KEY MESSAGING POINTS

Food is at the heart of our public health and climate crises. Tons of scientific studies show that industrial animal agriculture plays a major role in driving climate change *and* diet-related disease.

• The scientific evidence is clear: eating less meat is vital to reducing greenhouse gas emissions and curbing the rates of chronic, costly, diet-related diseases.

CLIMATE: There are massive amounts of industrial animal foods in the national school meal program, which is fueling the climate catastrophe that threatens our future. To protect student health and well-being, now is the time to shift school meals toward healthy, climate-friendly foodservice.

HEALTH: Childhood obesity rates are soaring, particularly among low-income students and children of color. Frequent servings of cheeseburgers, pizza, chicken fingers and hot dogs on school menus do not help students establish a lifetime of healthy eating. School meals can help end our nutritional divide by increasing access to healthy, fresh, plant-forward food.

SOLUTIONS: School districts should expand choices for plant-based and plant-forward offerings on school food menus so that at least one quality plant-based entrée is featured every day.
