The student will:	
	Identify and meet college admissions and scholarship deadlines
	Request your Baxter transcript, counselor recommendation, and teacher
	recommendations a minimum of two weeks before deadlines
	Confirm that your counselor and teachers have received all your electronic transcript and
	letter of recommendation requests (Common App and other applications)
	Identify standardized tests your colleges require (e.g. some require subject tests in
	addition to SATs or ACTs)
	Send standardized test scores directly from the testing agency to the colleges to which
	you are applying
	Complete FAFSA (opens Oct 1; colleges have varying deadlines) and send it to the
	schools to which you are applying
	Find out if any of your schools require the CSS Profile; complete that by the deadline
	Find out if any of your schools require an interview or audition; schedule as needed
	Request that the transcripts of any college courses you've taken be sent directly
	from the college where you took the class to the colleges to which you are
	applying
	Check your email for info from your colleges; login to and check college portals regularly
	Alert your counselor immediately if your colleges report that you are missing any pieces
	of your application that come from Baxter (transcript, letter of recommendation)
	Submit your enrollment deposit to the college of your choice by May 1

Counselors will:

- Send your transcript and counselor letter of recommendation to colleges by your deadlines (if we are given at least 2 weeks notice; asap otherwise). Please note, teachers send their letters directly, so confirm dates and requirements with them directly
- Answer admissions representative's questions about your transcript, at their request
- Send an updated mid year transcript to your schools (unless your application happens at or after the mid year updates)
- Provide your transcript and letter of recommendation to scholarships, at your request
- Send your final transcript where you ask us to, at your request
