## Lesson Plan for 7<sup>th</sup> grade core

- 1. all students must get their copy of Okay for Now from their locker at the beginning of school and immediately after lunch.
- 2. Students must not turn in any work directly to the substitute teacher, NOR should any work be left on the desk for Mr. Rodgers
- 3. Students should (see Class Staff chart near door) get notebooks.

Students will work on the following IN order (for maximum quiet and efficiency):

- 1. Journal Notebook:
- a. 15 minutes before sharing.
- b. Answer the prompt in a minimum of 200 words or more
- c. Prompt -
- i. Imagine that one side of your Isearch argument took over America and made all people follow that conclusion in actions, making the losing side of the argument illegal and punishable by life in prison...
- 1. What would the world look like?
- 2. What would be some advantages? Disadvantages?
- 3. Tell a story about a person living in this new world.
- d. After about 13.5 minutes, tell people to wrap up...
- e. Allow 3 4 students to share their journal, or summarize it with the class.
- f. When done notebooks should be returned to the file cabinet, by one person at each table.
- 2. Read Okay for Now 25 minutes max.
- a. Either students should read for the time, and take notes at the end of every chapter.
- b. Or students can work on the cartoon for their assigned chapters (see red and blue folders next to table near door).
  - Students must return their completed panels at the end of this activity.
- c. Books borrowed by students from the classroom MUST be returned to the teacher.
- 3. Computers Work on Isearch paragraphs (20 30 minutes):
- a. Get a teacher to open the computer cart
- b. Students will be writing some pairs need to work together and may whisper.
  - i. Due today Opposing Argument and rebuttal.

- ii. Due on Thursday Three paragraphs:
- 1. Discussion
- 2. Conclusion
- 3. Unanswered questions and related topics not covered.
- c. Computers must be returned and plugged in by the class staff at the end of class last five minutes.
- 4. Movie Fallback if the kids start to lose focus:
- a. Disc 2 in the DVD player.
- b. Turn on the stereo, DVD button. Turn on LCD projector switch on right side of body when facing the projector lens.
- c. Use the remote
- d. Disc 2 Life After Humans:
  - i. Period ½ start from very beginning.
  - ii. Period  $\frac{3}{4}$  start in the second chapter or show.
- 5. Make sure at end of day -
- a. the windows are locked,
- b. the computers are plugged in, cart is on, and locked.
