Additional restrictive measures in connection with Covid-19

Dear Grandliiga participants!

In connection with the additional restrictions released by the government of the republic, aimed at reducing the spread of coronavirus and reducing contact of people, the Grandliiga Committee decided to introduce additional restrictive measures in the organizing matches of Grandliiga tournaments.

From November 28, 2020 to January 10, 2021 inclusive, the Grandliiga games will be played without spectators. The term of the restriction can be changed, depending on the epidemiological situation in the region.

The games continue according to the schedule of the calendar and only players and teams administration are allowed into the sports hall.

Players and teams administration arrive to the scheduled games, do not enter the playing hall before their match, and do not return to the playing hall after the match as spectators. The stands will be raised, there will be no seats for spectators. Players and teams administration before and after the match, in the premises of the sports complex of the Tallinn Humanitarian Gymnasium, observe the 2 + 2 (or reasonable distance) rules and wear masks. **In the playing hall, during the warm-up before the match and during the match, without masks.**

These solutions are aimed at preventing the spread of coronavirus in order to protect human life and health and to avoid overloading the medical system. According to the government document dated 24/11/2020, link:
