### **Introduction**

As many of you who have competed with us before will know, we attempt to create an inclusive environment for Judokas of all abilities.

### **Format + age requirement**

- Expected to be Pools to knockout with repechage.
- Organisers reserve the right to change format depending on number of entries. (ALL competitors will get at minimum 2 contests)
- If there are incomplete Advanced Men's Team organisers may be able to merge teams or add in individual competitors.
- Age requirement: in general all judokas should be 16+. They should be aware it is an adult competition with strangles/armlocks. Preferably, the judoka should already have some competition experiences. Of course, we will try to put young people in groups with similar age.

**Groups – Groups will be stuck to when possible, but may be merged if low numbers in certain weights**

**Group A:** Novice Women- 5<sup>th</sup> Kyu and below (Players to be sorted into groups by age and weight)

**Group B:** Intermediate Women 4<sup>th</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu (Players to be sorted into groups by age, weight and grade)

**Group C:** Advanced Women- 1<sup>st</sup> Kyu and Above (Weight groups to be decided on day + open weight for points if time allows)

**Group D:** Novice Men- 5<sup>th</sup> Kyu and Below (U66 kg, U73 kg, U81 kg, U90 kg, O90 kg)

**Group E:** Intermediate Men- 4<sup>th</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu (U66 kg, U73 kg, U81 kg, U90 kg, O90 kg)

**Group F (Team):** Advanced Men- 1<sup>st</sup> Kyu and Above (U66 kg, U73 kg, U81 kg, U90 kg, O90kg)

### **Entry Fees**

- Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis (entry confirmed with payment);
- Entry limit of 225 will be strictly adhered to;
- Entry cost is £15 per competitor (reduction if they are part of our club). Any payments made after 15<sup>th</sup> of January 2022 or on the day will be charged at £20 per competitor. An extra 10p is charged by the SU for online payments.

### **Weigh In**

Weigh in will be ordered as per the schedule. If Weigh in for a particular group finishes early, the next group may be called forward prior to scheduled time.

Competition will be due to begin at 9:30, with weigh-in times as below:

- Groups D-E (Novice and Intermediate Men): 8.50 - 9.20
- Group A-C (Women): 9.30 – 10:00
- Groups F (Men's Team): 11 - 11.30

Male competitors will weigh in in their judogi trousers and will be given a 0.8 kg allowance

Female competitors will weigh in in their judogi trousers and plain t-shirt and will be given a 0.8 kg allowance.

### **Notes:**

- All Judokas must wear a white judogi
- Coaches briefing regarding rules at 9:15
- All judokas must hold a valid BJA, BJC or AJA licence (or equivalent) and produce this when weighing in
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries or combine weight groups should this be required.
- Each club will be held responsible for the behaviour of its players
- In the event of a dispute, the Tournament Director's decision is final
- In the event of an on mat dispute, the Referee in Charge's decision is final
