

**Civil Rights Movement - Mini Presentations**

After watching video clips from *Eyes on the Prize* and *Freedom Riders*, students discuss the challenges faced by the organizers of the civil rights movement. Working in small groups, students then analyze the movement's early efforts. Each group is responsible for researching one of the actions of the movement between 1945 and 1965; each group also examines resistance to the changes wrought by the movement.

**The events to be investigated include:** desegregation of the armed forces, *Brown v. Board of Education*, Montgomery bus boycott, sit-ins, freedom rides, and the Mississippi freedom summer. Each group has 10 minutes to present their research to the whole class.
