2. Updates on:

- a. 2024 Temporary Plan for Vertebrate Welfare in Research Proposals (Update as decided by CEIF leadership)
 - Companion animals communicated with Mars, Hills, & researcher at UIUC. In this case, Champion has come out to confirm standards already, so the researcher is good to go and just needs to write this into her proposal.
 - 1. Would have to confirm how we confirm for new researchers at new institutions moving forward.
 - ii. Farmed animals researcher match standards in country where they are based. Researcher standards by country (IACUC in U.S.) and there will two separate protocols for this
 - iii. IAB can decide whether they fund only the non-invasive portions of research or non-invasive plus invasive.
- b. 2024 Temporary Animal Welfare Statement for researchers at ESA
 - i. Meghan will draft a minimal statement to include with CEIF research statement that accompanies public presentations.

3. Governance Best Practices Conversation

 - Don't want to ever create a lack of unity between AWC and CEIF overall guidelines on these issues and believe these are overall leadership matters
- vi. Establish a process for 1) removing members that are not contributing in a timely manner; and 2) re-nomination if a member leaves during their two-year appointment
- Once finalized, this Governance document will be sent to CEIF leadership for review and then share the final document with the IAB.
