#### Is Your Child <u>Ready</u> To Start Kindergarten?

Below is a list of basic things your child should know and be able to do before he or she enters kindergarten. If you send your child to us knowing these things, we can get right to the business of teaching kindergarten curriculum! Thank you, in advance, for working on the following with your child! #### <u>Things Your Child</u>

Should Know BEFORE Kindergarten

-Say their first and last name

-How to tie their shoes

-How to use scissors

-How to write their name

-How to recognize their name from a list

-How to take care of their own toilet needs

-How to button their own pants and buckle their own belt

-How to zip their own jacket

-Their phone number

-Sing/Recite their ABC's

-Take turns and share

teaching your child to read, write, and complete



#### <u>Kindergarten Registration</u>

After completing the initial online application, you will be contacted later in the Spring for a time to come to school for the screening.

You will need to have these ready to upload during online registration process.

- Your child's original birth certificate with the raised seal
- Proof of residence (examples are utility bill, lease agreement, tax bill)
- Copy of your child's current immunization record
- · Any court documents that pertain to your child
