

Disability Status Variables

Learning about disability status by sex and age

Madison, New Jersey is a well off community that includes elderly populations, living with a disability. However, different parts of Madison have significantly different median populations with disabilities.

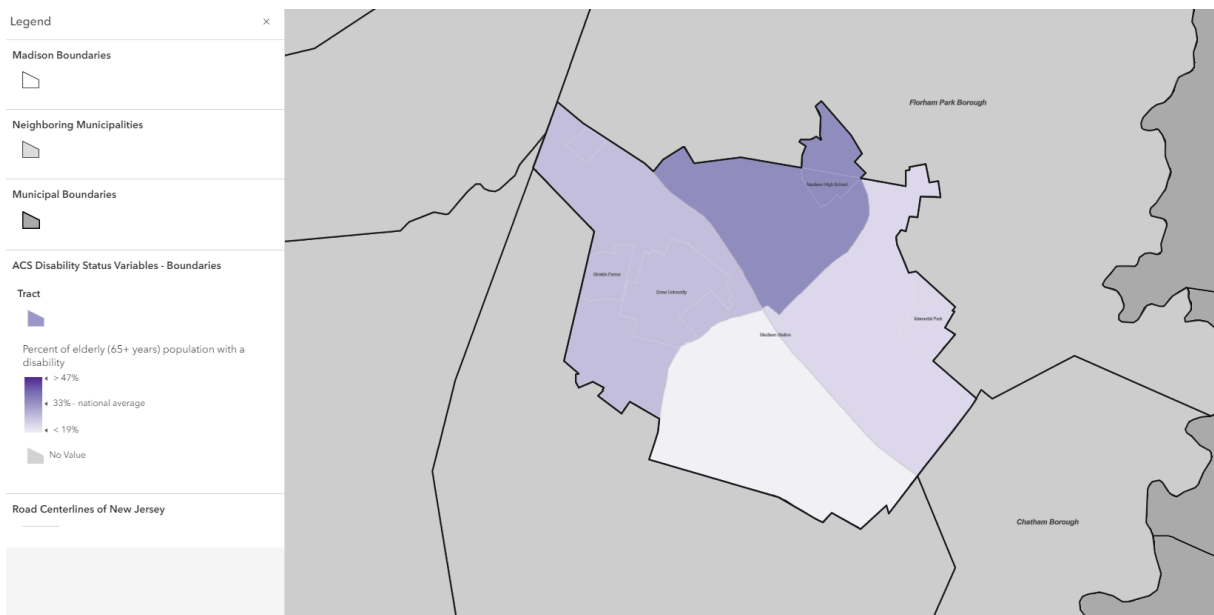


Figure 1. Madison Borough, Disability Status by Census Tract, American Community Survey (2018-2022). This map can be viewed online [here](#).

The information shared in Figure 1 comes from the U.S. Census Bureau, American Community Survey, collected between 2018-2022, and estimated for Madison's four census tracts.¹

The following estimates were found for Madison census tracts:

What the American Community Survey can tell us about residents

- North tract: has greater than 34.8 percent of people over 65 that have disabilities, also the highest rate in Madison
- East tract: has 22.7 of elderly with disabilities
- South tract: about 9.1% have a disability
- West tract: 27% of elderly have a disability

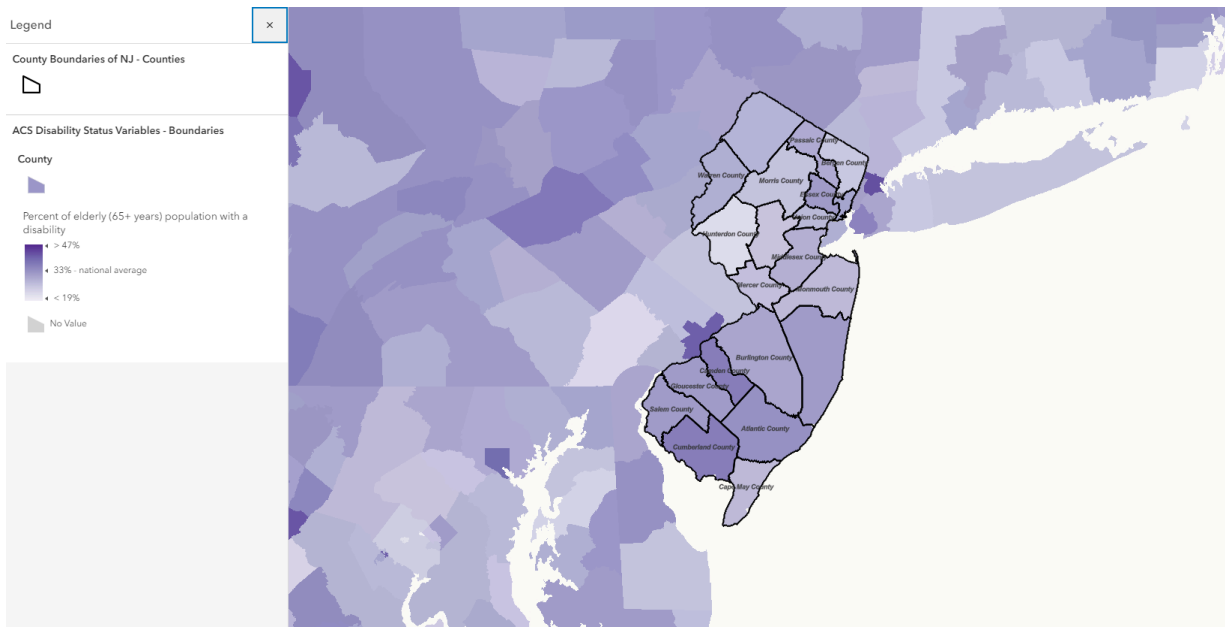


Figure 2. North New Jersey, Earnings by Occupation by Census Tract, American Community Survey (2017-2021). This map can be viewed online [here](#).
