B. ATHLETIC COMPLEX BID APPROVAL

Tom DenHerder moved and Betsy Kikstra supported the motion to approve the athletic complex bid as presented.

ZPS and our construction manager took bids for this project on May 30, 2024. We had a great turnout overall. We collected 102 bids in 28 bid categories, from local contractors interested in this project. The athletic complex will be located north of the HS campus. That property purchase was completed on April 19, 2024. We will have 16 new tennis courts north of ZEHS, both schools will share these courts, as recommended by our athletic directors and coaches. North of ZWHS, there will be 2 Soccer/Lacrosse turf fields, (1 for ZEHS and 1 for ZWHS) along with a concession stand, bleachers, team rooms, an athletic trainer room, and an official's room. Overall, we were pleasantly surprised to find this project under the projected budget, total cost \$10,965,779 to be funded with the 2021 Bond. The Finance Committee reviewed this in depth today before the board meeting and recommends we move forward in approving the contracts for Bid Pack #10. The timeframe for the completion is Spring 2026.

- B. Summer School Opportunities:
 - Zee Bus Events across the summer with reading opportunities and books
 - K-8 High Doses of Summer Tutoring One-on-one or small group tutoring for K-8 students based on need. This will include 3 connections a week with students in Math, ELA, or both in June and July. Staff are hired, trained, and ready! We have well over 245 students participating. This will happen at Cityside with some of the construction happening around the district.
 - 9-12 Summer Credit Recovery We have 5 staff supporting our 9-12 students looking to recapture credits to ensure on-time graduation. Students will join in person two times a week and work (with the option to come another day). This runs 6 weeks and has approximately 100 students signed up.
- C. Staffing Update: Interviewing and hiring has been occurring since right around spring break. We have some positions remaining and are appreciative of the many individuals who have taken part in identifying our newest ZPS team members.
