# The goal:

To finish all of the vocabulary, writing and reading activities in the workbook that you haven't done throughout the year.

## The reasoning:

It is important to practise language consecutively (without breaks) in order to best retain (keep) knowledge and skills over time.

### What should you do?

Go over each page of the workbook. If you have done it, great! If you haven't, check what it practises.

If it's grammar that we learned, do it. If it's a grammar topic we didn't study in class, skip (לפסוח/לדלג) it.

If it's vocabulary, reading comprehension (AKA "unseens") or writing tasks, complete them.
