WELCOME ROCK EQUIPMENT LIST 2024



The High Country is notorious for its rain, cold temperatures and high winds so it is imperative that children have a SEAM SEALED WATERPROOF JACKET and 2 pairs of shoes for walking / tramping in. It could be very cold, therefore students must have warm clothes.

Please ensure ALL items are named.

All items to be packed into a soft sports bag, pack, overnight bag etc. Not a suitcase. We have very limited space for transporting gear, please do not overpack

- 1 Pillow
- 1 Sleeping bag (inside waterproof plastic bag if it can't go in the bag)
- Bed roll or self inflating or self blown mattress
- 1 Warm Pajamas
- 1 Pair of shoes/boots with good grip for hiking outside
- 1 Pair sports shoes for travelling and around camp
- 4 Sets of underwear
- 4 pairs of socks suitable for hiking - thick/merino/thermal
- 3 Complete changes of clothes (1 set worn on first day) e.g. shorts, leggings, t/shirt, woollen jersey/polar fleece/polyprop /track pants (NO JEANS)
- 1 Polypro or merino/wool long leggings (Thermals) NOT COTTON OR POLYESTER
- 2 Polypro or merino/wool tops (Thermals) NOT COTTON OR POLYESTER
- Toiletries - toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Small personal hand sanitizer
- Deodorant
- Face cloth
- 1 small Towel
- Brush / comb
- 3 Plastic bags (dirty gear)

Packed into a daypack (preferably waterproof- if not these items should be inside a plastic bag)

- 1 Named drink bottle
- 1 Mighty packed lunch for day 1 including morning tea
- 1 **Seam Sealed Waterproof Jacket - Not a puffer**
- 1 Sunhat
- 1 Sunscreen
- 1 Beanie (wool or polar fleece)
- 1 Pair woolen or polar fleece mittens or gloves

Other items:

- **Own Medication if required, in a named plastic bag (to be signed in with teacher on departure day)**
- Ditty bag containing: plastic or metal plate, bowl, cup, knife, fork and spoon, 1 x named teatowel
- Paperback Book/cards/small teddy bear or comfort toy
- Torch
- Aqua shoes, crocs or similar closed toed jandal or gym shoes for the creek, These will get wet
- Gumboots (optional) - last year there were a lot of cow pats around the campsite!
- Ice cream container of homebaking or equivalent for morning & afternoon tea (preferable in a square type container for easy stacking/transportation) No nuts please. To be collected in the hall prior to departure

No cellphones, jewellery, electronics

Please do not over-pack as we have limited room on buses & in 4wd's

If you have trouble sourcing items, please let the class teacher know or speak with someone in the office so we are able to help. There is a mandatory gear check at school prior to going on camp on **Friday 16th February**. All items highlighted in yellow must be brought into school to be checked by the classroom teacher and will return home with students on this day.
