## Next Week's Topics for Learning:

#### Phonics:

- English: We will review the names, sounds, and formations of the letters Aa, Gg, Dd,
  Ss, Ee, Rr, Pp, and Jj. Please read the attached Parent Home Connection letter and see the video lesson to support your child at home.
- Spanish: The students will study syllables with M and P. HFWs: los, las, mi, son, un, de, Y, tú, eres, puedo.

### Reading:

- English: Students will discover how books change lives around the world. We will read the story Tomás and the Library Lady by Pat Mora and Museum ABC by the Metropolitan Museum of Art. We will explore how Tomás's life is changed by books, and we will understand different ways people around the world get books. Please see the attached Parent Letter to learn ways you can support your child at home as we begin our new reading unit.
- Spanish: The students will ask and answer questions about key details of a text.
  Starting with the Hispanic Heritage month, the students will learn about their hispanic teachers' countries of origin.
- Math: The students will learn to count on from a part. They will also learn how to relate part-part total.

 Homework pages: Lesson 7-11, pages 33-54 (Optional: to help students reinforce content at home) No need to bring them back to school.
