Host a Louisville Orchestra chamber performance at your school! A small group of LO musicians will present a 45-min program designed to expose students to a variety of instrumental music and themes, demonstrate different musical concepts, and familiarize them with the instruments of the orchestra.

Optional classroom activities are provided prior to performance. Schools are also provided access to the LO Online Music Education Learning Library.

PERFORMANCE INFORMATION

- **Dates:** October 2025–April 2026 (*see reservation form for available dates*)
- **Times:** Flexible – based on school schedule and musician availability (45-min presentation)
- **Audience/Location:** Grades 3-6
 - Presentation should be held in an auditorium, cafeteria or other assembly area
 - Maximum students: ~250

REQUIREMENTS

- Please make sure the school front office staff knows about the musicians' visit in advance.
- A teacher or school staff member should chaperone the musicians at all times and introduce the group before they begin their presentation.
- Students should be supervised at all times. In the event of a discipline problem, please have a teacher or administrator deal with the situation to avoid disruption.
- **NOTE:** All musicians have passed the criminal and CAN records check required by JCPS and the state.

IMPORTANT SPACE & SET-UP REQUIREMENTS ***PLEASE READ***

- Musicians require a clean area of at least 20 by 20 feet. *Please leave a comfortable amount of space between musicians and students.* This can be on a stage, but it is preferred to have the ensemble present on the same level with the students. (If students sit on floor, musicians can present on the floor level vs. on a stage.)
- **Please provide and set-up one (1) armless, non-folding chair for each of the number of musicians that will be performing. Note: Musicians will supply their own music stands.**
- **Please provide a microphone. Please advise if one is not available.**

- Space must be over 68 degrees Fahrenheit to ensure proper and optimal conditions for the musical instruments used.
- *NOTE: All musicians have passed the criminal and CAN records check required by JCPS and the state.*

IMPORTANT: The use of any video or audio recording devices is strictly prohibited.

The LO may ask if a staff member or photographer can attend to document the presentation. If so, this will be arranged with the school in advance. Photos may be used in LO marketing material online, in print, and other media formats.

PAYMENT

Please send payment no later than two (2) weeks prior to the scheduled service. Payment can be made by consolidated check or credit card. If your group is a FFTA grant recipient, the LO will send an invoice directly to the Fund.

**If booking services to a school outside of Jefferson County, the LO requires mileage reimbursement. Calculate mileage to/from 40202 and your school. Cost is \$.67 per mile + program cost.*
