Participatory audiovisual methodology in Secondary Education
for reversing gender inequalities
Educogen project proposal

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EDUCOGEN is a Spanish National funded by the Science and Innovation Ministry that aims to evaluate the impact of participatory audiovisual methodology in the educational field for the deconstruction of sexist imaginaries and practices in adolescents between 12 and 16 years of age from different socio-economic levels in order to contribute to reversing gender inequalities.

EDUCOGEN is linked to the European H2020 project "Smooth Educational Spaces. Passing through Enclosures and Reversing Inequalities through Educational

Commons, SMOOTH (H2020-SC6-TRANSFORMATIONS, 2018-2020) which introduces educational commons for the reversal of inequalities and the active social inclusion of young people at risk in Europe. What EDUCOGEN proposes, in addition to SMOOTH, is to incorporate the gender approach in the concept of educational commons and to include a participatory audiovisual methodology within the educational commons perspective.

The main objective of the project is to introduce teachers and students to the audiovisual participatory methodology and the horizontal perspective as a tool for working on gender equality. The project contemplates a methodological triangulation with different quantitative (questionnaires to students and teachers) and qualitative techniques (focus groups, interviews and audiovisual participatory workshops) depending on each phase of the project. That way, the objective of this communication is to present the methodological design of the project; paying particular attention to the design of the audiovisual participatory workshops.
