Unit 1 Lesson 4



Aim: Students will learn to read a phrase related to common school items (sharpener, lunchbox, pencil case) and practice reading and circling the correct items.

Time: 45-60 minutes

Materials:

- Flashcards of (sharpener, lunchbox, pencil case, and other related items)
- Real or toy items of a sharpener, lunchbox, and pencil case
- Coloring materials (crayons, markers)
- Students' mini flashcards
- A box or paper bag to "hide" classroom items

Tip: Use positive reinforcement to encourage participation and correct answers. Praise students for their effort and provide gentle corrections as needed. Incorporate visuals and hands-on activities to keep young learners engaged and make the lesson more interactive.

Engage:

Greet the students warmly and gather them around. Show real items or flashcards (sharpener, lunchbox, pencil case) and ask students if they know what they are.

Guessing game

Put your school supplies inside a box or a paper bag. Model the Activity. Close your eyes. Put your hand inside the bag or box. Touch one of the items inside. Guess what the item is. Open your eyes. Show the students the item you guessed. See if you guessed correctly. Then, students play the game one by one, coming to the front of the class or in pairs. Encourage students to say the name of the item out loud when they find a match.

Explore & Practice:

With the Book

Reading and Circling Activity

Display the book page. Show students how to read the sentence and circle the correct item that matches the word.

Ask students to come up one by one and circle the correct item on the board, reinforcing their understanding.

Let students complete the book page independently or in small groups, providing assistance as needed.

Closing:

Review and Recap

Gather the students back in a circle. Show the flashcards again, asking students to name each item. Ask a few students to share their completed worksheets and explain their choices.
