

SUPPLY LIST FOR PERFECTING YOUR PINWHEELS (and HSTs!)

Fabric: Decide upon the size of the Pinwheel Block you would like to make. See size chart, below:

Finished Block Size	Unfinished size	Print Fabric	Background Fabric
4 inch block	4.5 inch block	(2) 3.5 inch squares	(2) 3.5 inch squares
6 inch block	6.5 inch block	(2) 4.5 inch squares	(2) 4.5 inch squares
8 inch block	8.5 inch block	(2) 5.5 in. squares	(2) 5.5 in. squares
10 inch block	10.5 in. block	(2) 6.5 in squares	(2) 6.5 in. squares
12 inch block	12.5 in. block	(2) 7.5 in squares	(2) 7.5 in. squares

Feel free to bring scrap strips or squares (nothing smaller than 4.5 inches), nothing needs to match since this is a technique class!

Supplies:

Sewing machine in good working order, bobbin area thoroughly cleaned out (don't forget your foot pedal and the cord for plugging in your machine!);

1/4 inch presser foot of your choice

Thread – neutral is best

1 or 2 pre-wound bobbins

Sewing machine manual

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Rulers: 6.5 inch strip ruler at least 18 inches (available at CQC)

Rotary Cutter with a **SHARP** blade – (both available at CQC)

Cutting mat (at least 12 X 18 inches) (available at CQC)

Pins (fine piecing pins are best -- available at CQC)

Scissors

Seam ripper

Pen or pencil and notepad to take notes

HIGHLY RECOMMENDED:

Mary Ellen's Best Press (for flat, crisp seams) – available at CQC

Small iron – available at CQC (if the class is full)

Small (wool) pressing mat – available at CQC (if the class is full)
