## Off-campus Education in Chinook's Edge School Division At-A-Glance

Purpose: This document provides a one page snapshot of the main areas involved with Off-campus Education programs, and the key responsibilities for each of those areas. This is not meant to replace any specific procedures or processes; rather to provide the 30 000 foot view of Off-campus Education. Off-campus Education Teacher = Certificated Staff. Educational Assistant = Non-certificated Staff.

Safety	<ul> <li>Due diligence</li> <li>Inspections of worksites</li> <li>Injury reporting</li> <li>Ensuring adequate supervision at site by employer</li> <li>Parental awareness and communication</li> <li>Pre-requisites</li> <li>Pre-placement orientation</li> </ul>	Certificated Staff - lead responsibility for student safety.
Learning Plans	<ul> <li>Every off-campus education program must have a list of learning outcomes, clearly stating what the student will be able to demonstrate at the conclusion of the off campus education experience.</li> <li>Must be a quality educational experience -demonstrating incremental learning and growth over time.</li> </ul>	Certificated staff - develop learning plans collaboratively with the employer and the student. Learning plans are available for RAP and Green Certificate. Assistance with documentation and record keeping may be provided by non-certificated staff.
Monitoring of Program	<ul> <li>Regular ongoing monitoring of the student throughout the Off-campus Education program</li> <li>One contact for every 25 hours is recommended. Take into account the hazard level of the worksite, the progress of the student, etc.</li> </ul>	Under the direction of certificated staff, a non-certificated can conduct the monitoring and documentation of that monitoring.

	Student timesheets	Any concerns that arise from the monitoring must go immediately to the certificated staff member.
Student Assessment and Evaluation	<ul> <li>Assessment procedure must be clearly articulated to the student before activities at the work site commence.</li> <li>The Off-campus Teacher is responsible for each student's final mark.</li> </ul>	Certificated staff responsibility. Non-certificated staff may assist with collection of documents, records, and feedback collected from monitoring plan.
