- 1. Welcome/Introductions Mr. Gatten
 - a. Special Guest Brad Sorenson, Administrator of Schools
 - i. Proposed High School Boundary Changes
 - 1. Mr. Sorenson explained the various reasons for the "Midas Creek" boundary changes.
 - a. Mainly in response to requests from the affected area to keep students together instead of splitting among three high schools.
 - 2. Changes would take effect in the 26-27 school year if approved by the JSD School Board.
 - 3. Students who would attend Herriman High under the current configuration would be allowed to attend even if the new boundaries are approved.
 - a. Students choosing to permit to Herriman instead of going to their new boundary school would not have buses available to Herriman.
 - 4. People living in the area who would move to a different high school are given a survey that is different from the one sent to unaffected families.
 - 5. A concern was raised about Oquirrh Hills Middle School being too full to absorb students if the boundary is shifted.
 - a. Mr. Sorenson acknowledged the concern and stated that the school has the physical capacity to accommodate more students and may be allocated additional teachers as its population grows.
 - 6. The JSD Board will take comments at their October 28 and November 11 meetings. A vote to approve the boundary change will be held in December.
