



# 1. Calculator Terms and Conditions

Playing for the Planet and each member of the Playing for the Planet Alliance must agree to abide by Carbon Trust's Terms and Conditions and applicable terms of use in the Carbon Calculator tool.

Playing for the Planet can share this tool only with members of the Playing for the Planet Alliance and non-members classified as small developers. Both Playing for the Planet and each user may share the tool with auditors/verifiers providing third party assurance opinions. Playing for the Planet and each Alliance member cannot share this tool with any other third-parties (such as subcontractors) for the first 12 months.

The Carbon Trust may consider permitting Playing for the Planet to share the tool or a part of the tool (e.g. the tool methodology and/or outputs of the tool) with certain third parties on a case-by-case basis upon request.

Use and sharing of the tool by Playing for the Planet and its Alliance members after the first 12 months will be subject to a new contract under Carbon Trust's Terms and Conditions as well as an annual licence fee and may also be subject to further licensing arrangements depending on the proposed use case of the tool.

Agreement to the use of IP:

- Carbon Trust will retain IP ownership of the Carbon Calculator.
- This includes a license to use the Carbon Calculator for 12 months (1 year) for up to 100 Playing for the Planet users (members and non-members) only.
- Individual users of the tool must abide by the terms of use. Playing for the Planet is responsible to ensure that members follow these conditions.

Agreement on licensing of emission factors:

- A license fee for the use of tool and its use by third-party users is valid for 12 months. After this year, there will be an annual fee to update the emission factors and continue the use of the latest calculator.
- The use of emission factors for datasets such as the IEA will require a bespoke licensing agreement and associated fees. For example, Playing for the Planet must obtain their own license to use emission factors with the IEA. This is not included in this scope of work and such agreement between Playing for the Planet and IEA must be agreed **prior** to sharing with members.

Agreement to the use of emission factors:

- The emission factor datasets used in this calculator are from publicly available databases.
- Playing for the Planet must purchase their own license to use IEA emission factor data from the IEA directly if they wish to use this dataset.
