



These are platforms with lots of interactive resources at all levels from total beginner to Intermediate (GCSE) level employing the latest theoretical approach on retrieval practice.

For Mandarin Excellence Programme (MEP) classes, all students are also subscribed to the GoChinese portal, which provides additional interactive learning resources specifically tailored to the MEP curriculum.

**Spanish:** In addition to these clubs, all students in year 7 to 11 have been subscribed to the Sentence Builders and Active Learn portals, where they do most of the homework. These portals have lots of interactive resources at all levels, from total beginner to Intermediate (GCSE) level, employing the latest theoretical approach on retrieval practice.

**French:** In addition to these clubs, KS4 students (year 10 and 11) have been subscribed to the Active Learn Pearson and Kerboodle portals where they do most of the homework. This is a portal with lots of interactive resources employing the latest theoretical approach on retrieval practice.

For Year 9, 10 and 11 all students will also be given login details into the Pearsons Active Learn platform, which makes the basis of all SoW and teaching material for Y9 to 11 in French and Spanish.


