

Reassessment Policy

AP Government

- Students are eligible for a reassessment on a quiz or assignment only if the original score is below 80%. This does not include essays.
- Students can not score higher than 80% on a reassessment unless otherwise specified.
- Essays can be retaken, regardless of the original score, and earn up to 100%.
- Students will be allowed only one reassessment for each summative assessment.
- A reassessment is available only if all of that unit's assignments have been completed. (Submitting a partial assignment doesn't count as completion.)
- Reassessments must be completed within two weeks of the original due date, *except* for essays. Essay reassessments must be completed within two weeks after the grade is received.
- Given the nature of Political Science Journals, there is no reassessment opportunity. Complete and turn in on time.
- The same goes for DCA grades each quarter.
