

1. What is ACSL and who can participate?

ACSL (American Computer Science League) is an international computer science competition for students in grades K–12. Students compete in divisions based on grade level and experience. Read more here <https://www.acsl.org/>

2. Do I need an ACSL team to use this website?

No. Anyone can use this platform to study ACSL topics, take practice tests, and review concepts—even if your school is not registered with ACSL.

3. How do the ACSL divisions work?

Divisions include Elementary, Classroom, Junior, and Senior/Intermediate. Each division has its own set of topics and difficulty levels.

4. Does this website follow the official ACSL curriculum?

Yes. All topics, knowledge graphs, examples, and practice questions follow the official ACSL topic list.

5. Can I take the real ACSL contest on this website?

No. This platform is for practice only. Official contests are administered through ACSL-registered schools and teams.

6. What is the Knowledge Graph and how do I use it?

The Knowledge Graph shows every ACSL topic in a visual map. You can track what you've completed, what needs practice, and what to study next.

7. Are answers and explanations provided?

Yes. After each test, you can review step-by-step explanations and the correct logic.

8. Do I need an account to save my progress?

Yes. Creating an account lets you save progress, track tokens, see historical scores, and sync results across devices.

9. How often is new content added?

Content is updated regularly to match ACSL's yearly curriculum changes and improve clarity.

10. Is this website only for advanced students?

No. The platform supports all skill levels—from beginners learning basic logic to students preparing for Senior Division topics.

11. Can I join AI Code Academy's official ACSL team through this site?

Yes. Students without a school team can apply to join AI Code Academy's official ACSL team.

12. Can I retake a practice test?

Yes. You can retake any practice test as many times as you want. Your best score is saved in your dashboard.

After each test, you can open the Review page to see correct answers, explanations, and your mistakes.

15. Does the website save my progress automatically?

Yes. Your progress, tokens, and completed topics save automatically while you're logged in.

You cannot switch divisions manually. Divisions are assigned only to official AI Code Academy students. If you are not enrolled as an AI Code Academy student, you can still practice any division, but you will not be officially assigned to one. Go to Dashboard → Profile, then choose any available avatar.
