

Ranked Choice Voting enactments and usage

The States of Maine and Alaska use Ranked Choice Voting statewide for federal and state offices. Five more states use Ranked Choice Voting for military and overseas voters to participate in runoff elections: Arkansas, Alabama, Louisiana, Mississippi, and South Carolina. Major political parties use RCV in 7 states. Twenty-three U.S. cities have enacted Ranked Choice Voting for their local elections.

(Code Key: S = statewide; O = overseas/military voting; P = party primaries & nominations; L = local elections)
