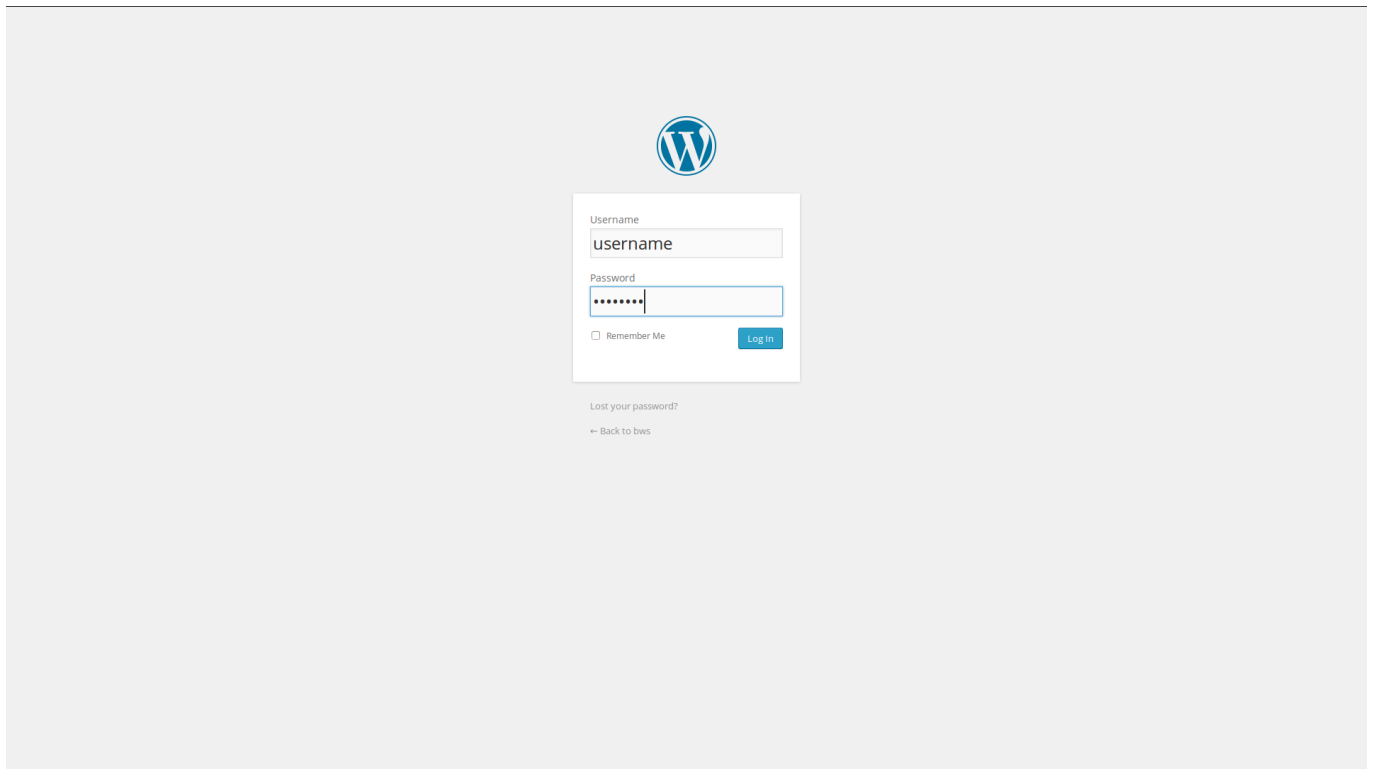

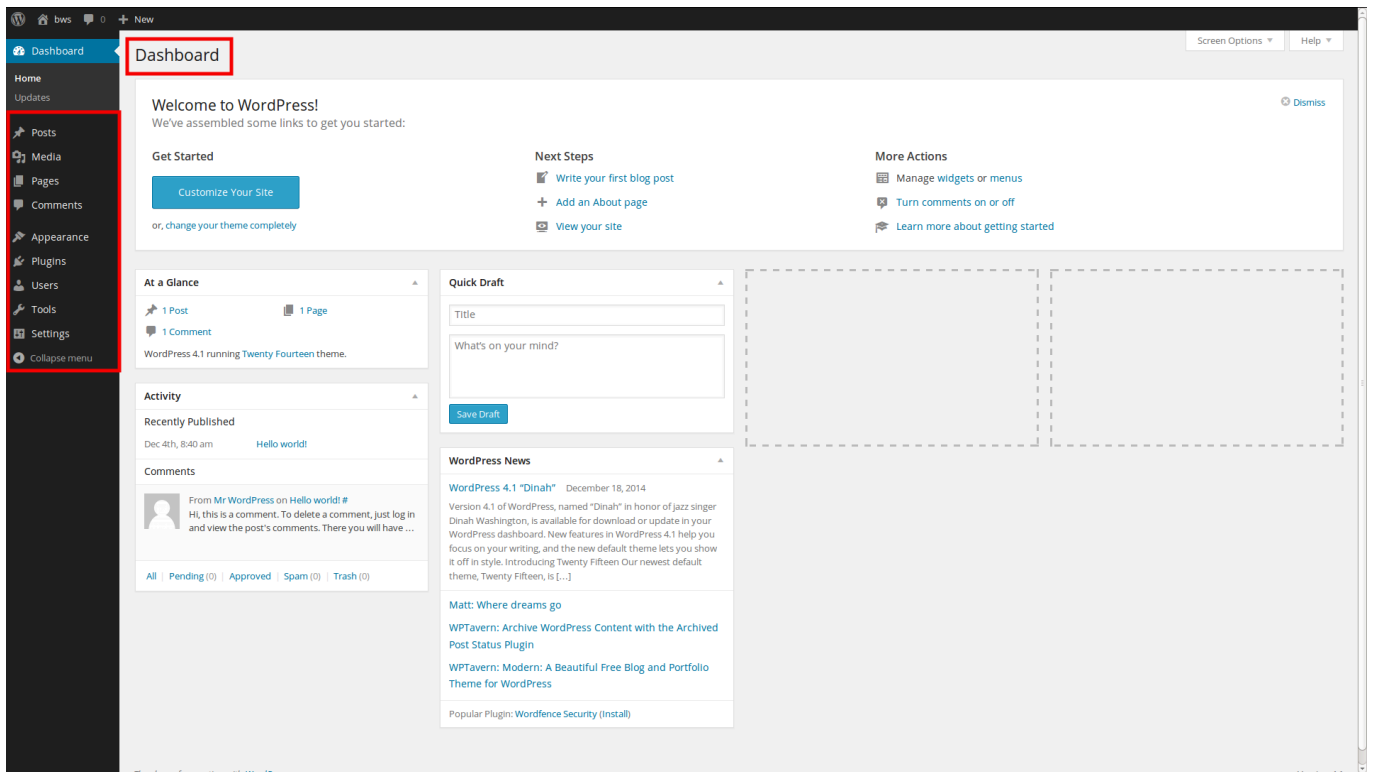

1. **Log in** to your site as an administrator.



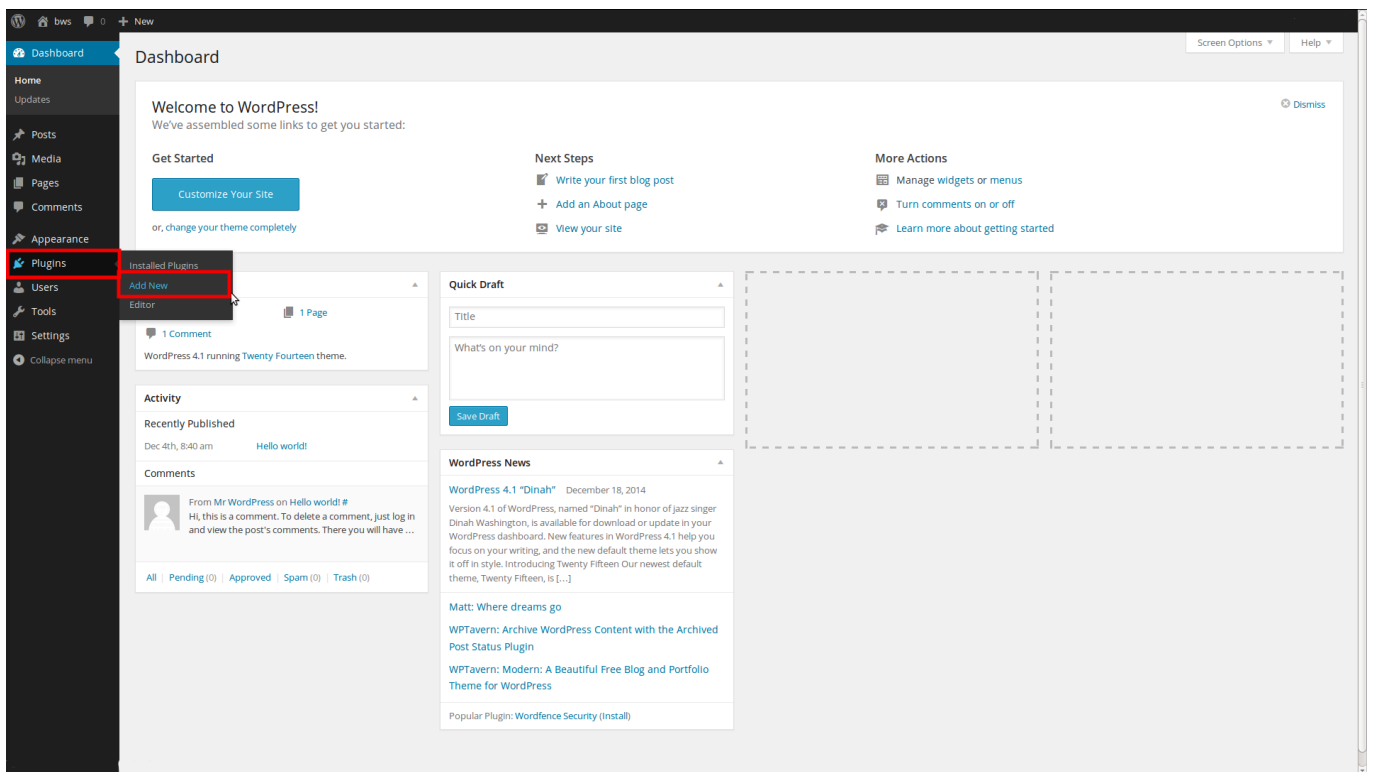
2. Go to your **Dashboard** and find the menu on your left.



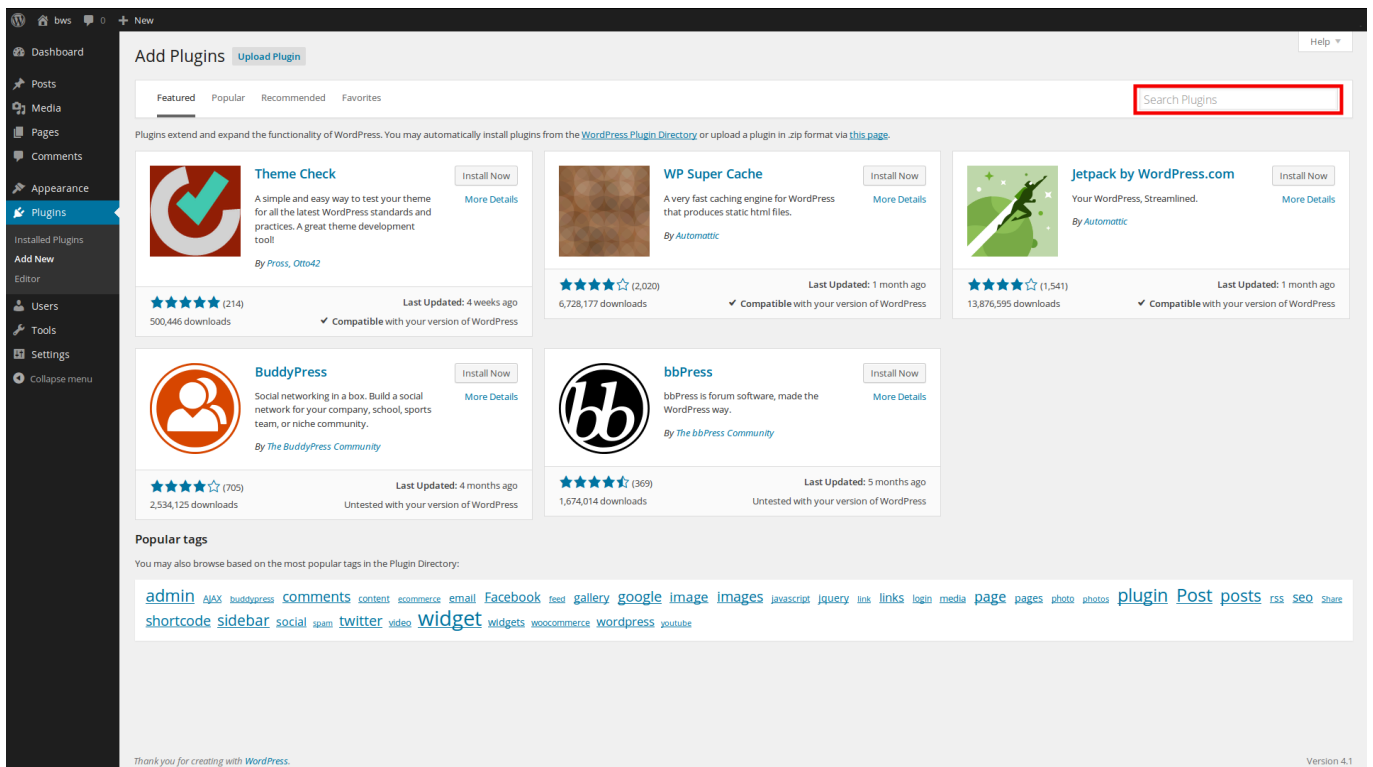
3. Select **"Plugins"** => **"Add new"**.

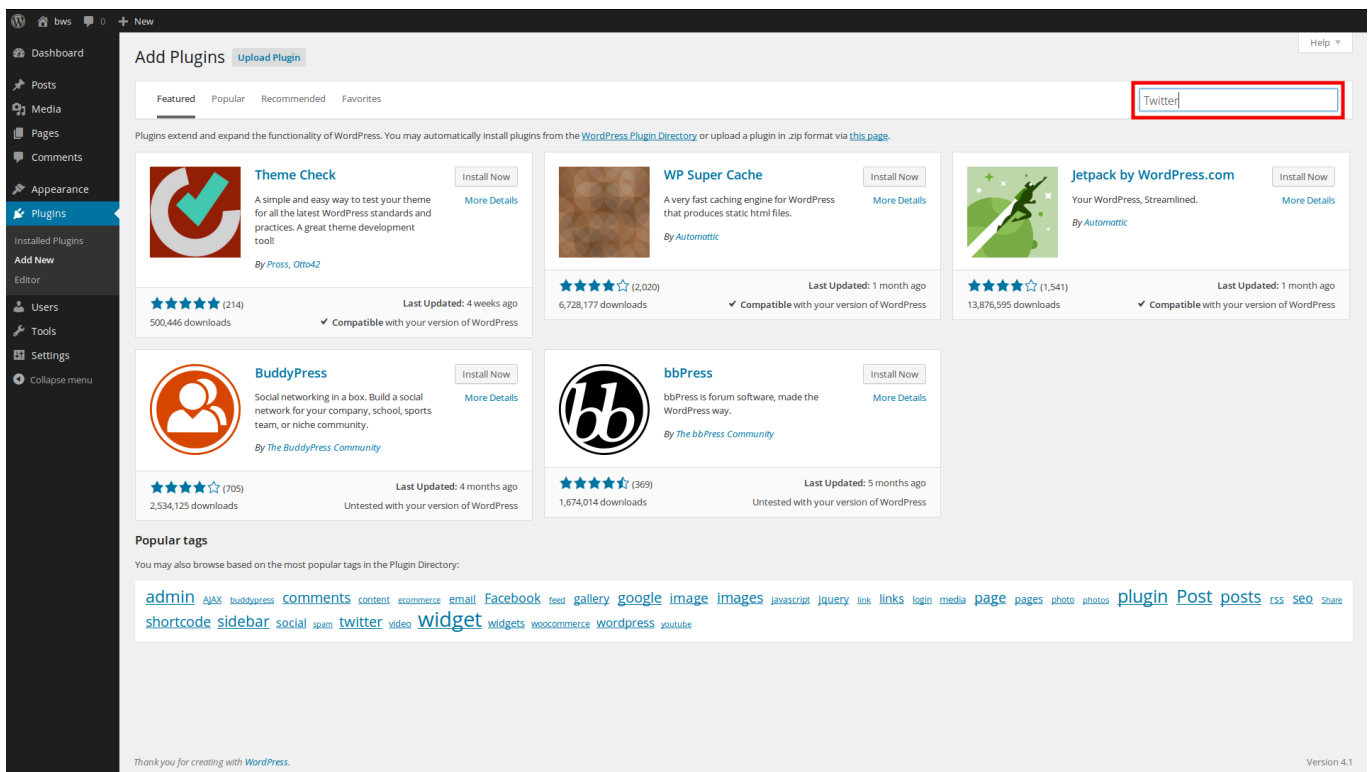
4. Find the **Search** field.



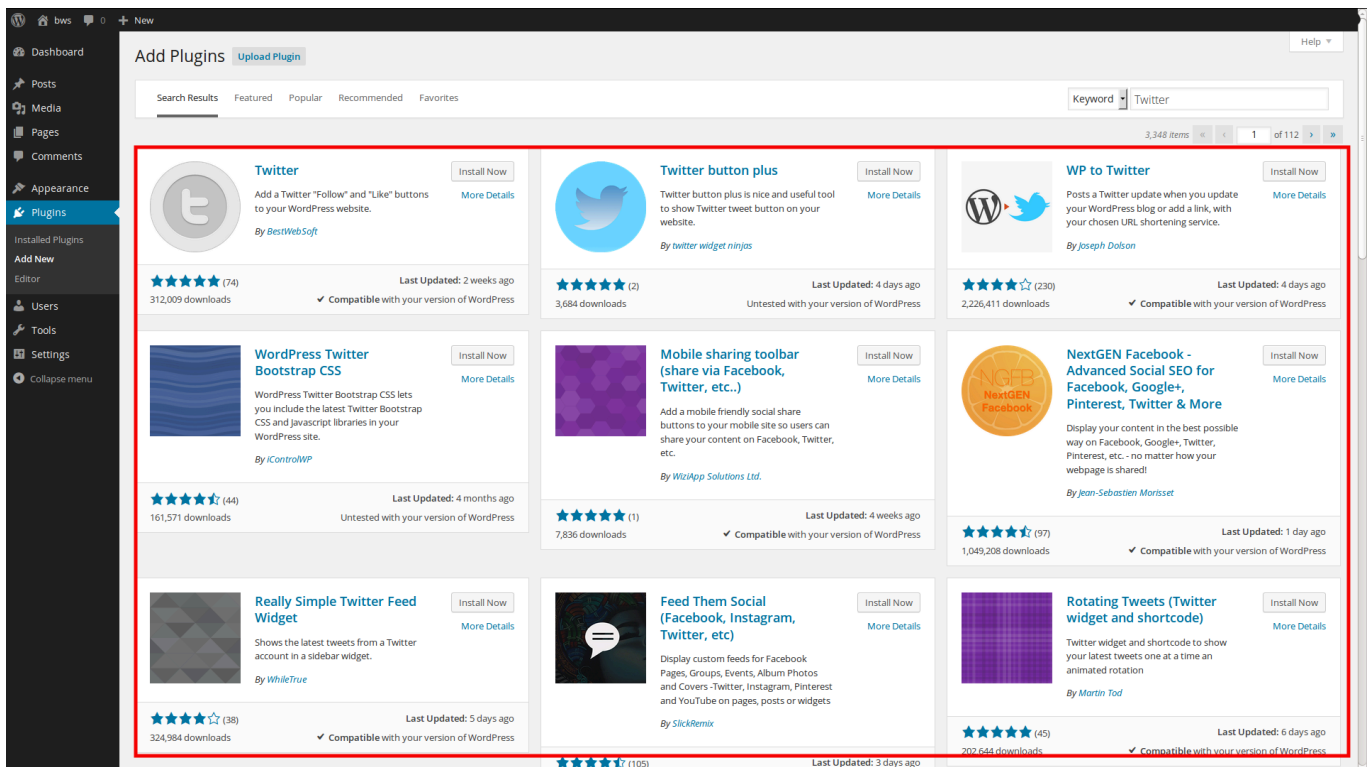
5. Type **"Twitter Button"** there and press **"Enter"**.

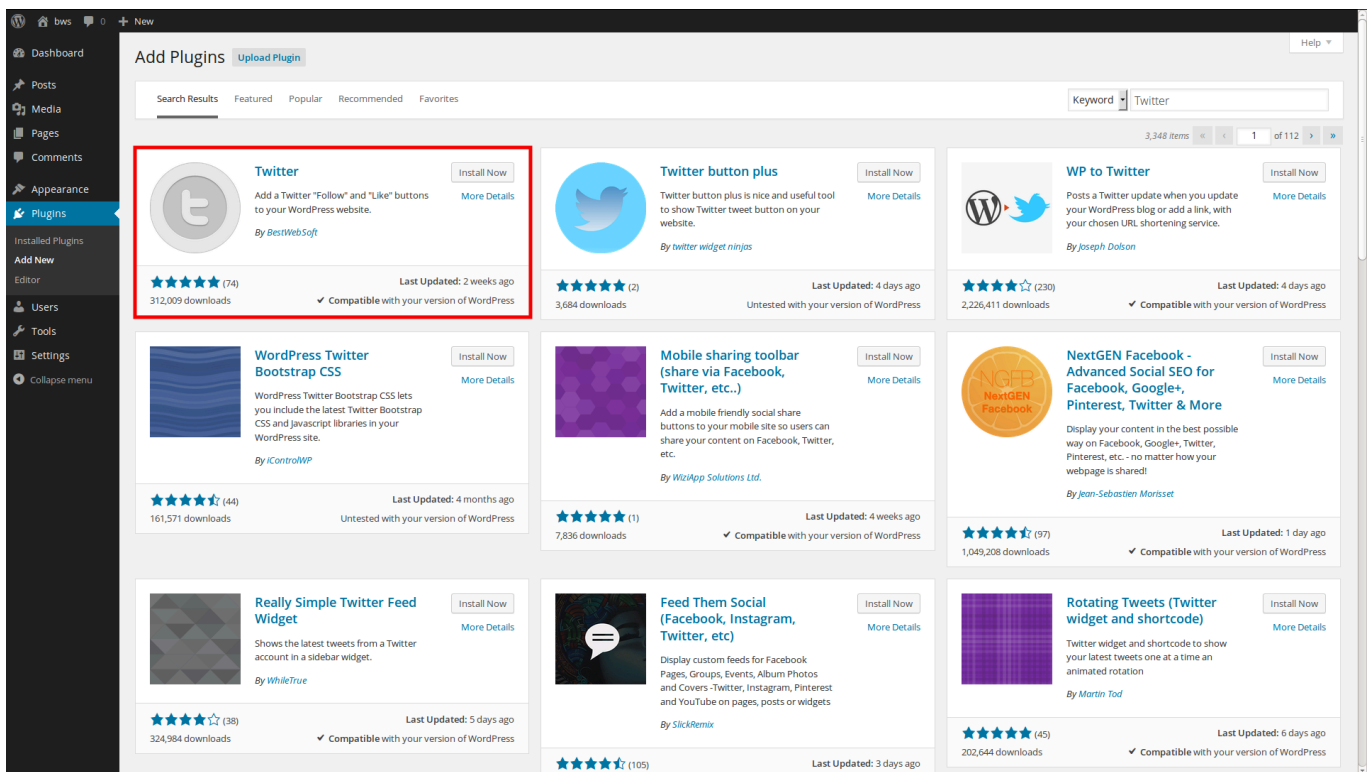
6. You will see a list of plugins.



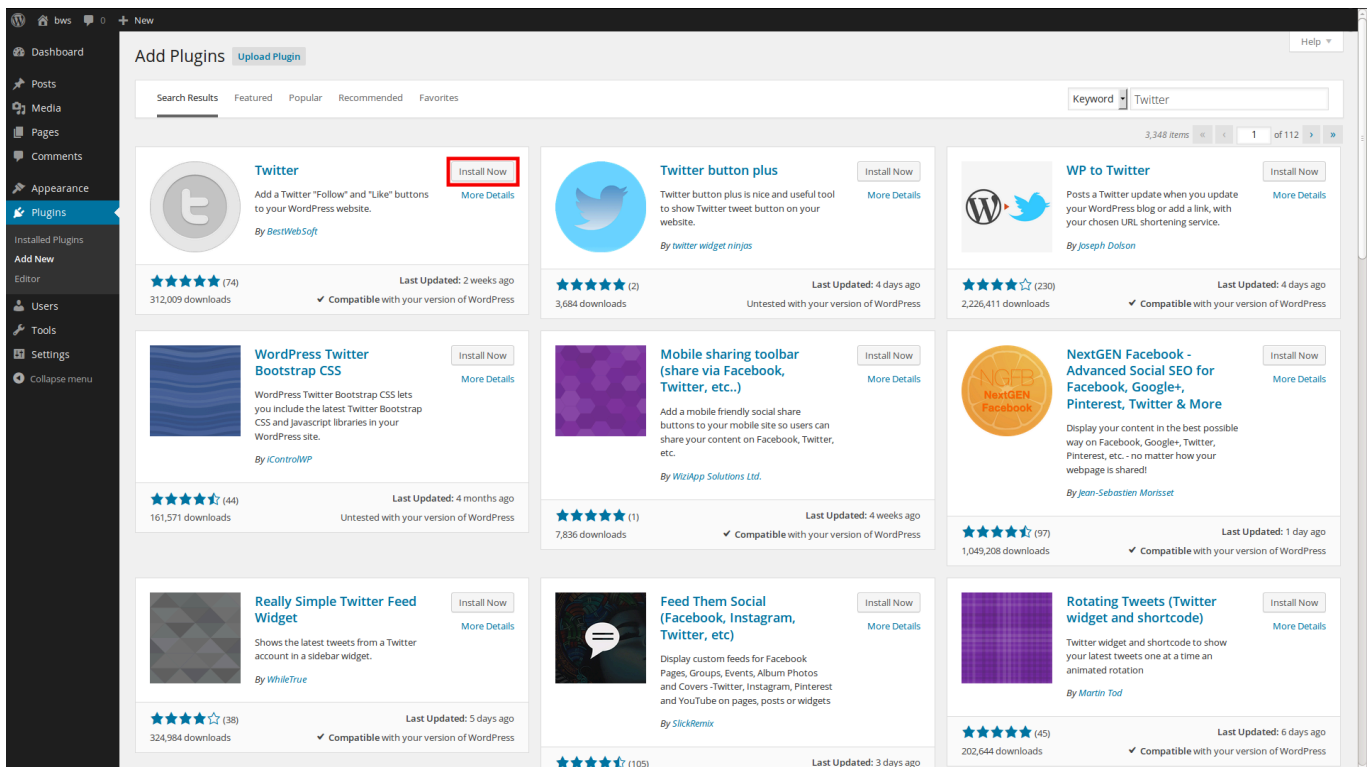
7. Find the necessary plugin in the list. Please read the description carefully to be sure you select the right plugin.

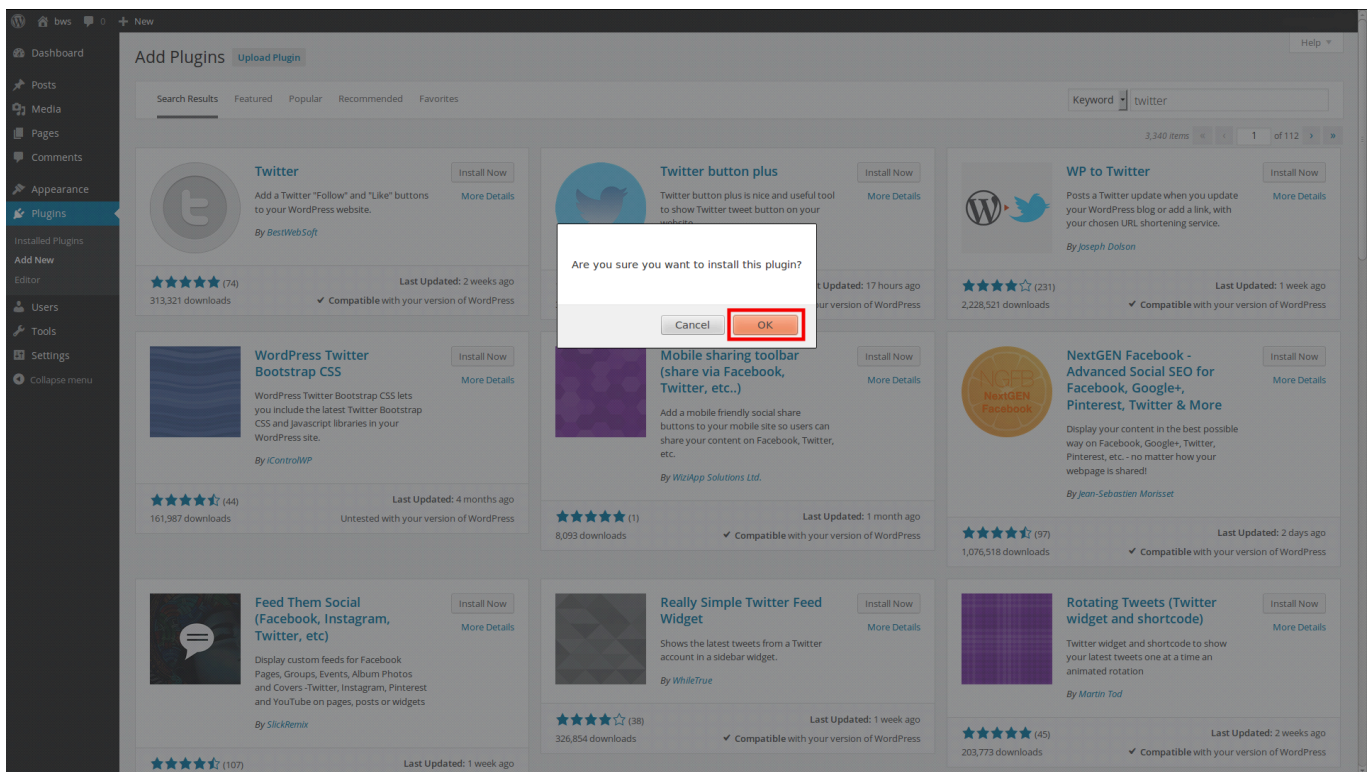
8. Then click **"Install Now"**.



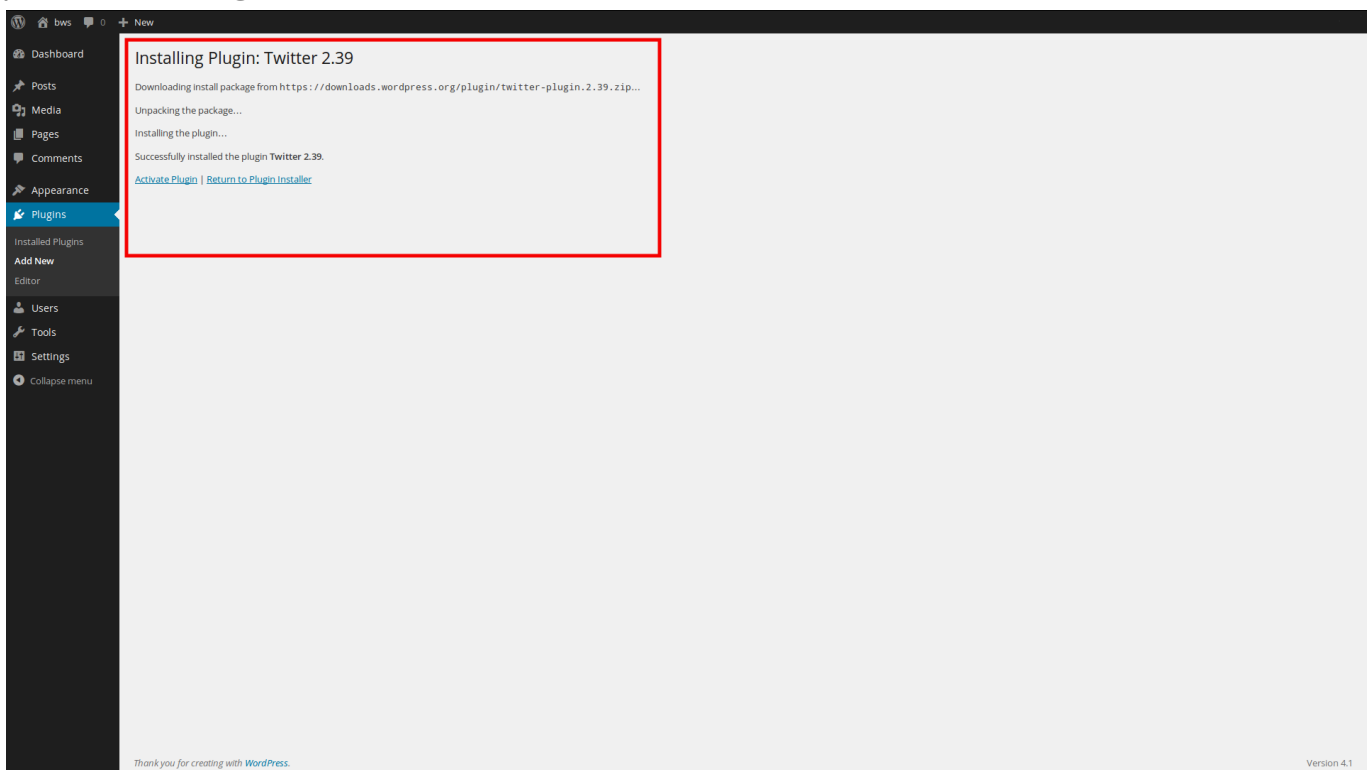

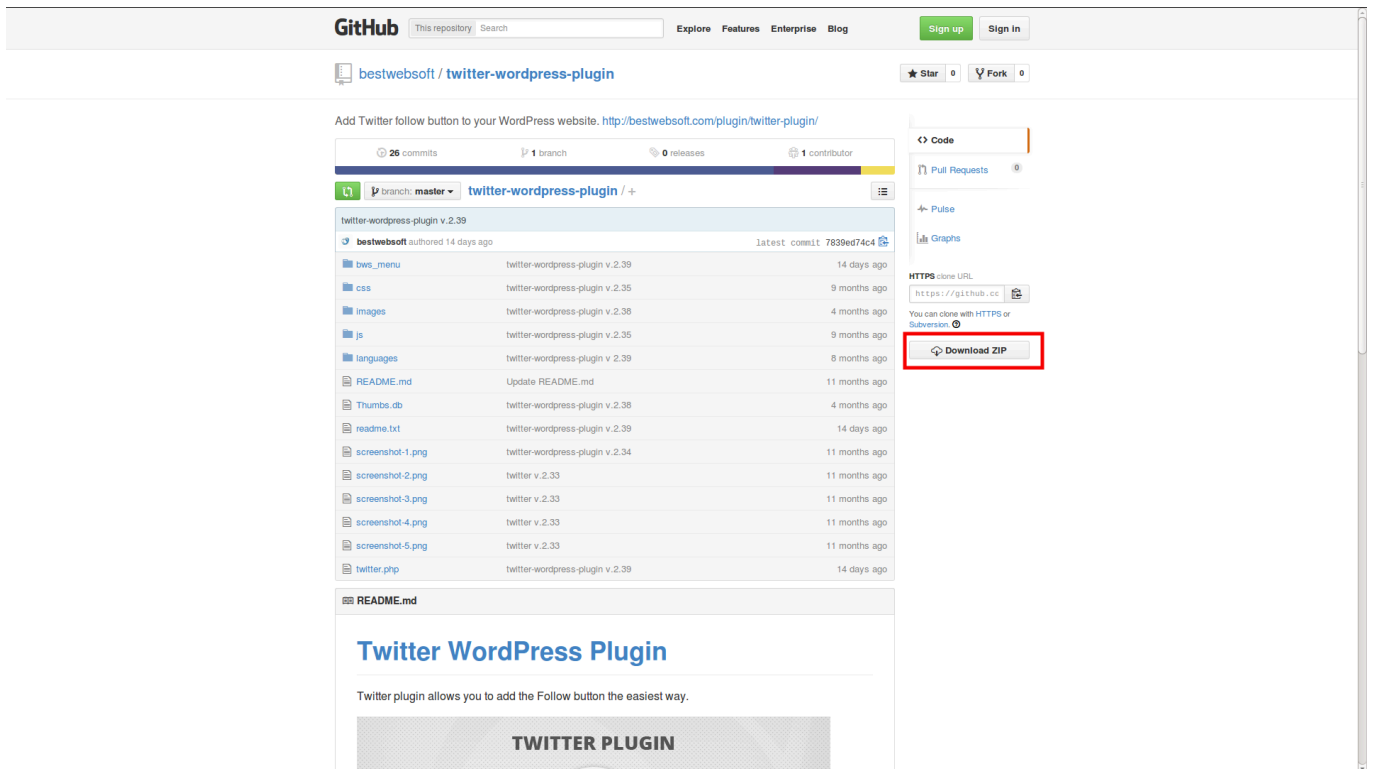


2. How to install Twitter Button plugin from GitHub

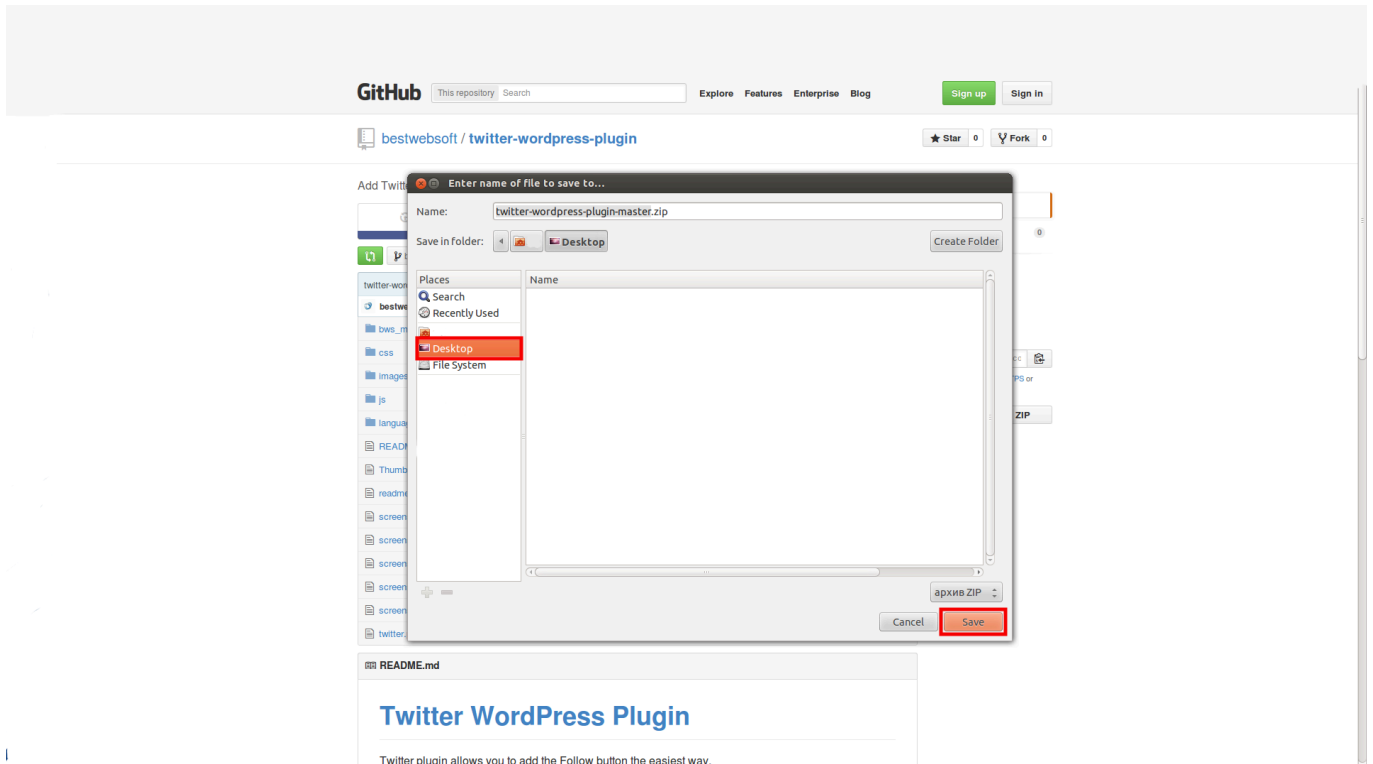
1. Go to <https://bestwebsoft.com/products/twitter/download> and click **“Download from GitHub”**.

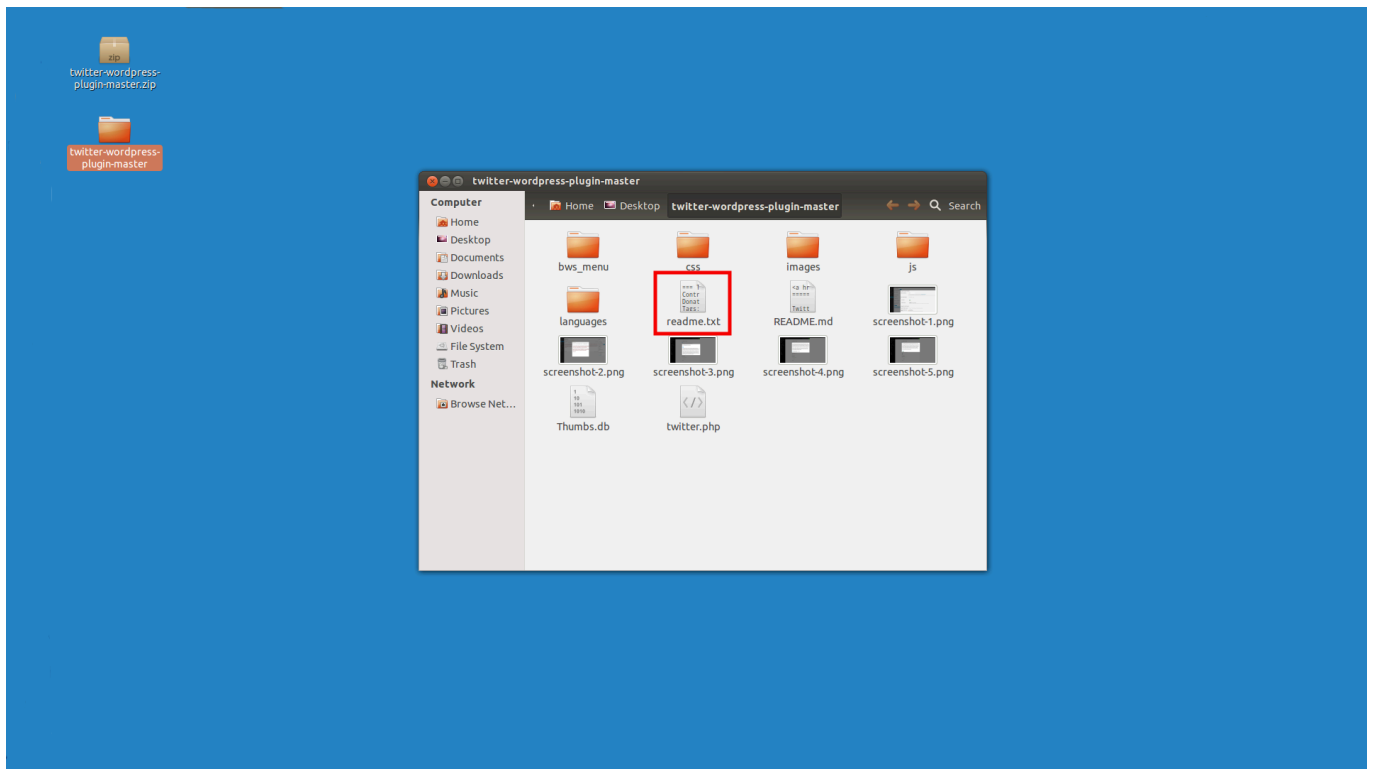

== Installation ==

1. Upload the folder 'twitter-plugin' to the directory '/wp-content/plugins/'.
2. Activate the plugin via the 'Plugins' menu in your WordPress admin panel.
3. You can adjust the necessary settings using your WordPress admin panel in "BWS Plugins" -> "Twitter".

== Frequently Asked Questions ==

= I cannot see the Twitter icon in the post after the plugin installation =

In the WordPress admin panel go to "Plugins", find the "Twitter" plugin and click "Activate".

= How can I deactivate the plugin =

In the WordPress admin panel go to "Plugins", find the "Twitter" plugin and click "Deactivate".

= After clicking the Twitter icon I see the Twitter Home page instead of the necessary account page =

1. In the WordPress admin panel go to "Settings", find the "Twitter" plugin settings page and enter your Twitter login. Then click "Save Changes".
2. If you do not have Twitter account yet you should create it using this link: <https://twitter.com/signup>. After account is created please follow the instructions above.

= How to adjust the Twitter icon position on the page =

In the WordPress admin panel go to "Settings", find the Twitter plugin settings page and select one of the listed positions: Top position or Bottom position. Then click "Save Changes".

= After installation and settings adjustment on the plugin settings page it is not working still =

1. Please click "Save Changes". Make sure that you got the message "Settings Saved".
2. After saving your settings you should refresh the web page, where the Twitter icon should be placed.

= I have some problems with the plugin's work. What Information should I provide to receive proper support? =

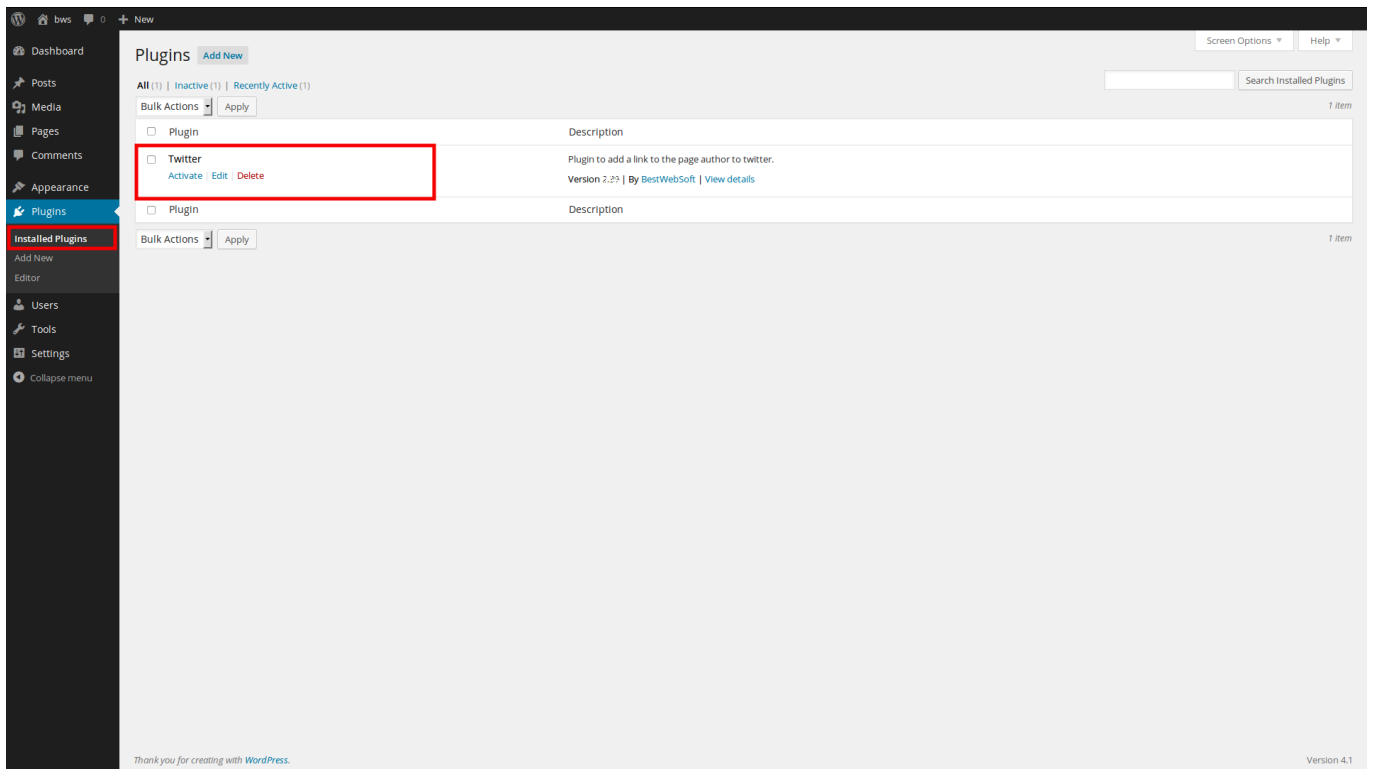

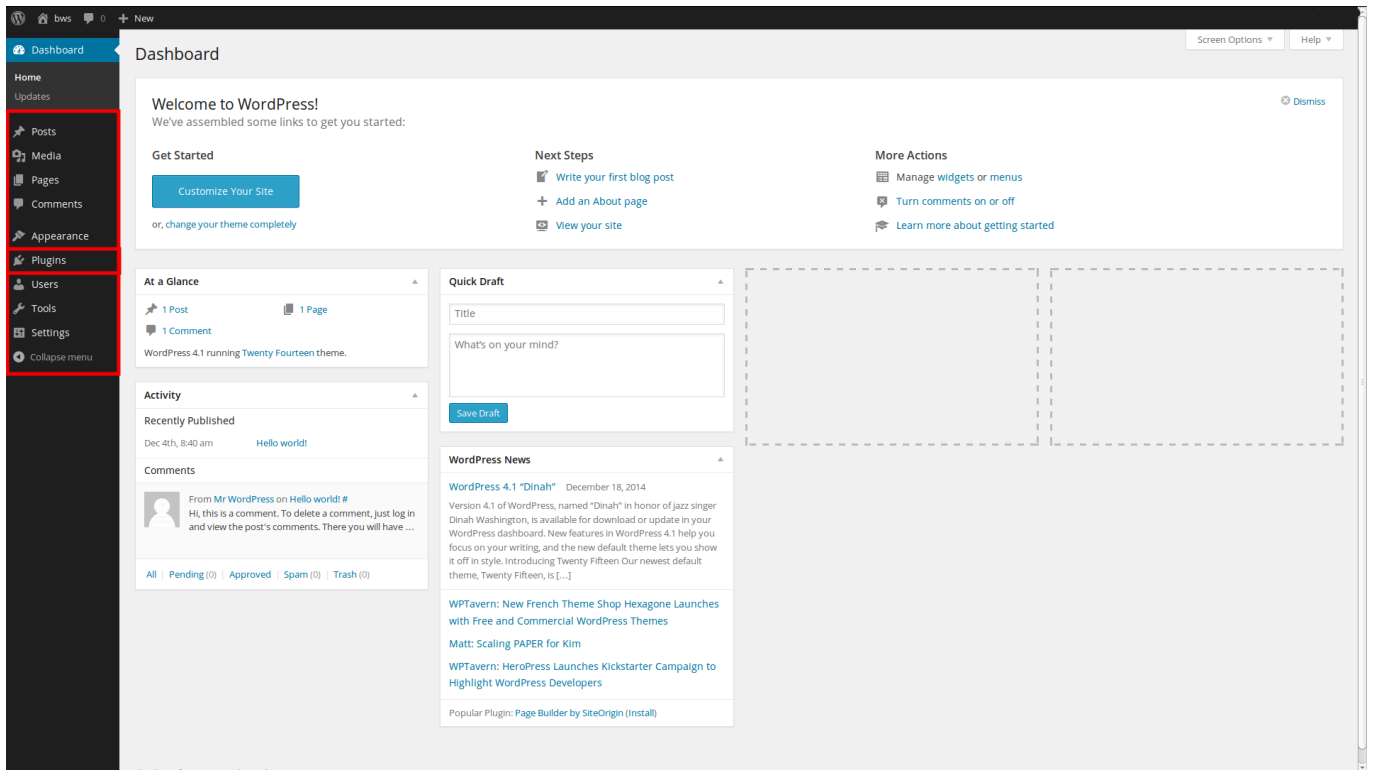
4. Alternative way of installation

This way of installation is preferable when you download the plugin folder by using a download link (mostly in case with Pro versions). In this case you do not have to extract the folder with the plugin to your desktop, it will be extracted automatically in your dashboard.

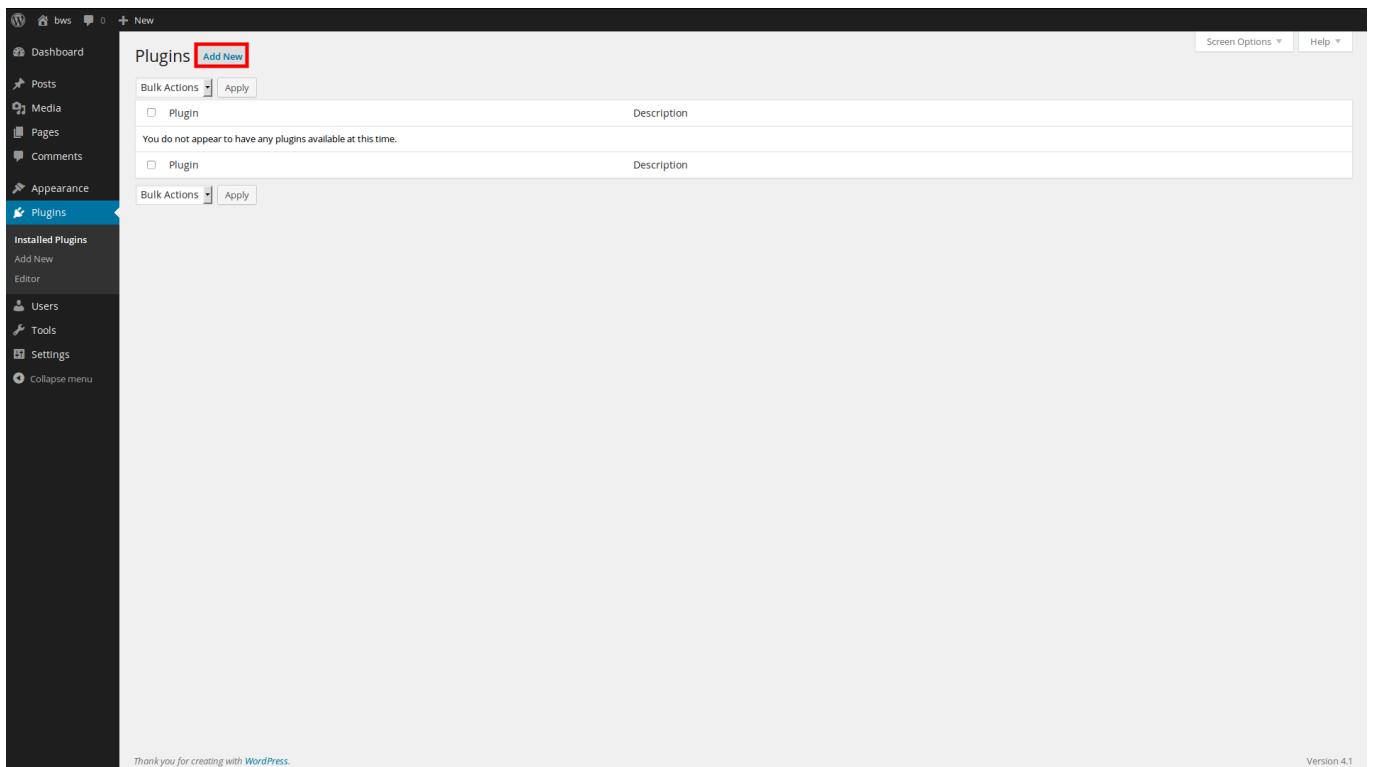
1. Make sure there is the plugin's zip-folder on your desktop.



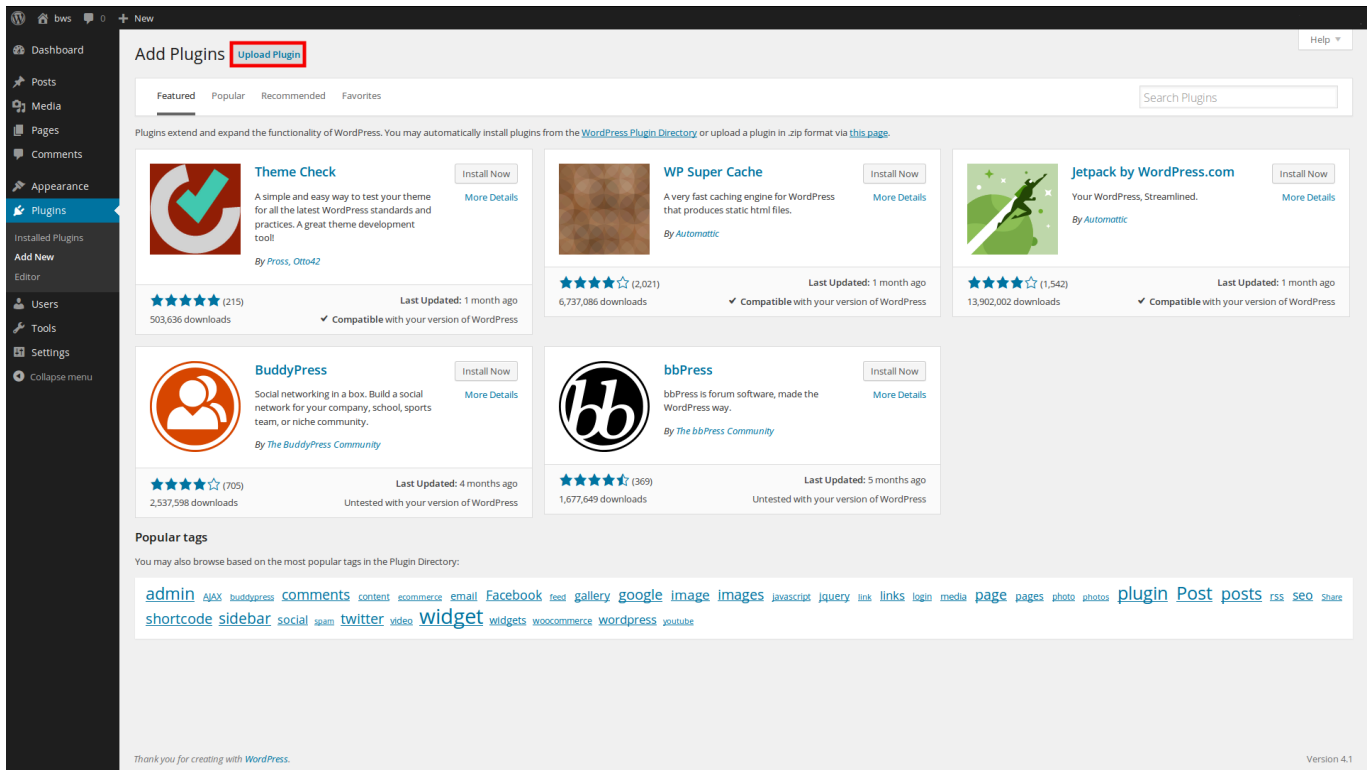
2. Click **"Plugins"** in the menu on the left in your admin area.



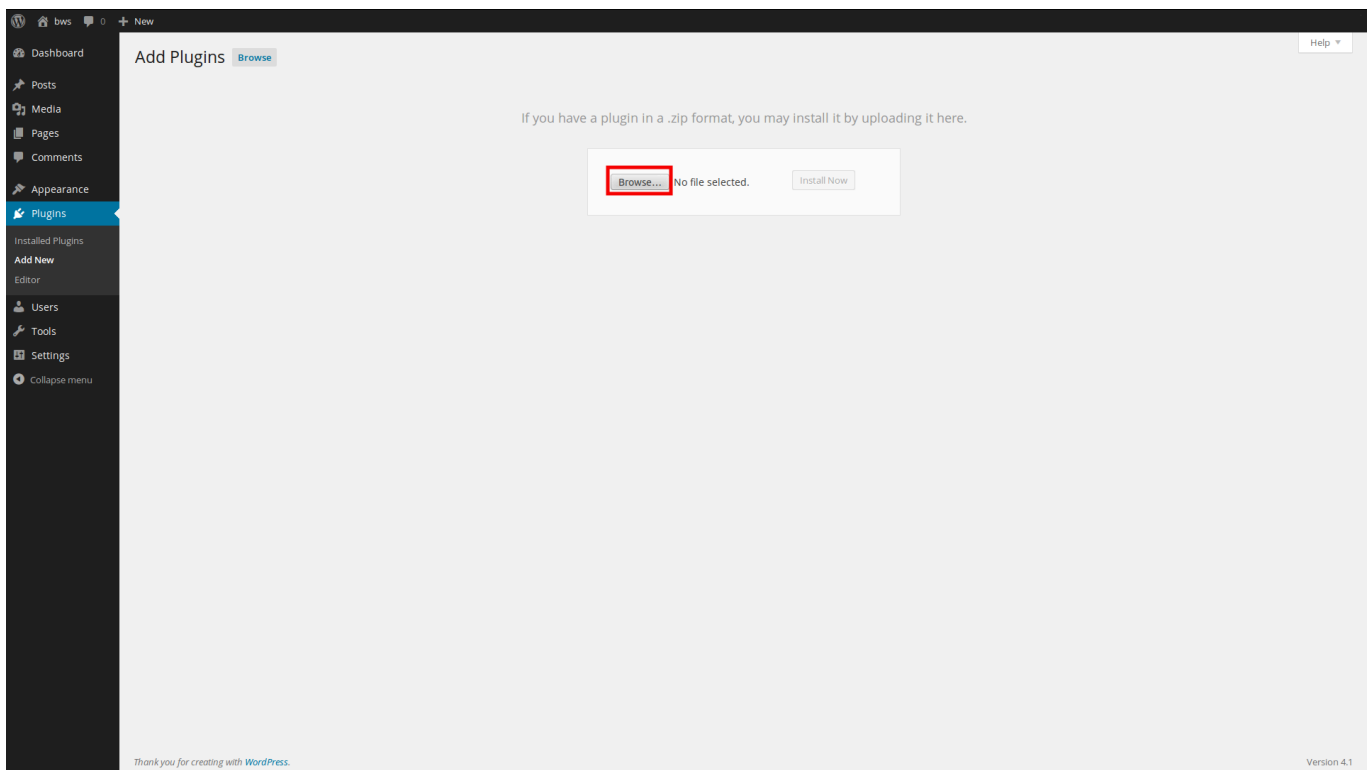
3. Click **"Add new"** at the top of the page.



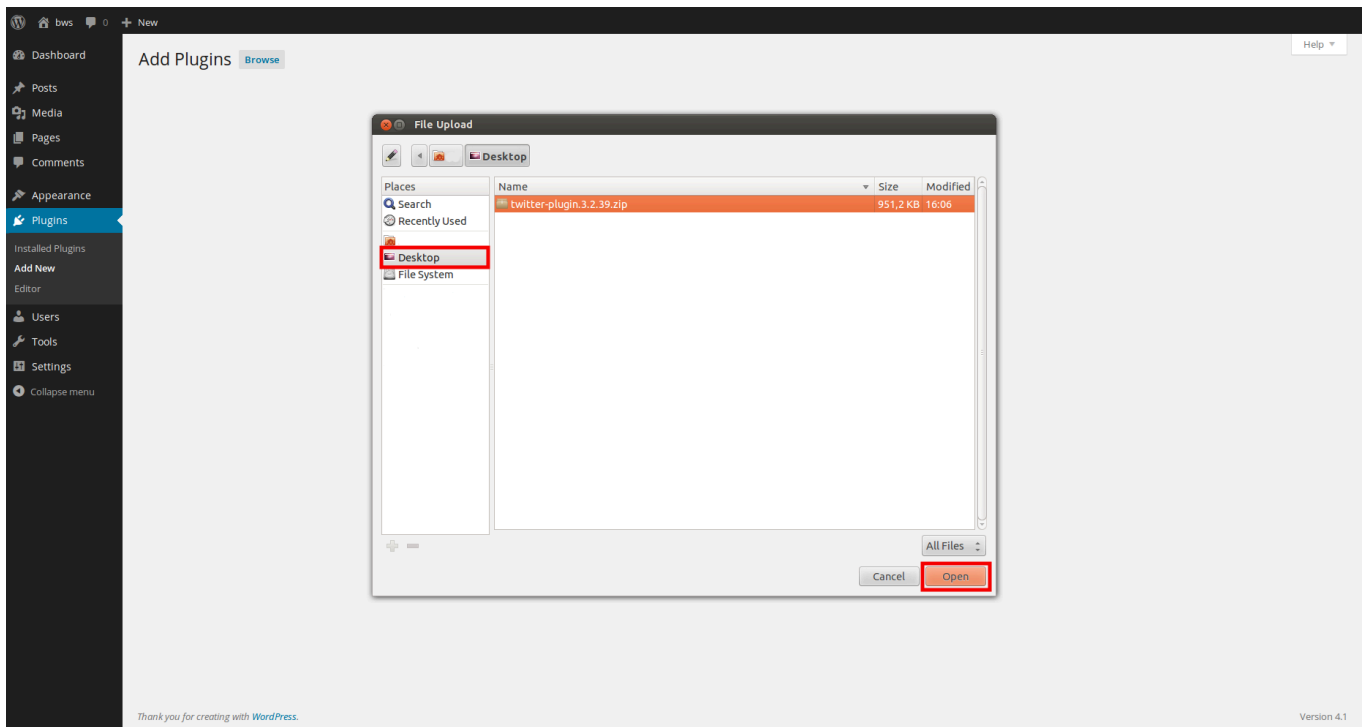
4. Click "Upload Plugin".



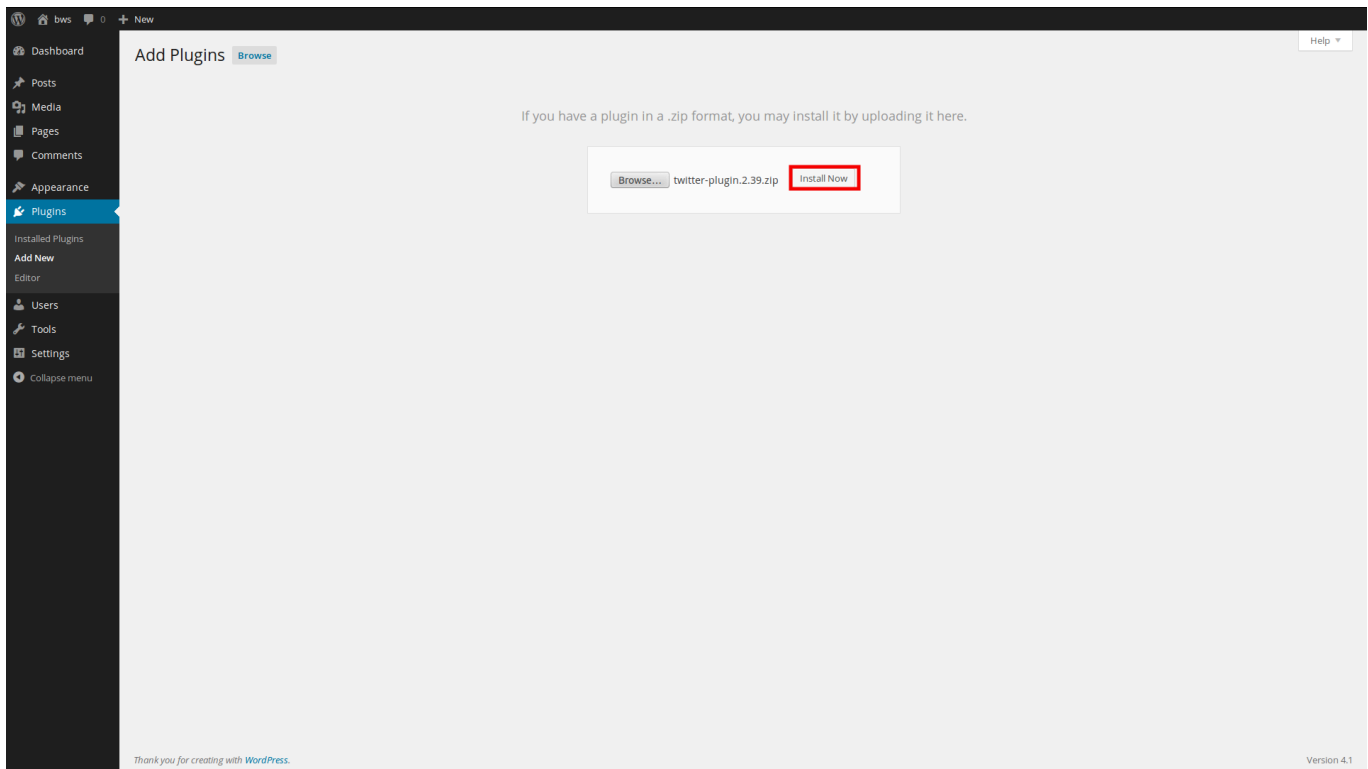
5. Click "Browse".



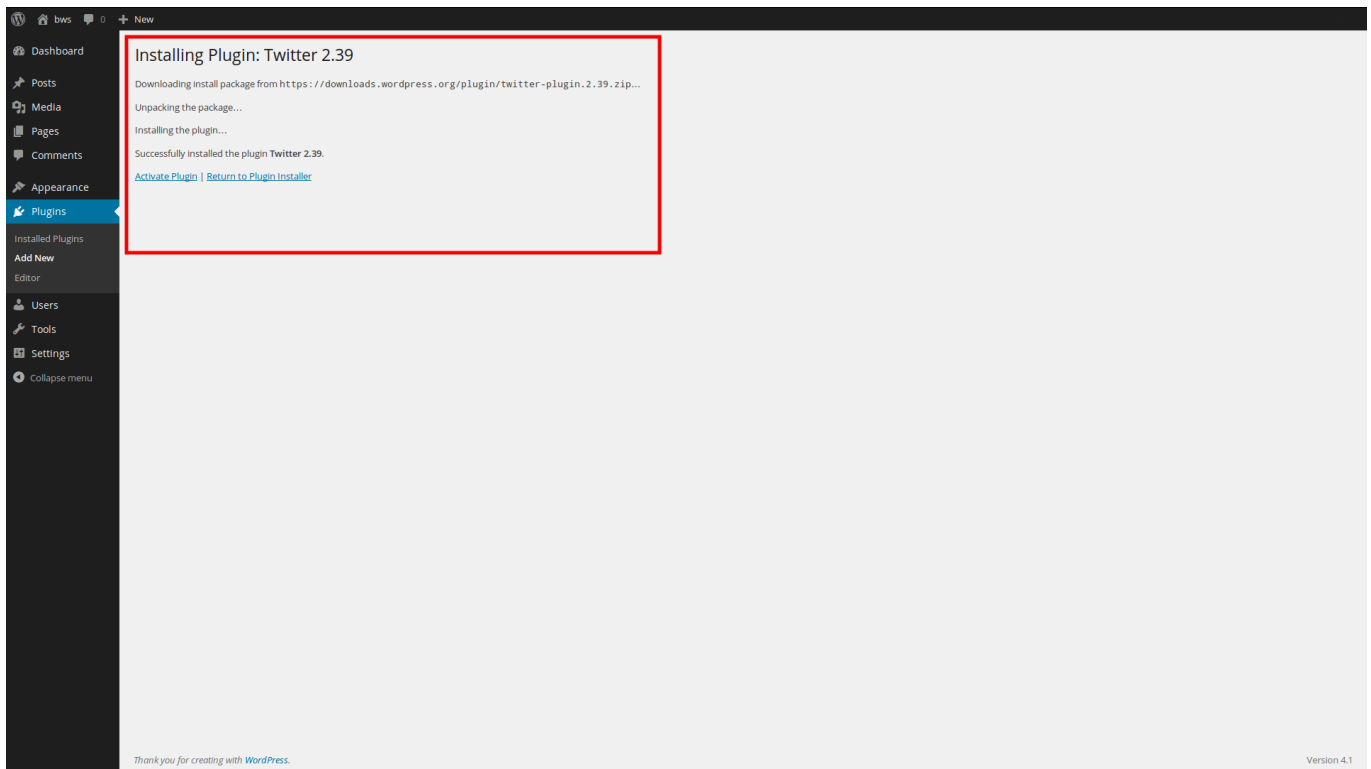
6. A pop-up window will ask you to choose the file. Select Twitter Button zip-folder and click **“Open”**.



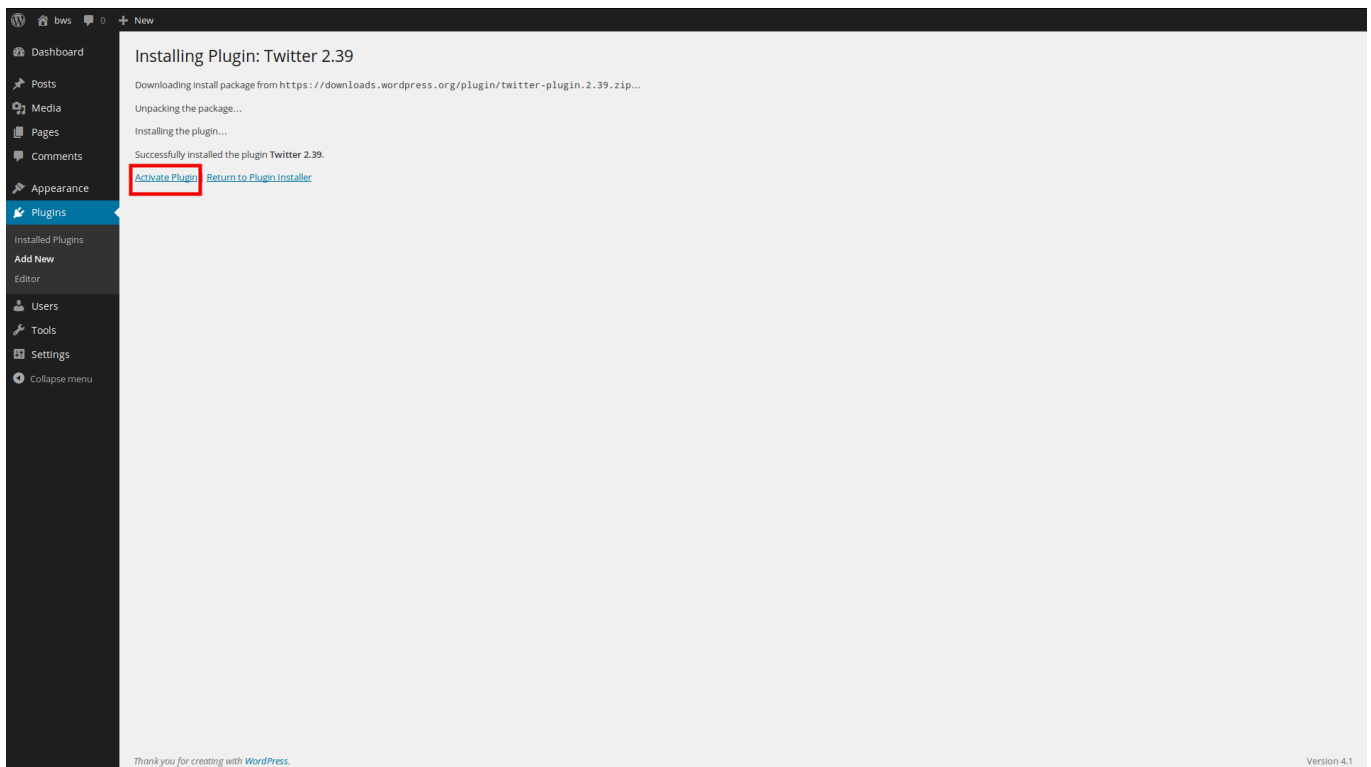
7. Click **“Install now”**.



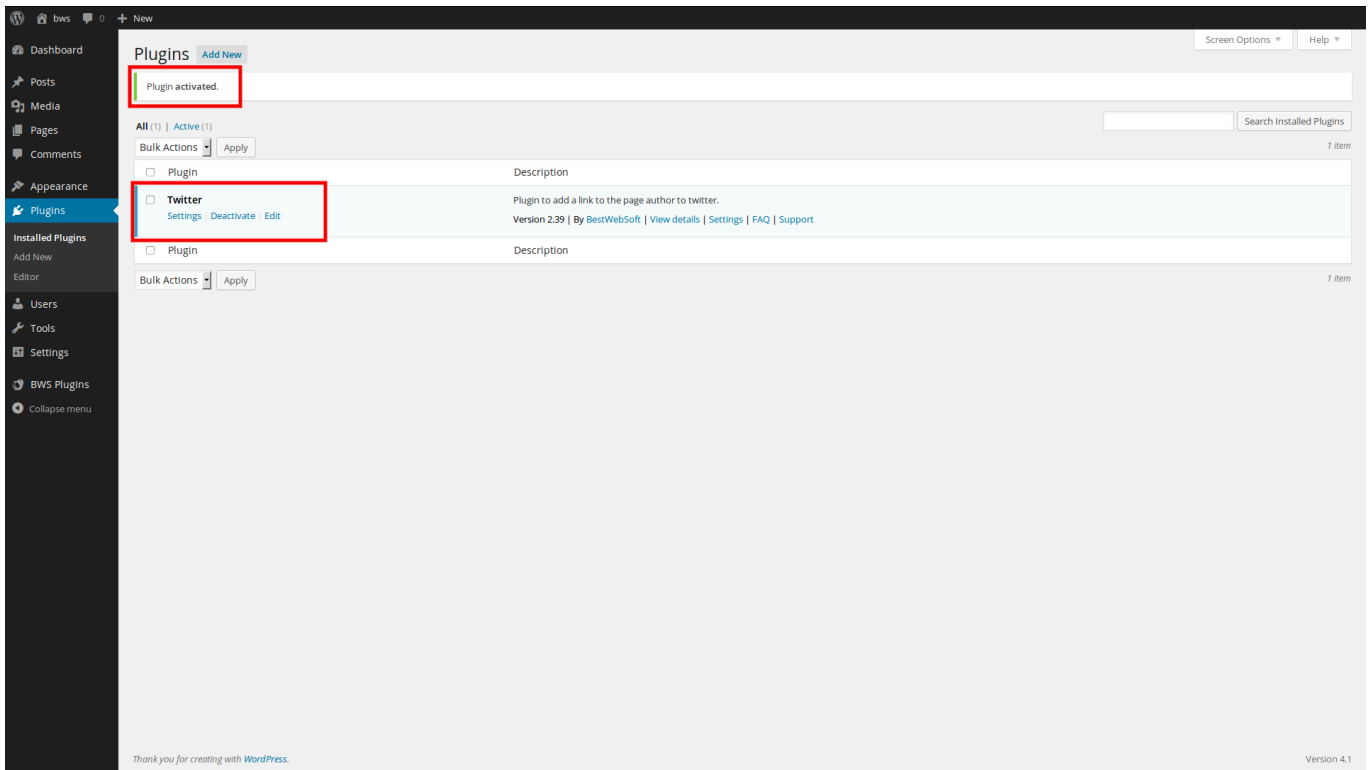

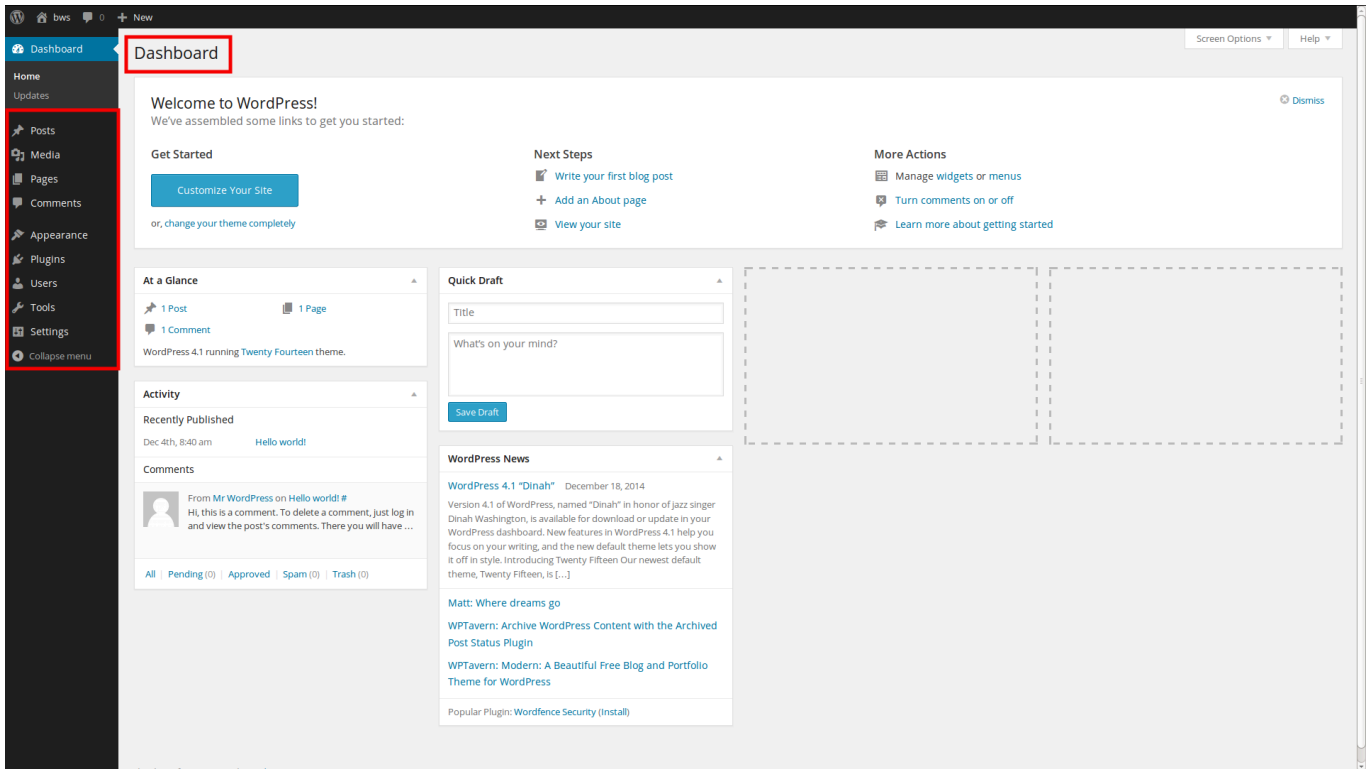

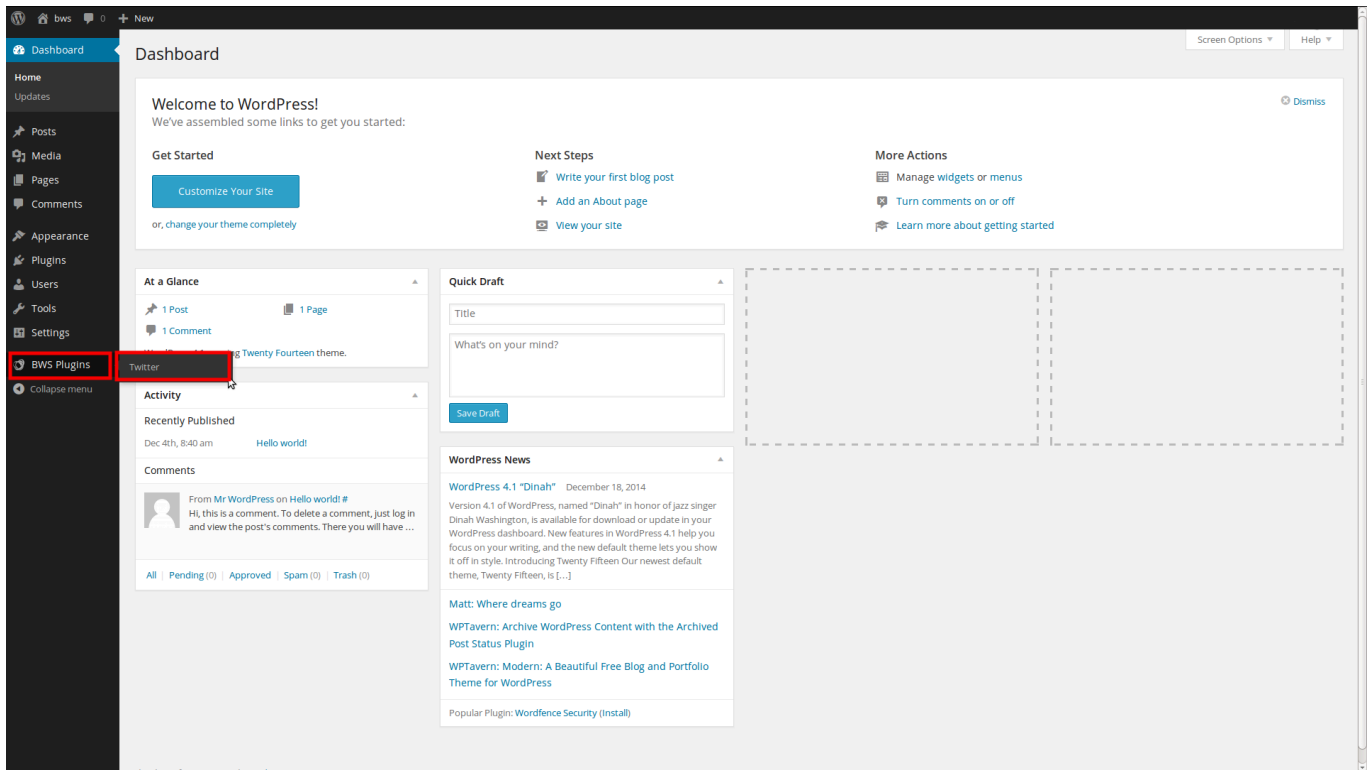


5. How to use the plugin

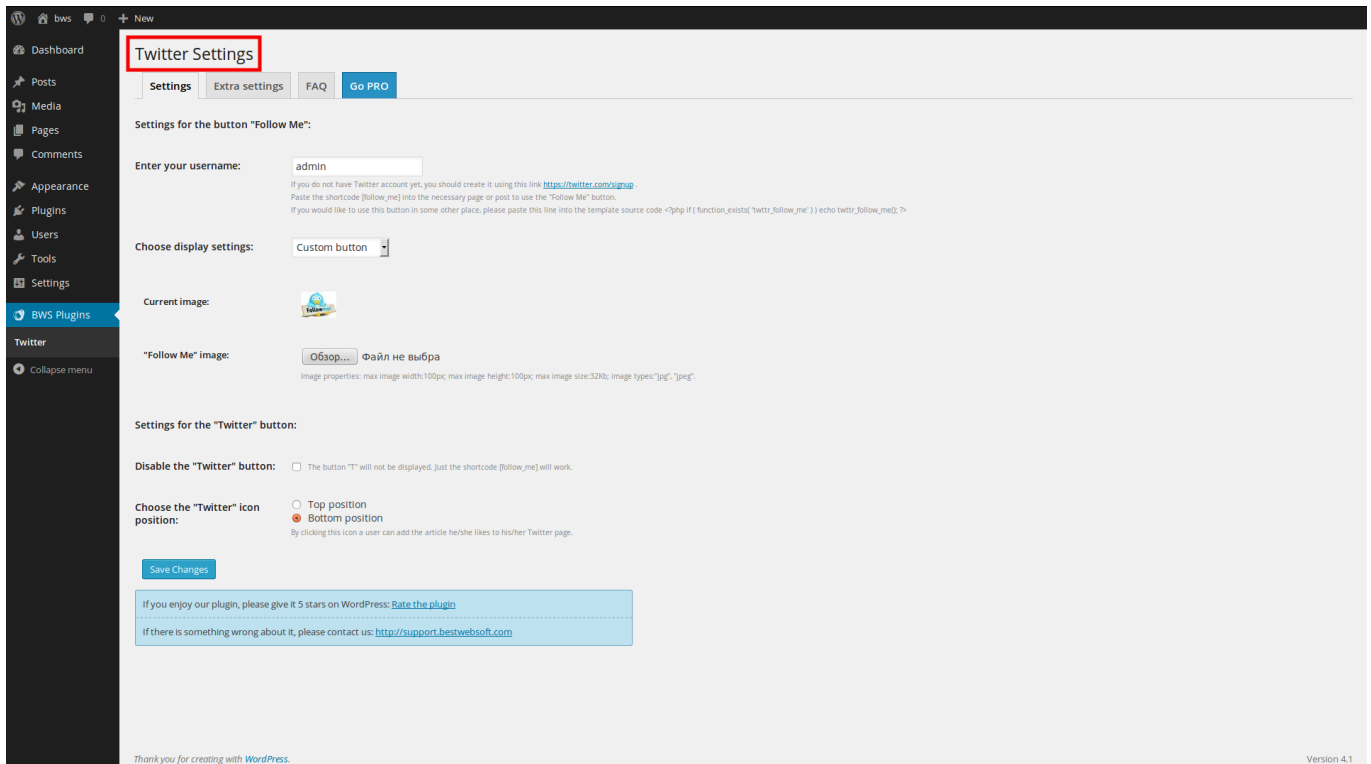
1. Find the menu on your left.



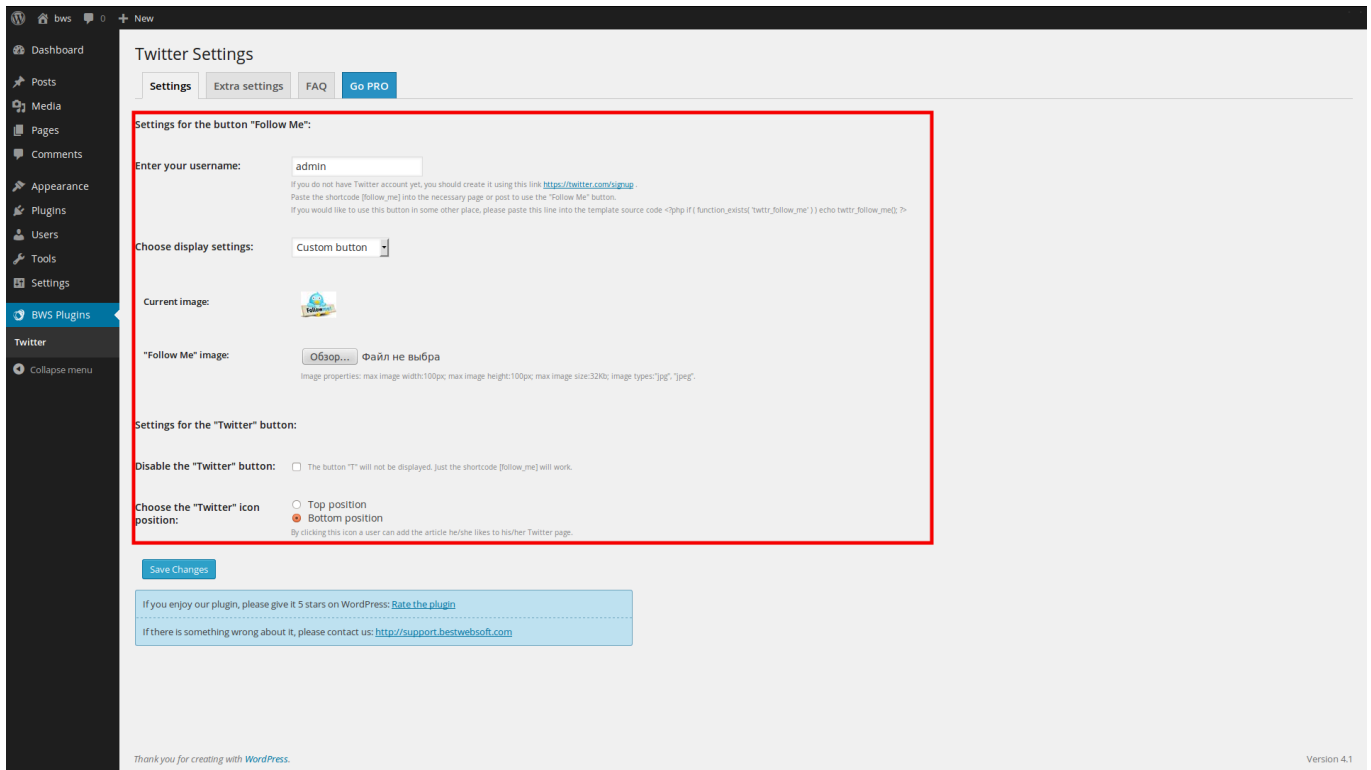
2. Select "BWS Plugins" -> "Twitter Button"



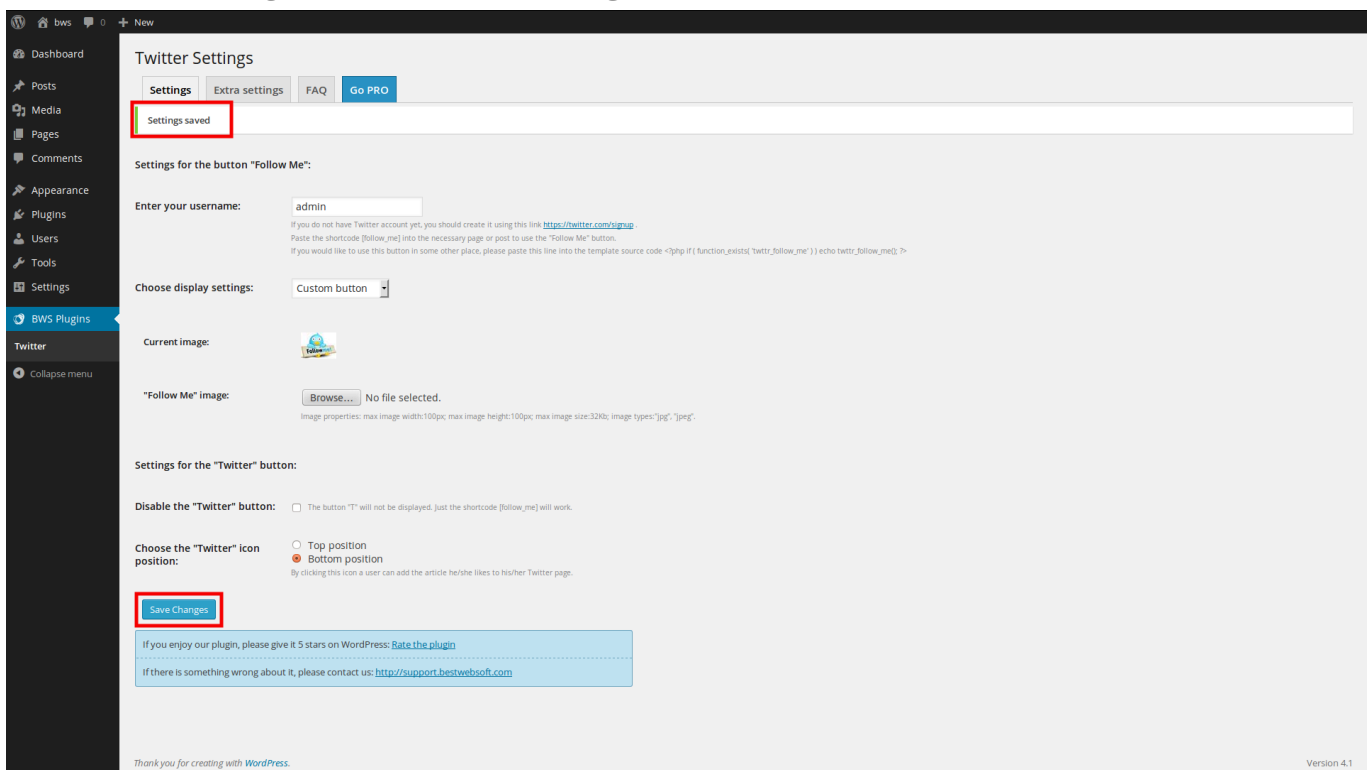
3. You will see Twitter Button Settings page.



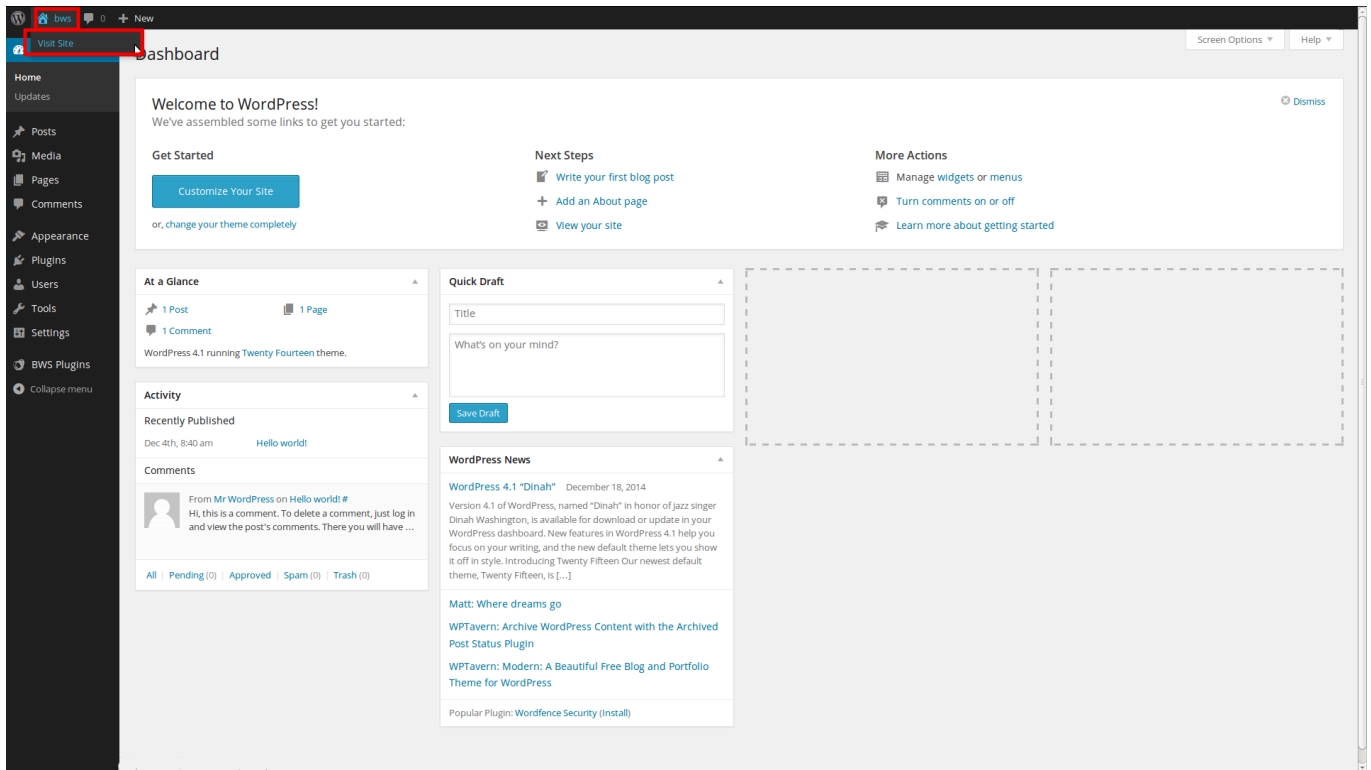
4. Configure the plugin the way you like.



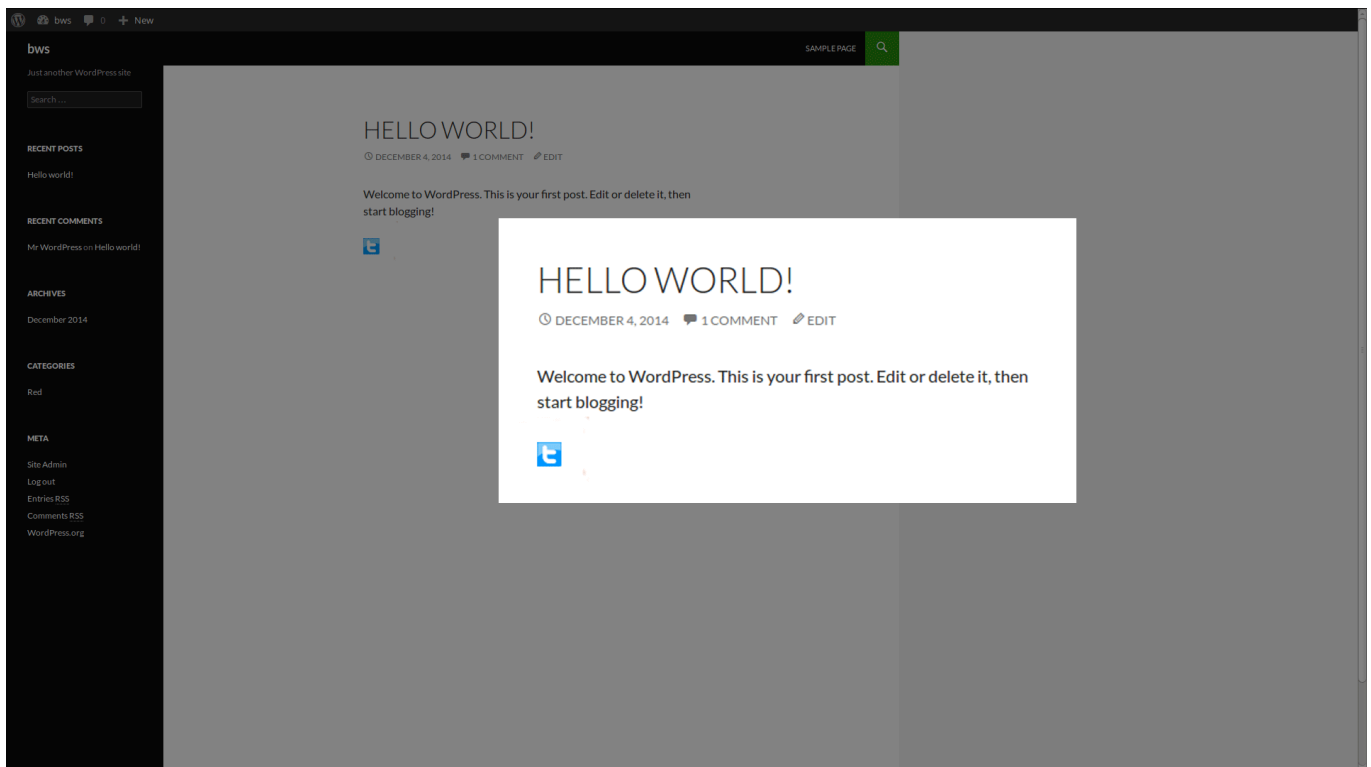
5. Don't forget to click "Save Changes".



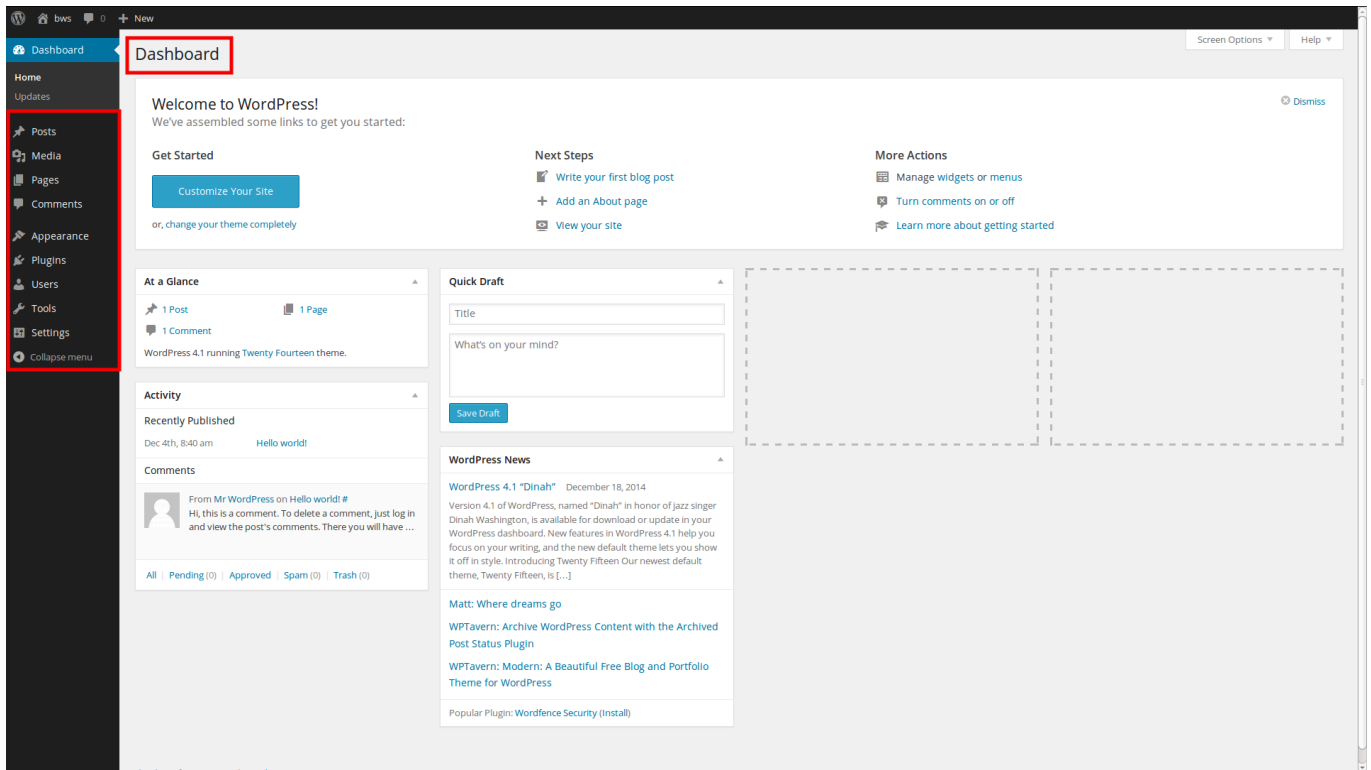
6. To see how the plugin works, you need to visit your site.



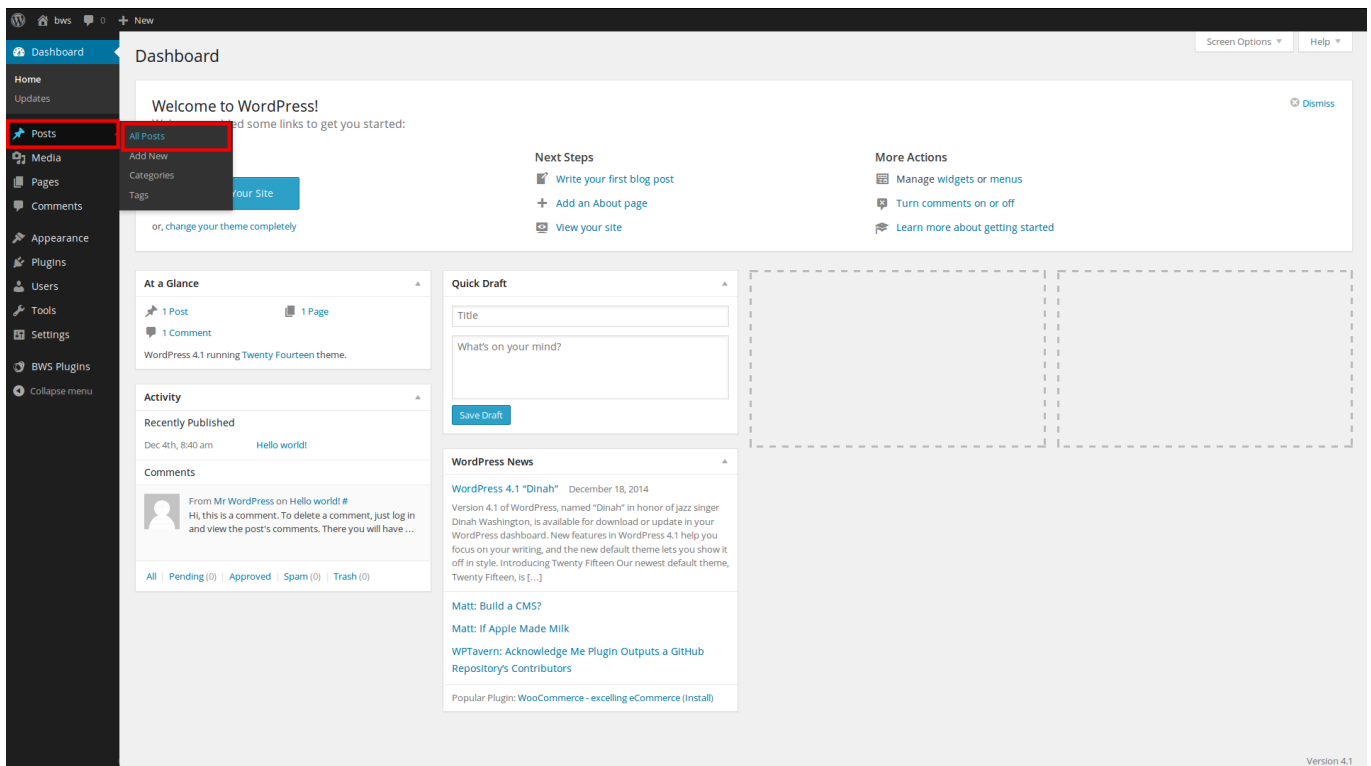
7. Now you can see **Twitter "Like" button** under your post. If you want to share this post on your Twitter, just click this button.



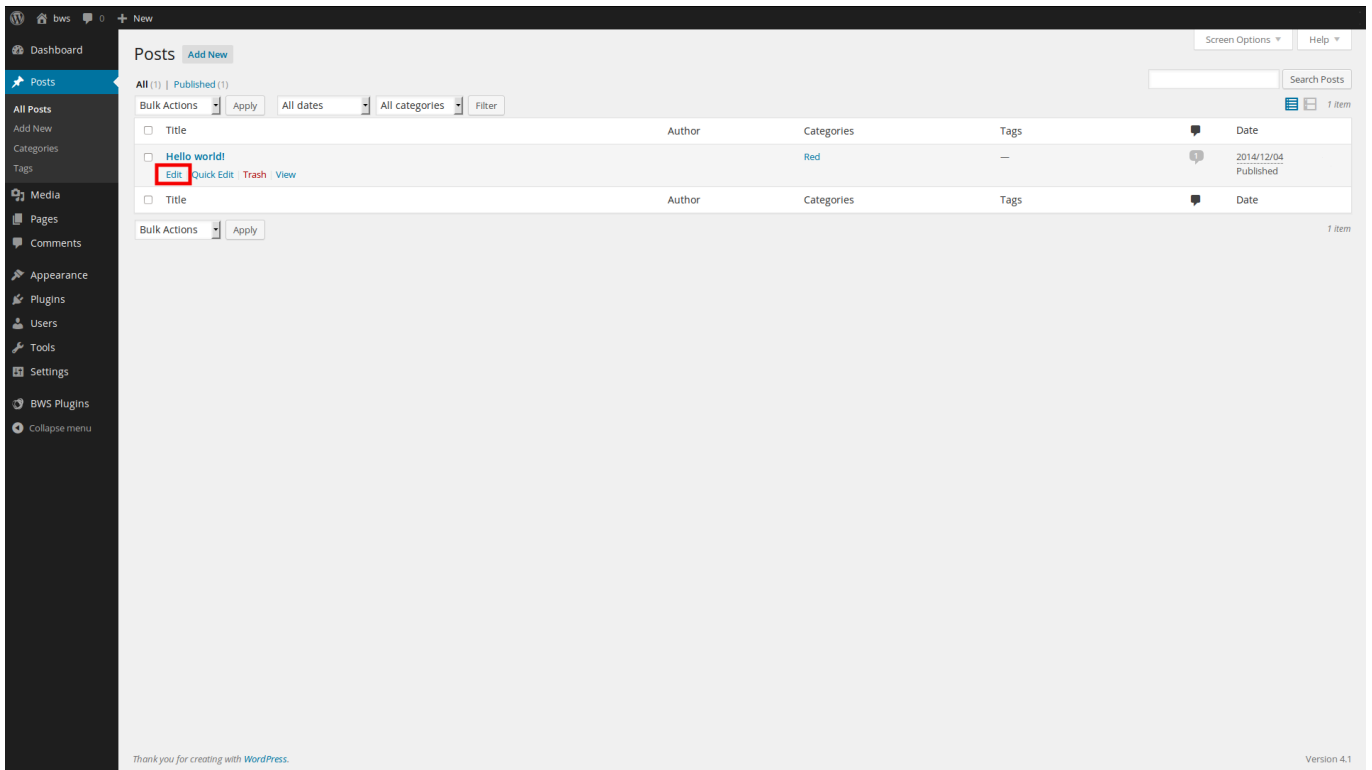
8. Find the menu on your left.



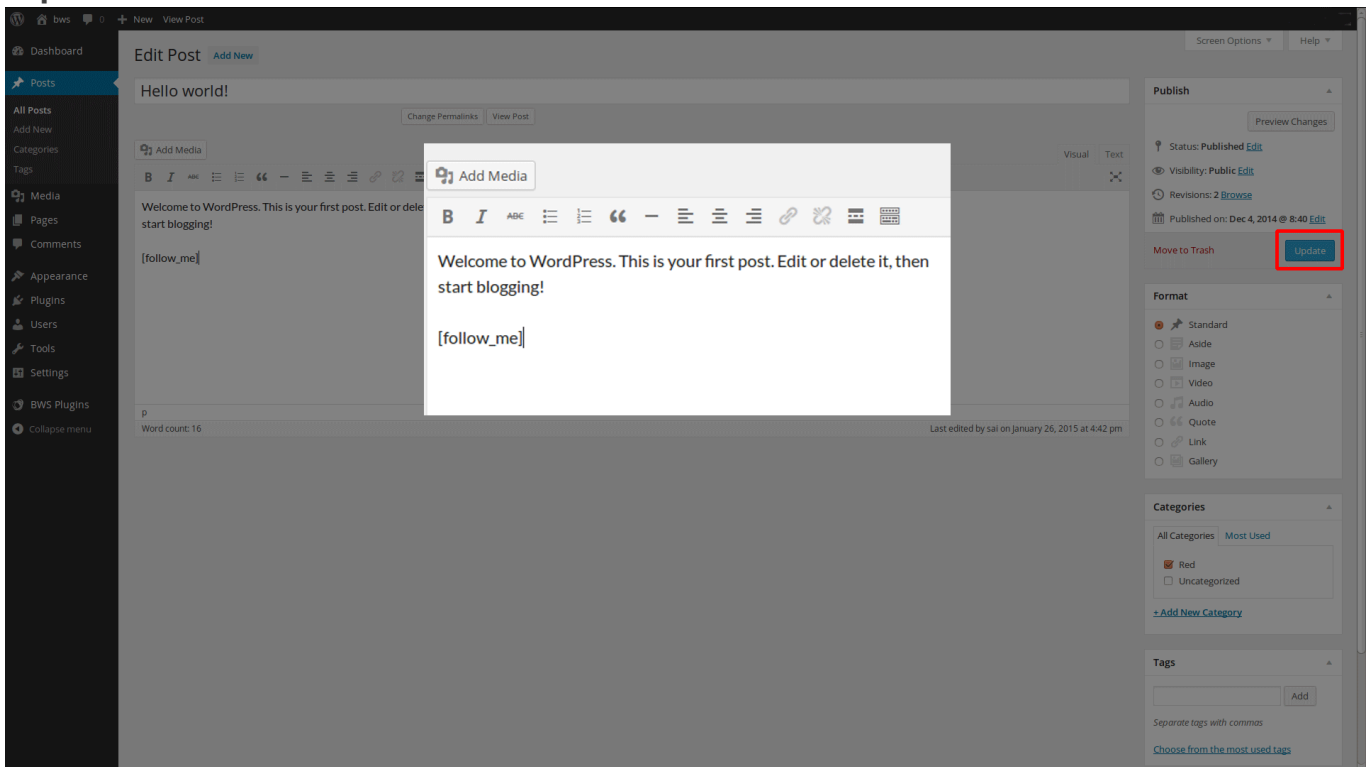
9. Click "Posts" > "All Posts".



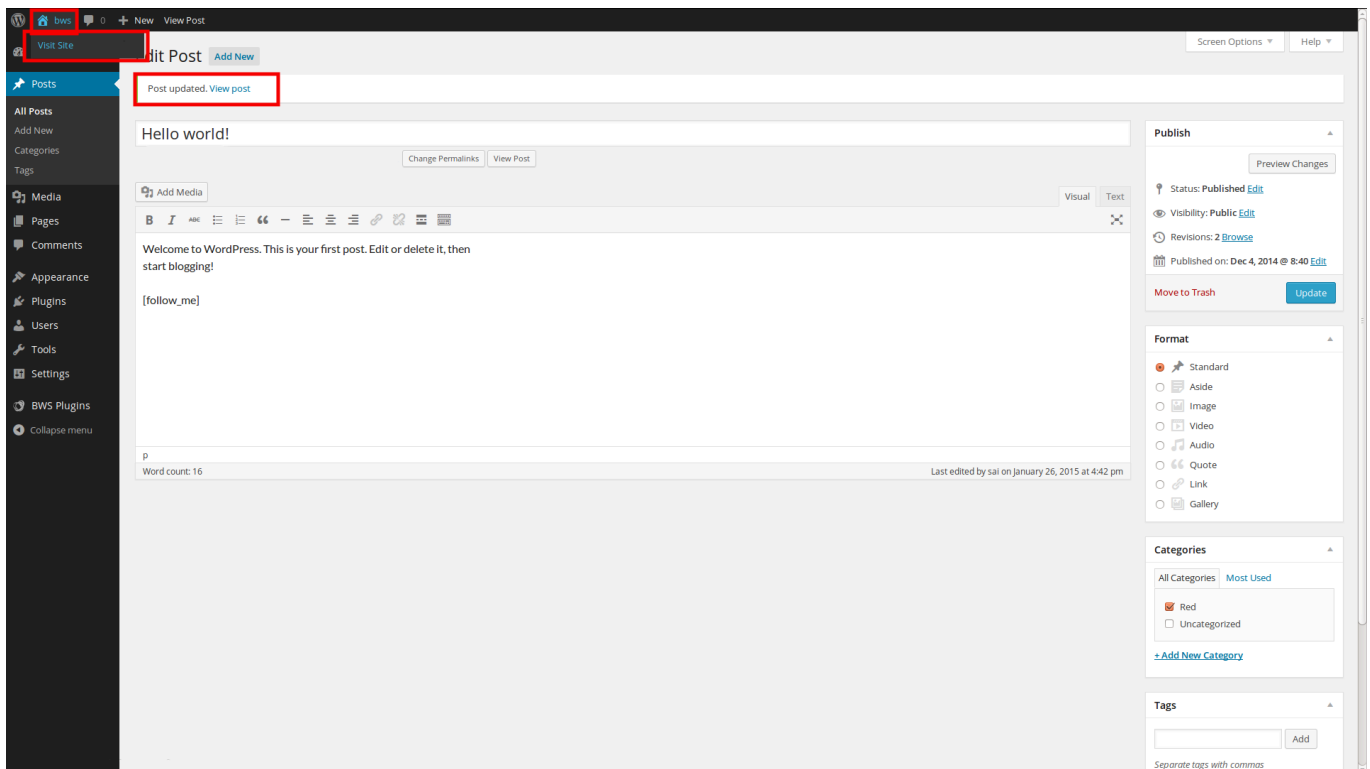
10. Select **"Edit"** below any post of yours.



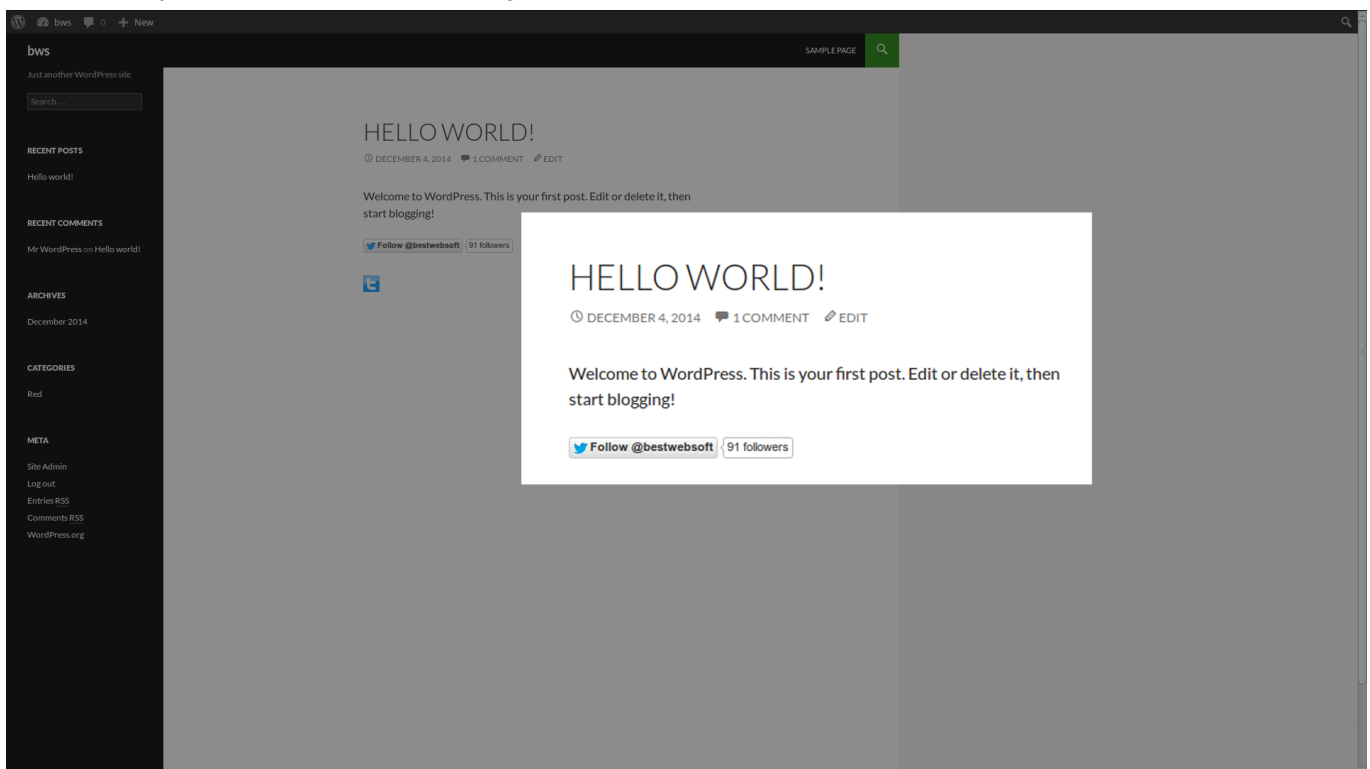
11. Paste the shortcode **"[follow_me]"** beneath your post content and click **"Update"**.



12. When your post is updated, visit your website to see the result.



13. Now you can see Twitter “**Follow me**” button beneath your post. If you want to follow the post author on Twitter, just click this button.
