome. Lived in Miami, FL for 6 months being a part of a Religious group but discerned a call back to direct parish ministry. Returned to the Archdiocese of Portland and covered Sweet Home parish from December 2024 to July 2025.

Influences and Mentors

- Deeply influenced by his family—especially his older sister Mary, known for her integrity and faith. She served as his confirmation sponsor and guided him through spiritual questioning in college.

Hobbies, Pastimes, and Fun Facts

- Played on a state-champion, nationally ranked high-school baseball team while at Sprague High School.
- Worked various jobs including lumber mill work, helping in his grandmother's flower shop while in Kindergarten, and picked blueberries on a friends family farm.
- Loves to play golf and has played numerous Jack Nicklaus courses in the US & Mexico. And enjoys fishing, hiking, and remodeling houses.

Aspirations, Skills, and Bucket List

- Would love to instantly master equipment design and manufacturing; interested in creating machines that produce affordable, disaster-resistant building materials by compressing dirt and cement.

What He Loves About St. Anthony

- Loves the size, energy, and multicultural life of the parish. Values serving alongside Father John and especially appreciates the school. Enjoys active engagement with the Hispanic community. Feels at home in a large, vibrant parish reminiscent of his upbringing at St. Joseph's in Salem. Views St. Anthony as a "full circle" return to his roots—and he loves that the mascot is the Hawks! :-)

Challenge Goal



Raise or have Pledged **\$1.8 million** by **January 1st, 2026** to complete the necessary fundraising efforts for the M.S. New Addition & Remodel

Thank you again to those of you who contributed on Giving Tuesday. We are still awaiting the final totals from the matching gifts we received!

Let us review how different pledge levels break down on a per-day basis. Seeing the daily cost may **highlight** how even a small commitment can create substantial impact.

- **\$100,000** → 3 year pledge → \$33,333.33 a year → **\$2,777.77 a month** → \$92.59 a day
- **\$50,000** → 3 year pledge → \$16,666.67 a year → **\$1,388.89 a month** → \$46.30 a day
- **\$25,000** → 3 year pledge → \$8,333.33 a year → **\$694.44 a month** → \$23.15 a day
- **\$10,000** → 3 year pledge → \$3,333.33 a year → **\$277.77 a month** → \$9.25 a day
- **\$5,000** → 3 year pledge → \$1,666.67 a year → **\$138.89 a month** → \$4.62 a day
- **\$2,500** → 3 year pledge → \$833.33 a year → **\$69.44 a month** → \$2.31 a day
- **\$1,000** → 3 year pledge → \$333.33 a year → **\$27.77 a month** → less than a \$1 a day


